Presentations mix education with entertainment to teach Soldiers about preventing sexual assault

HEIDELBERG, Germany – The Headquarters U.S. Army Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Personnel is funding "Sex Signals" sexual assault prevention training in communities across U.S. Army Europe, March 23-30.

The training is one segment of USAREUR's overall Sexual Assault Prevention and Response program, and can be used to meet unit mandatory annual SAPR training requirements. The program is a two-person interactive play that mixes education with improvisational comedy to provoke discussions about dating, sex and the issue of consent, to encourage audiences to intervene to prevent sexual assault. It is designed for and limited to Soldiers between the ages of 18 and 24 years old.
