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

# What are the odds?

- 25.8 million people (8.8% of U.S. population) have diabetes
- If current trend continues by 2050, 1 in 3
   U.S. adults will have diabetes
- Leading cause of blindness, kidney failure, and amputations of feet and legs not related to accidents or injury
- In 2007 was the 7<sup>th</sup> leading cause of death
- Shorter life expectancies

# What is the cost?

- In 2007 (Direct medical costs)- \$116 billion
- In 2007 –(Indirect costs related to disability, work loss, premature death) - \$58 billion
- On average, medical expenses for a person diagnosed with diabetes are more than twice as much as the expenses of a person without diabetes.

# What is Diabetes?

Diabetes is a disease in which the body has a shortage of insulin, a decreased ability to use insulin, or both. Insulin is a hormone that allows glucose (sugar) to enter cells and be converted to energy. When diabetes is not controlled, glucose and fats remain in the blood and, over time, damage vital organs.

# Forms of Diabetes

- Type 1 usually first diagnosed in children and young adults...accounts for 5% of diabetes cases
- Type 2 associated with older age, obesity,
   and physical inactivity accounts for 90-95%
- Gestational diabetes diagnosed during pregnancy – more often for American Americans, Hispanic/Latino and American Indian women
- Other types surgery, medications, infections pancreatic disease – accounts for less than 5%



Diabetes is a disease in which your blood glucose, or sugar, levels are too high. Glucose comes from the foods you eat. Insulin is a hormone that helps the glucose get into your cells to give them energy. With Type 1 diabetes, your body does not make insulin. With Type 2 diabetes, the more common type, your body does not make or use insulin well. Without enough insulin, the glucose stays in your blood.



Over time, having too much glucose in your blood can cause serious problems. It can damage your eyes, kidneys, and nerves. Diabetes can also cause heart disease, stroke and even the need to remove a limb. Pregnant women can also get diabetes, called gestational diabetes. (Read more)


