Extent

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2008-0002-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA request 2008-0002-F contains photographs from the White House Photograph Office. The collection includes contact sheets containing photographs of Hillary Clinton addressing the Redbook Magazine Awards luncheon in the East Room of the White House. Kate White, Editor of Redbook, introduces each honoree at the luncheon. Hillary Clinton presents awards to the honorees and joins the award winners for a group photo. One of the honorees is Senator Patty Murray. Hillary Clinton greets the event's participants in the Diplomatic Reception room. The contact sheets include views of White House Pastry Chef, Roland Mesnier, Franette McCullough, and staff with desserts made to look like teacups for the event.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office, and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
