

Eligibility Criteria for Wall of Gallantry Induction

- Nominee must be a graduate of the US Coast Guard Academy
- Nominee must have distinguished themselves in service to their country and be awarded one of the following:
 - (a) Medal of Honor
 - (b) Navy Cross
 - (c) Gold Medal of Congress
 - (d) Silver Star
 - (e) Legion of Merit (with combat “V”)
 - (f) Distinguished Flying Cross
 - (g) Coast Guard Medal
 - (h) Navy and Marine Corps Medal
 - (i) Gold Lifesaving Medal
 - (j) Bronze Star
 - (k) Silver Lifesaving Medal
 - (l) NASA Space Flight Medal

Graduates who do not meet the above criteria may still be eligible.

- All nominees must be submitted by April 15th of the previous year.

Procedure for Filling Out Nomination Form

- The name of the nominee should include the nominee’s rank at the end of their service.
- The year of graduation is the year the nominee graduated the US Coast Guard Academy.
- Career path and notable events should include a list of the nominee’s units and any major event that the nominee was involved in at each unit.
- Citation of distinguishing award is either the exact citation or comprehensive summary of the award that incurs the nominee’s eligibility to be placed on the Wall of Gallantry.
Note: except in rare circumstances, a copy of the citation is required for consideration.
