Army identifies deceased 2nd Brigade, 1st Armored Division Soldiers

HEIDELBERG, Germany— U.S. Army officials have identified the three Baumholder-based Soldiers who died in an automobile accident Sunday.

The deceased are:

- SPC Douglas Clark., 22, of Douglas, Georgia.
- SPC Laron Gadson, 24, of Greensboro, North Carolina.
- SGT Alexander Westbrooks, 26, of New York City, New York.

Clark was an Electronic Device Repairer, assigned to the 97th Forward Support Battalion, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Armored Division. Clark is survived by his mother and father.

Gadson was a Light Wheeled Vehicle Mechanic, assigned to Bravo Company, 47th Forward Support Battalion, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Armored Division. He is survived by his wife and daughter.

Westbrooks was Automated Logistical Specialist, assigned to the 97th Forward Support Battalion, 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 1st Armored Division. Westbrooks is survived by his daughter and his mother.

A memorial service will be held 3 June at 1500 in the Chapel One on Smith Barracks, Baumholder, Germany.

The incident remains under investigation.
