

AR Reconciliation Areas and Responsibilities



RPMS AR Reconciliation

- Daily file transfer Reconciliation Service Units
- Open Receivable balance in UFMS/ASM Balance in RPMS Reconciliation – Service Unit/Area Office
- Collections Allotments/Allowance reconciliation Service Unit / Area Office
- Cash reconciliation Service Unit/ Area Office
- Non RPMS AR Reconciliation
 - Allowance reconciliation Area Office
 - Cash reconciliation Area Office



Memo on AR Reconciliation by Liz Fowler and Carl Harper



- Memo Stresses on the AR Reconciliation due to significant audit findings and GAO audit

- Monthly monitoring shall be performed

AR Reconciliation Monitoring Process



- Two persons (one from Finance and One from Business Office) need to be identified who will be the primary points of contact responsible for AR & AR Cash reconciliation
- AR Dashboard will be circulated every month
- Monthly reconciliation sign off sheets will have to be provided by the Reconciliation POCs for every area that should include:
 - Justifications for the discrepancies listed on the Dashboard
 - UFMS Open Receivable vs ASM comparison and explanation of differences if any
 - Reconciliation Performance metrics indicators of reconciliation being performed at the service units and area offices for all types of reconciliation
- The sign off sheets will be sent to the Federal AR lead
- Monthly AR-RPMS-Cash reconciliation meeting will be held where the Federal AR lead will review the reconciliation progress across areas with HQE Leadership
- Reconciliation workshops will be conducted on a periodic basis to facilitate the reconciliation process



AR Dashboard



- First AR dashboard was circulated on March 16, 2010
- List of items include (but not limited to):
- ALL GENERATED/EXTRACTED FROM UFMS
 - YTD Collections by Service Unit
 - YTD Billed Amounts by Service Unit
 - YTD Adjusted Amounts by Service Unit
 - PTD Collected/Billed/Adjusted
 - Un reconciled collection schedules by area

MANUAL INPUT WITH AREA/SERVICE UNIT DATA

- RPMS Invoices, receipts and adjustment errors
- Reconciliation Performance Matrix
- Open Receivable Balances and ASM balances by Area, by Service Unit, by Allowance category – In puted by Service Unit/Area Contacts
- Will be circulated every month
 - To Area Directors, CEOs, Executive Officers, FMOs, and BOCs

What does the Dashboard Tell Us?

- Comparison of Billing, and can recognize Backlog at a Glance
- Are we in line to make our Projections
- Errors that could impact collections and A/R Balances
- Do we have a problem between RPMS and UFMS
- IS there money that has been deposited that hasn't been allotted?
- Etc.



IHS AR Future State Reporting Initiative



- Every valid bill, receipt (payment) and adjustment from RPMS exists in UFMS
- UFMS can be one centralized place to get all the reports including:
 - Revenue, Expenses, and Cash by Cost center
 - Nationwide Aging Reports facilitate better Tracking of Open Receivables
 - Management reports for benchmarking of performance of Areas and Service Units - Comparative analysis of similar service units across IHS will be possible
 - Posted Collections vs. Advice allotted reports
 - Treasury vs. UFMS Reconciliation reports
 - Trend analysis reports can be generated for all the various categories identified
 - Collections Projections plans Facilitates creation of accurate and eventually budget formulation for IHS
 - Help in Audit (CFO and GAO and OIG) Standardization of Adjustment categories and Reason Codes
