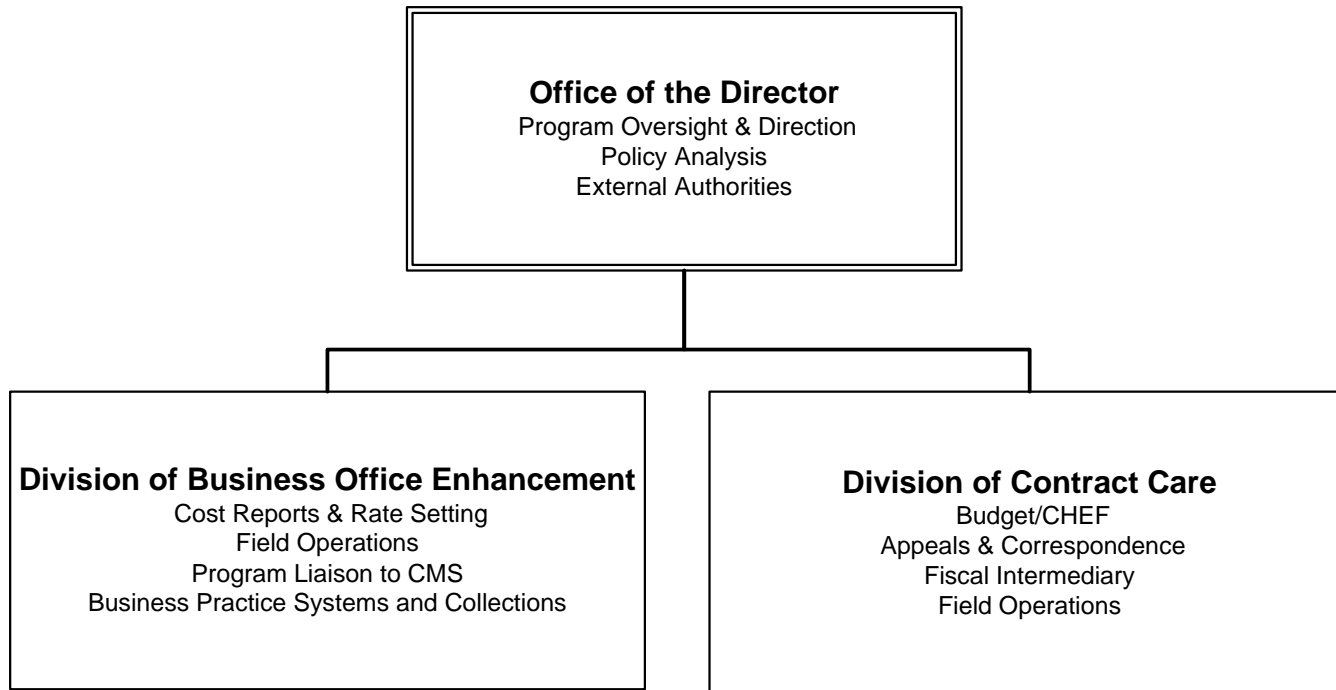

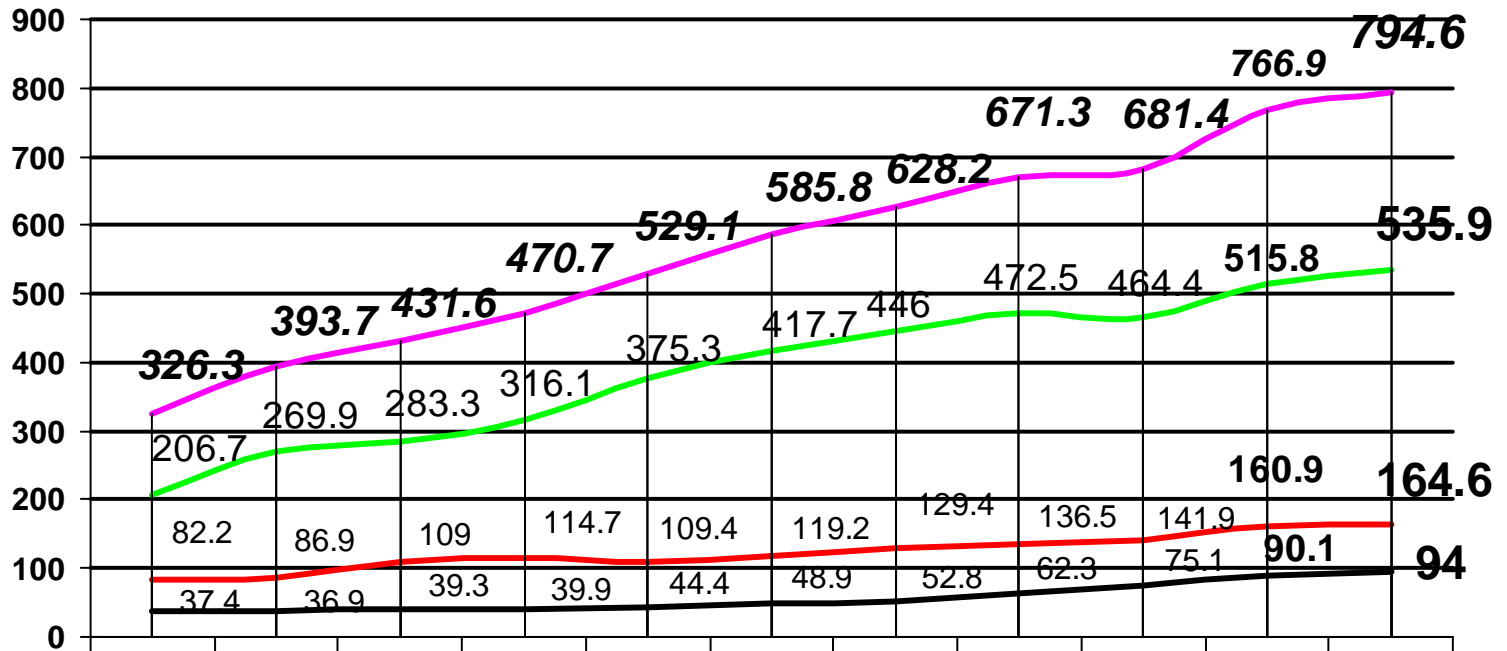

# Revenue Stream Impacts

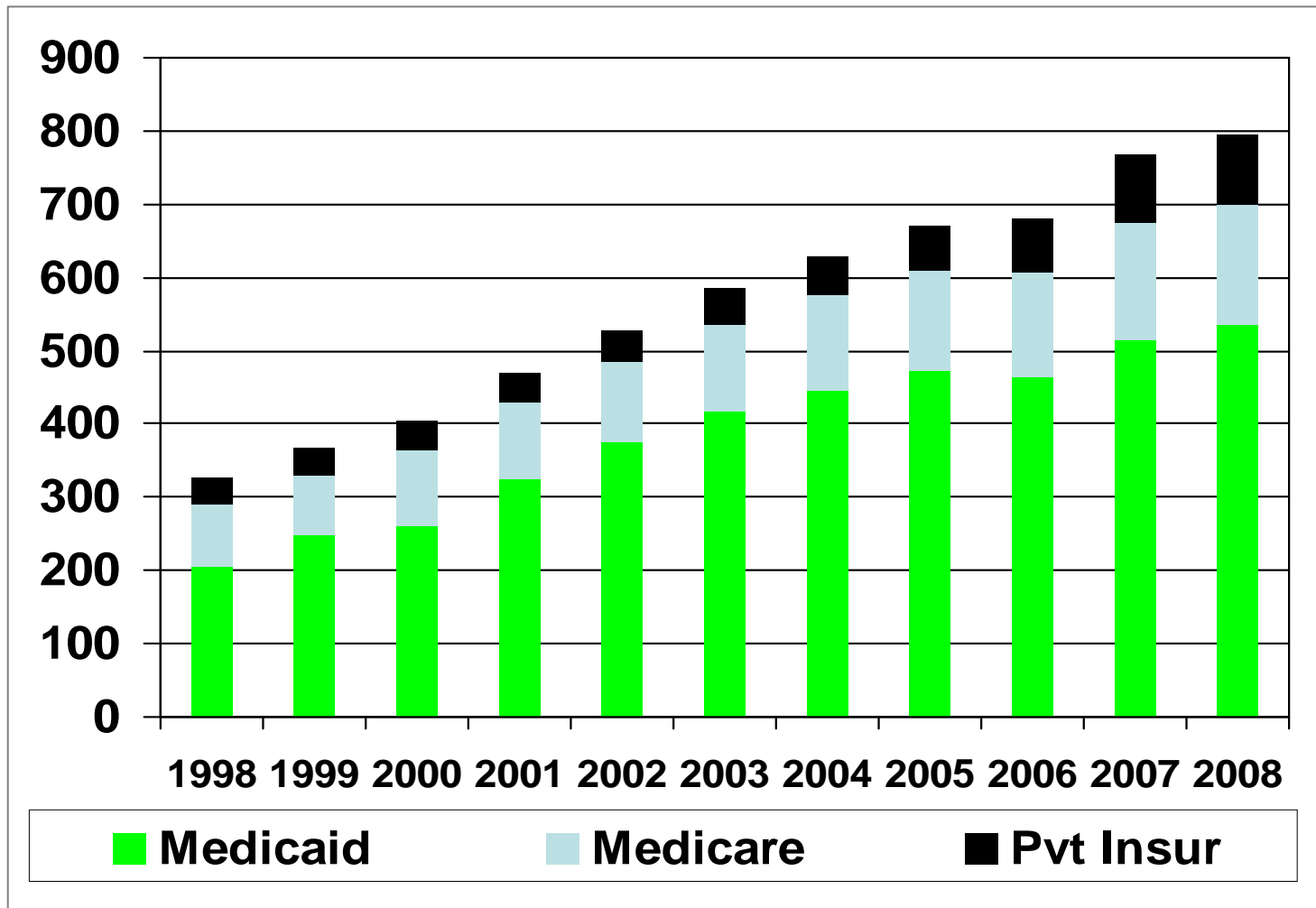
- Macro or Big Picture

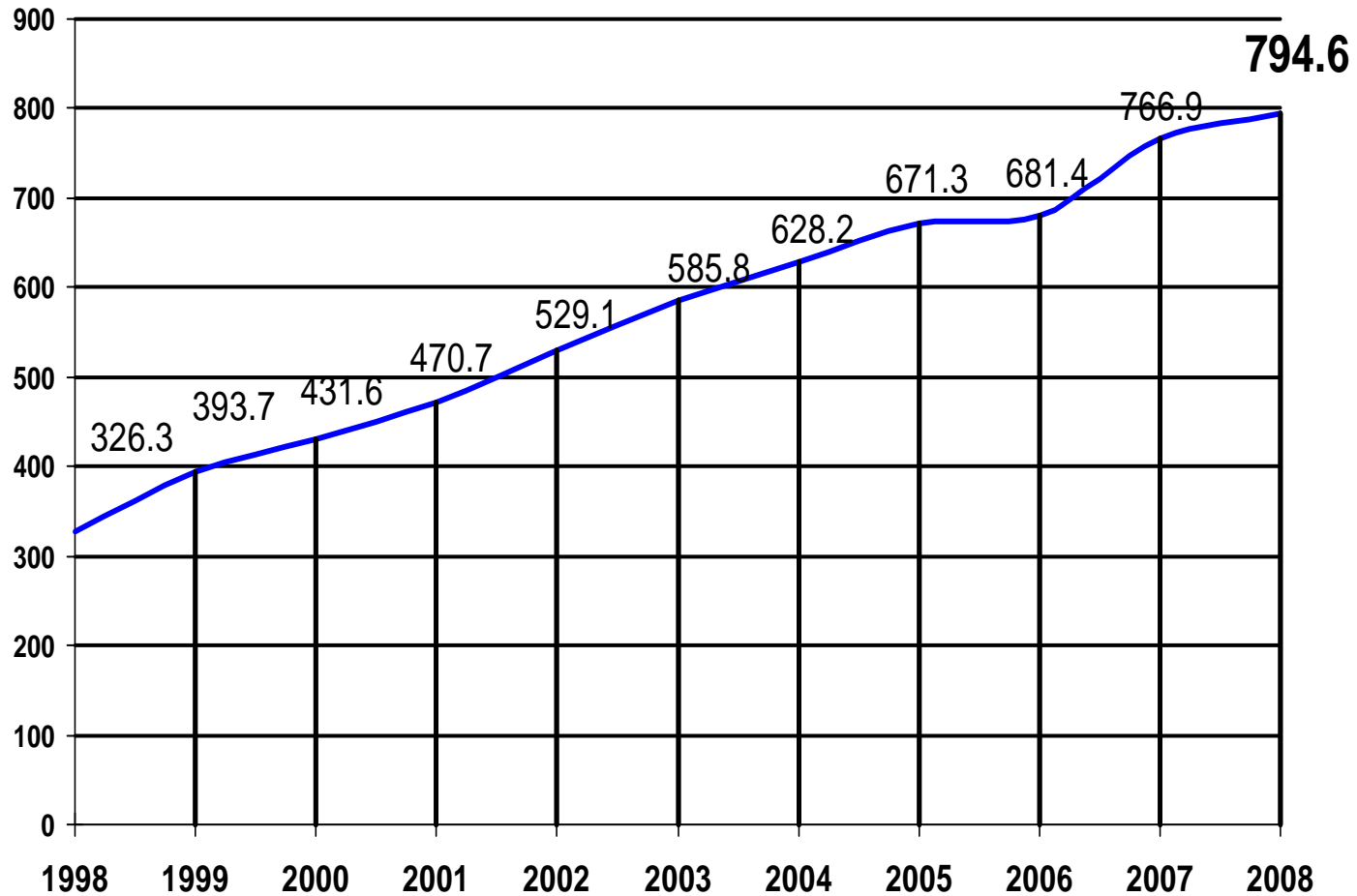

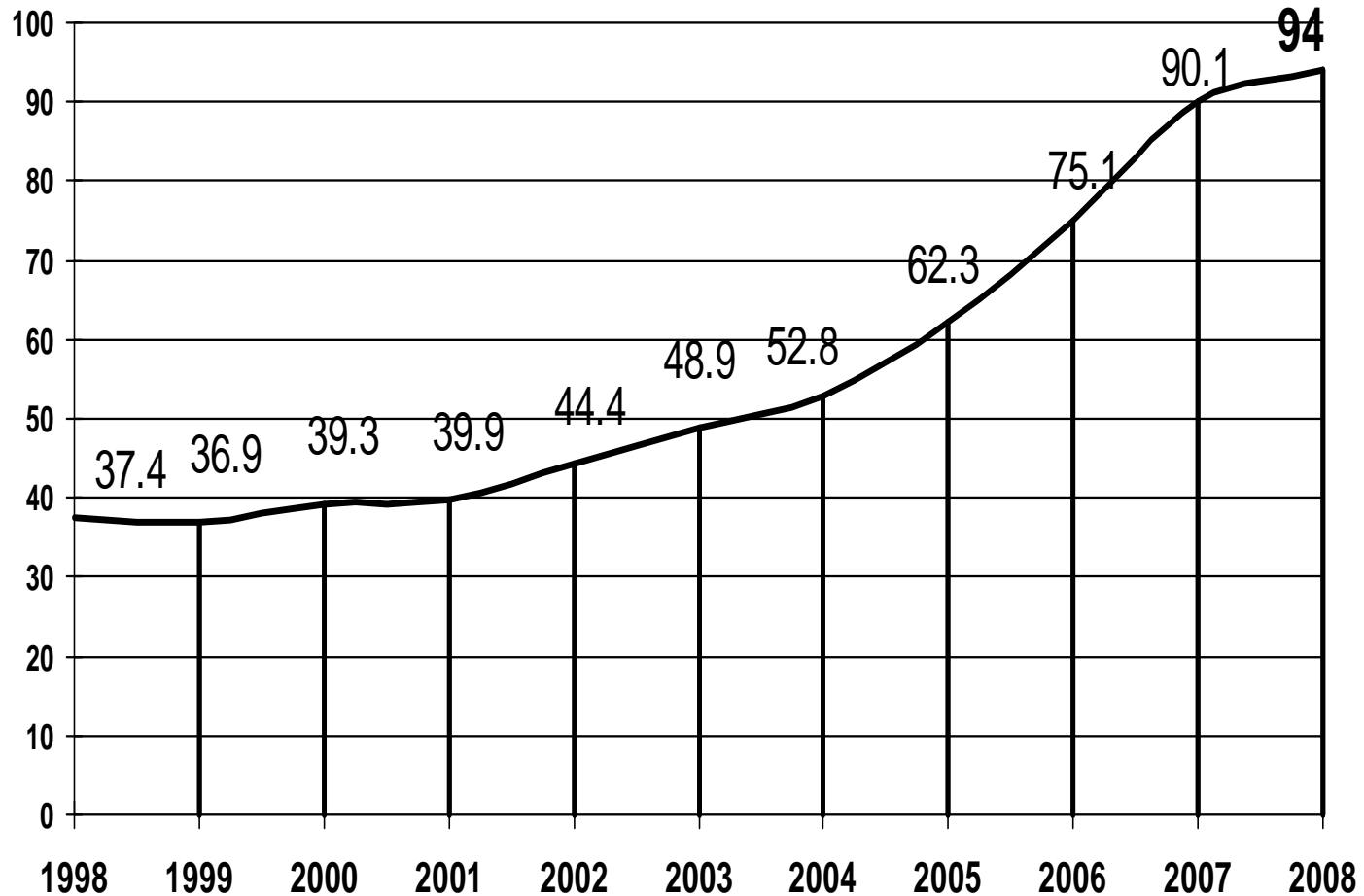

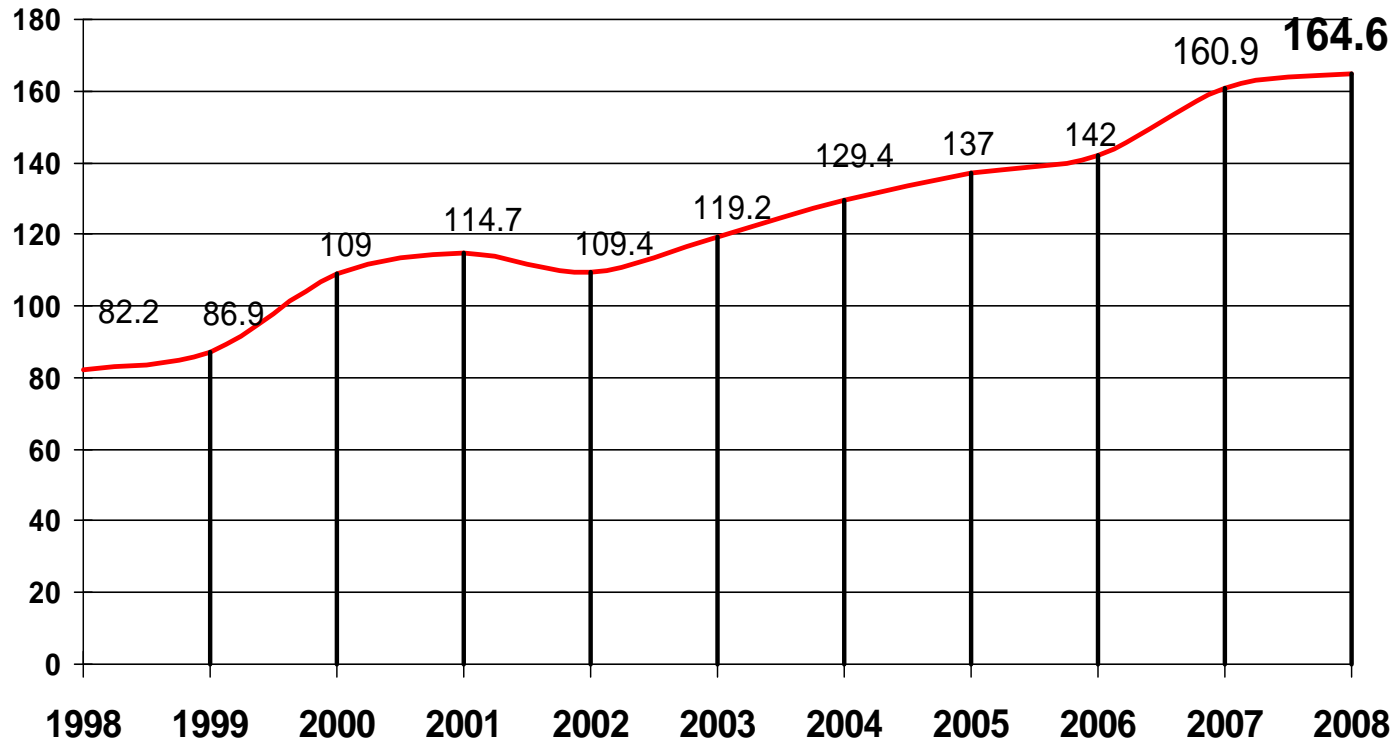




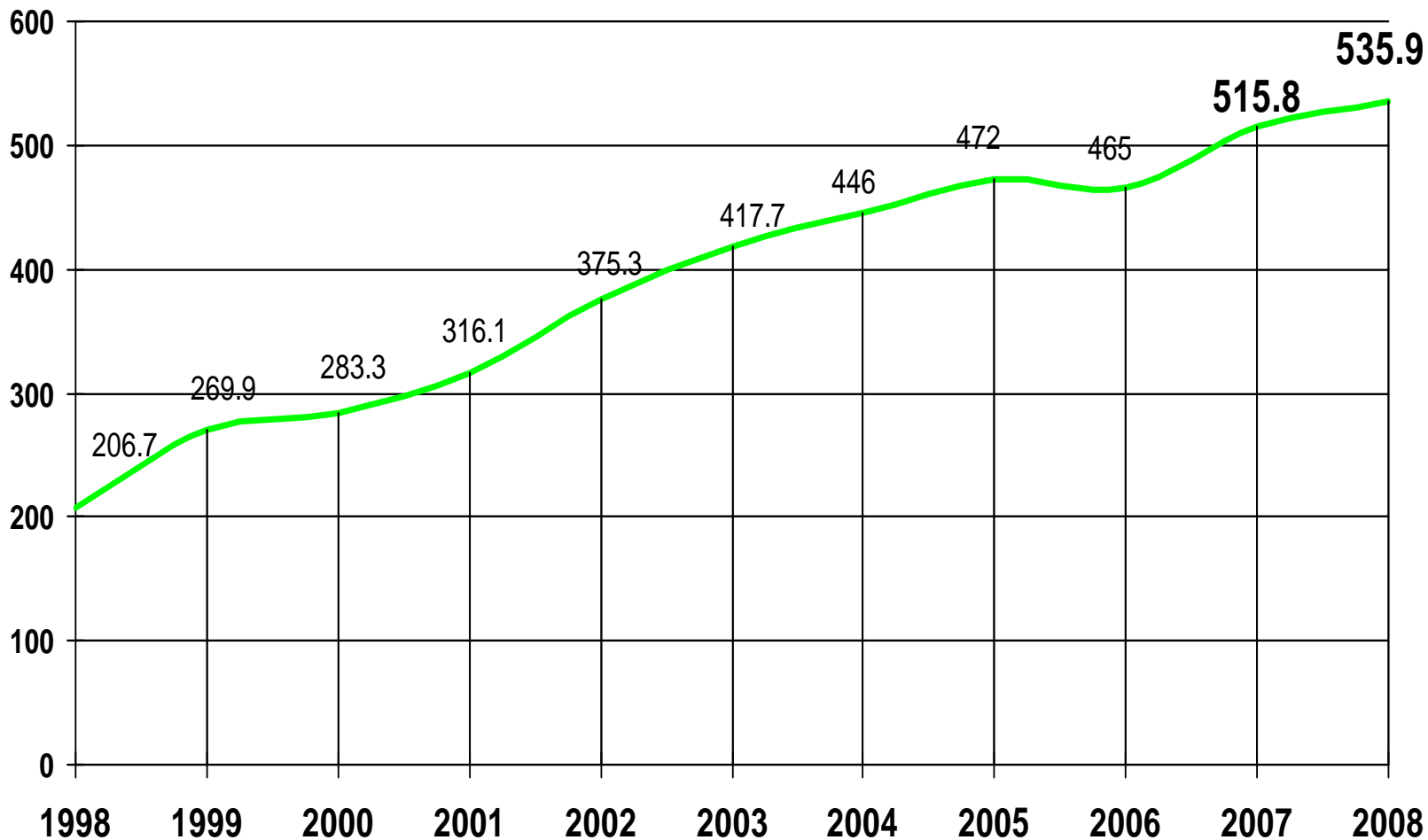
# IHS Private Insurance Collections 1998–2008



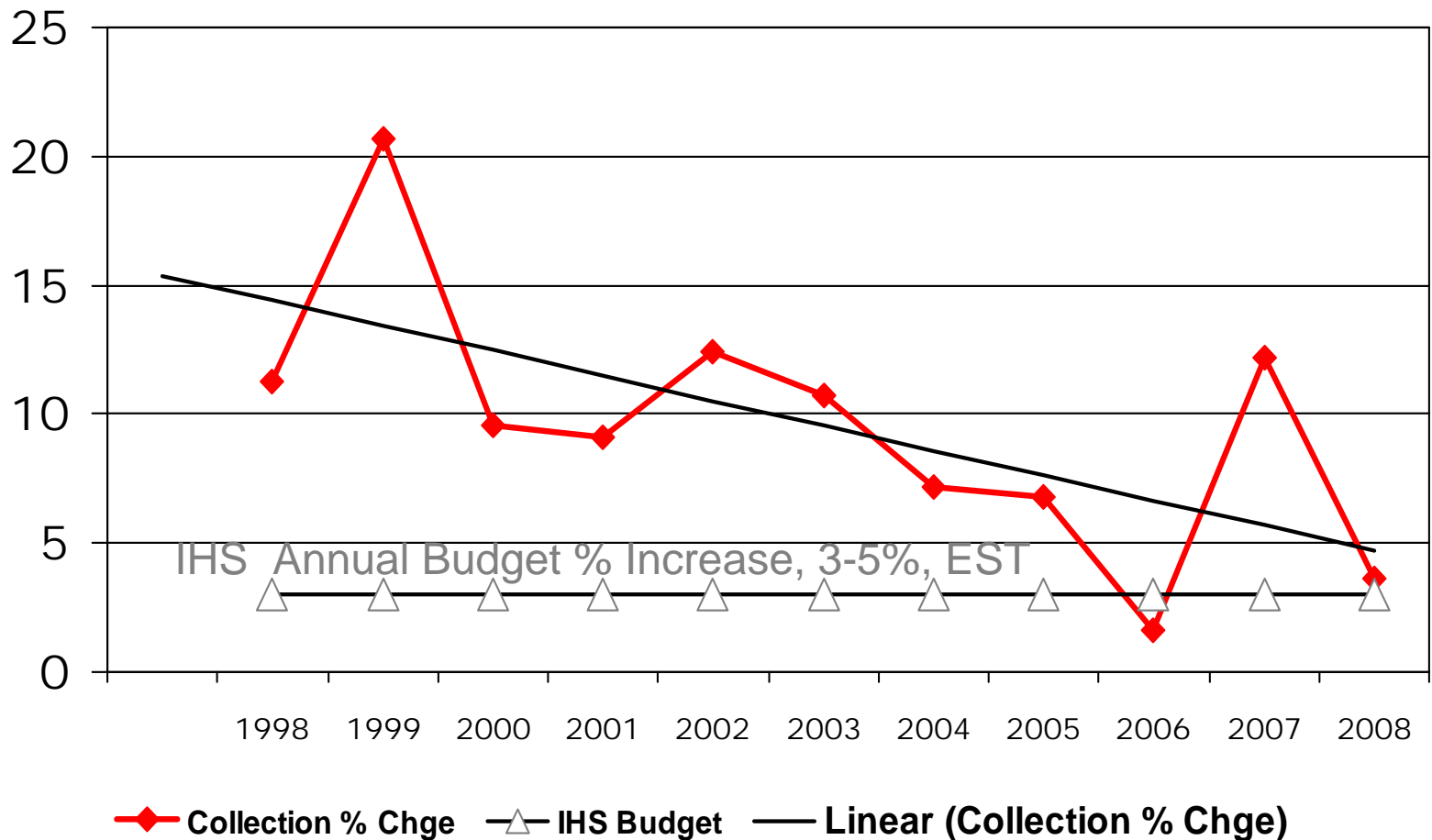
# IHS Medicare Collections 1998–2008



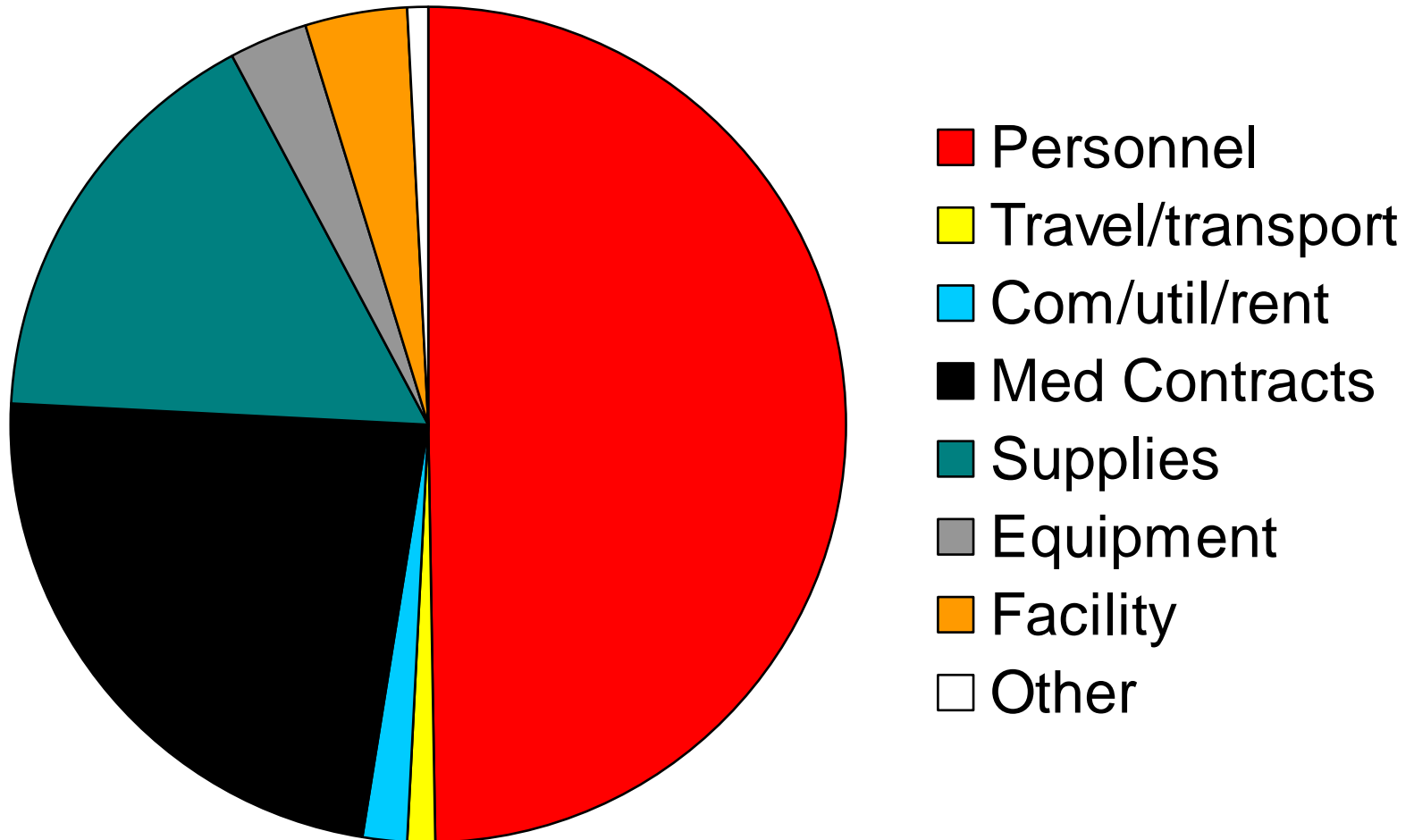
# IHS Medicaid Collections 1998–2008

# Ongoing Projects at Headquarters ORAP



- Cost Reports to set rates
- Review M&M laws, regulations, policies
- Liaison with National Indian Health Board (NIHB) and Medicare and Medicaid Policy Committee (MMPC)
- Liaison to Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) Tribal Technical Advisory Group (TTAG)
- Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Interagency Coordination, i.e., CMS, other
- Liaison with NBOC and Workgroups, PR, 3P, Point of Sale (POS)
- Internal Controls Policy, online tool
- Congressional budgets: track collections and prepare data
- POS, DME, RHAQDAPU, E-Prescribing: track and monitor numerous acronyms that represent potential opportunities
- Resource and Patient Management System (RPMS), training, policies etc.
- ResourceSmart, patient benefits coordination

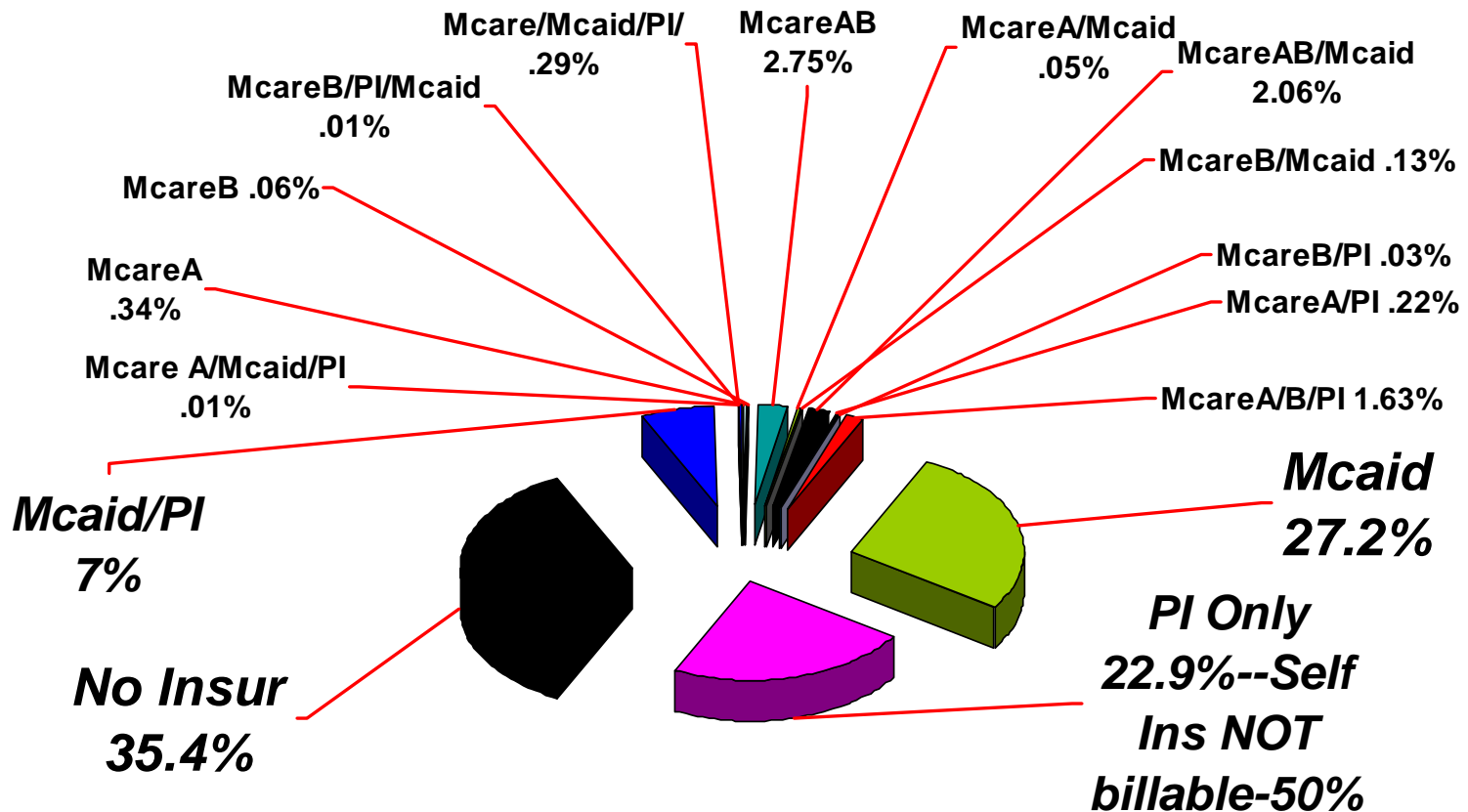

# IHS Total Eligibility Categories By Percent, 2006, 1.4M users

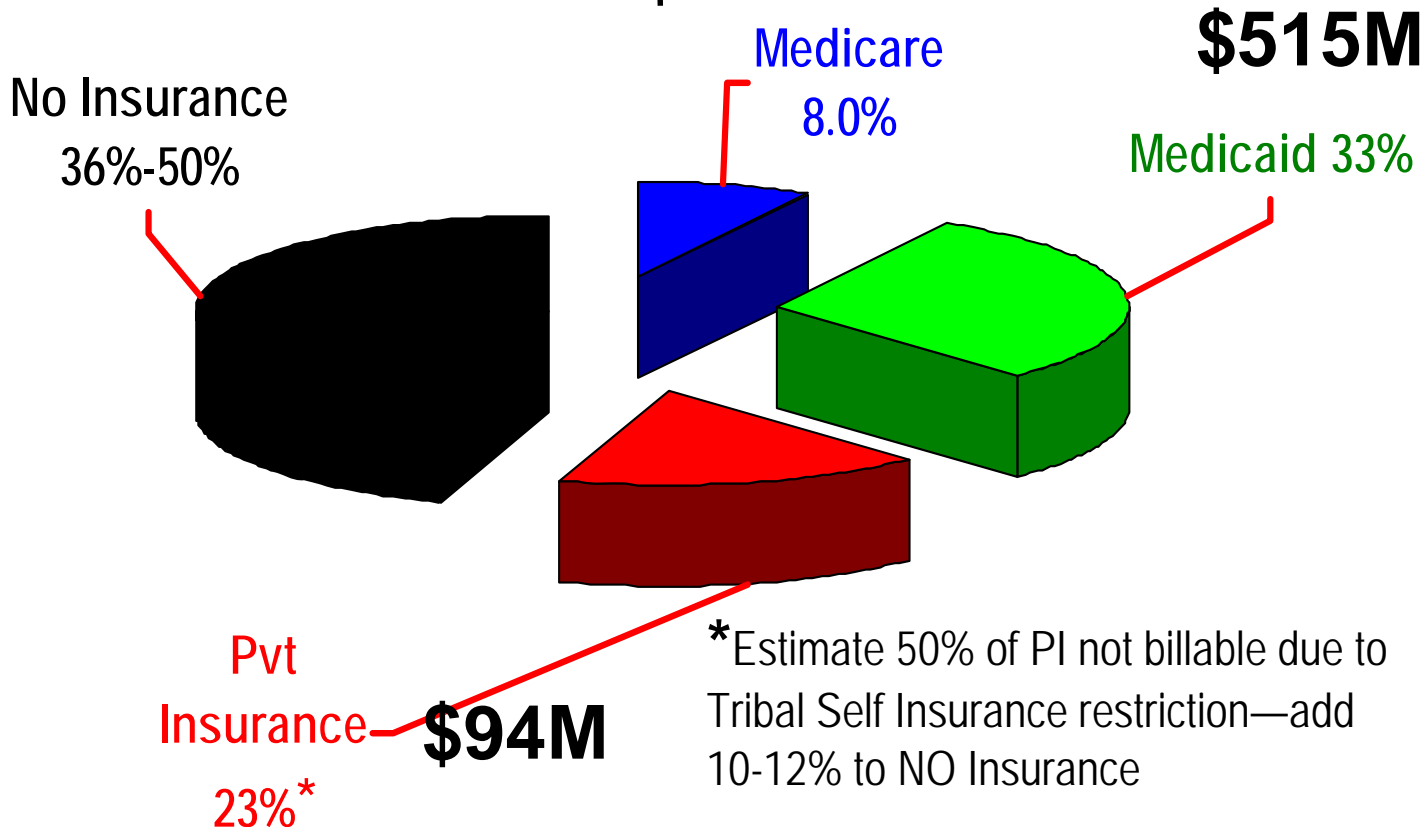
