

There are 5 BINGO cards. The next 5 pages present the BINGO cards that can be printed out; they are labeled at the bottom of the card (e.g., "matrix #1"). The subsequent 5 pages present the BINGO cards ***with the "answer row/diagonal" highlighted.***

The cards have been set up so that a BINGO participant possessing *any BINGO card* can win after Question #18.
