USAREUR units identified for deployment in 2009

HEIDELBERG, Germany – Two U.S. Army in Europe medical units have been identified for deployment to Afghanistan as part of the Operation Enduring Freedom Fiscal Year 09 force rotation.

Headquarters, 30th Medical Command, based in Heidelberg, Germany, is expected to command and control all echelon above Brigade Combat Team medical units in US Forces Afghanistan, as well as provide medical policy and oversight for all of US Forces Afghanistan.

The 67th Forward Surgical Team, based in Miesau, Germany, is expected to provide life-saving surgery in support of battlefield casualties.

The units are expected to deploy this spring for up to 12 months.

As part of its non-negotiable commitment to take care of Families, the U.S. Army in Europe will ensure that the military community infrastructure will continue to support the needs of all members of the community while the unit is deployed.
