

PROCEDURES GOVERNING APPLICANTS FOR NOMINATIONS TO THE SERVICE ACADEMIES

Nominations—General Information

United States Senators and Members of Congress may nominate candidates who are legal residents of their State or District for admission to the U.S. Air Force, the U.S. Merchant Marine, the U.S. Military and U.S. Naval Academies. The number of nominations which a Senator or Representative may make in a particular year depends on how many vacancies exist at the particular Academy in the quota allocated to each Senator's or Representative's office.

IT IS TO YOUR ADVANTAGE TO APPLY TO BOTH OF YOUR U.S. SENATORS AND TO YOUR U.S. REPRESENTATIVE TO MAXIMIZE CHANCES OF RECEIVING A NOMINATION.

For the class entering an Academy in 2013, Congressman Sarbanes may submit 10 nominations for each vacancy. Each Academy makes the final selection from among the nominees.

It is important to note that a Senator or Representative can only <u>nominate</u> candidates to be considered for admission by the Academies. Admission itself is determined by each Academy through an established admission procedure, and those nominated must meet the Academy's requirements to receive further consideration.

IF YOU APPLIED FOR A NOMINATION LAST YEAR, YOU MUST RE-APPLY THIS YEAR AND COMPLETE A NEW APPLICATION.

Basic Academy Requirements

Each Academy has certain basic qualifications that all nominees must meet to be eligible for appointment. If you have not already filed a pre-candidate questionnaire with the Academy of interest to you, we suggest that you do so by visiting the appropriate website so that you may receive complete information on Academy requirements directly from the Academy.

For those persons interested in the U.S. Coast Guard Academy, application is made directly to the Academy. Nominations are not required. Among the basic Academy qualifications are the following:

- 1. Legal resident in Maryland's Third Congressional District
- 2. Citizen of the United States
- 3. Unmarried, not pregnant and have no legal obligation to support children or other dependents
- 4. As of entry date, applicant must be at least 17 years of age and less than 23 years of age
- 5. Competitive scores on the Writing, Verbal and Mathematics portions of the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT)
- 6. High academic standing in secondary school class (generally in the upper 20%)

- 7. First-rate medical condition and proper physical aptitude
- 8. Participation and achievement in organized athletics, student government, clubs, or other extracurricular activities
- Good moral character

Many factors --academic ability, moral character, leadership potential, physical fitness, etc. -enter into the judgment as to which of the candidates meeting the above criteria should be
nominated to the Academies. Competition is extremely keen and the objective is to identify
those young citizens who are most qualified for an Academy education and subsequent military
career.

Letters of Recommendation

Please have three persons who are not members of your family each submit a recommendation on your behalf. Individuals who have taught you and are familiar with your abilities should write two of the letters. It is your responsibility to obtain these letters and submit them in signed, sealed envelopes with your application packet.

Secondary School Academic Record

It is your responsibility to obtain and include an official transcript of your grades through June 2012 in your application packet.

Scholastic Aptitude Test

The service academies require applicants for admission take the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the ACT. Since the SAT is more widely used in this area, and in order to have a uniform standard, we require that you submit official SAT scores in order to be considered for nomination. Please direct the College Board Testing Service to send the results of your test directly to my office by using SAT College Board Code Number 5637.

THE OCTOBER TEST IS THE LAST DATE THAT IS ACCEPTABLE FOR PURPOSES OF THIS APPLICATION. You should be aware that registration for the test closes several weeks prior to the test date. Your secondary school counselor can assist you in arranging to take the test. Information on the SAT may be found on www.collegeboard.com. ACTs ARE NOT ACCEPTED.

Affidavit of Residence

The affidavit in the Application Packet must be completed by the applicant's parent, legal guardian, or applicant if he or she is over 18 years of age and **notarized**. This satisfies the statutory requirement that nominees are legal residents of the State of Maryland and live in Maryland's 3rd Congressional District.
