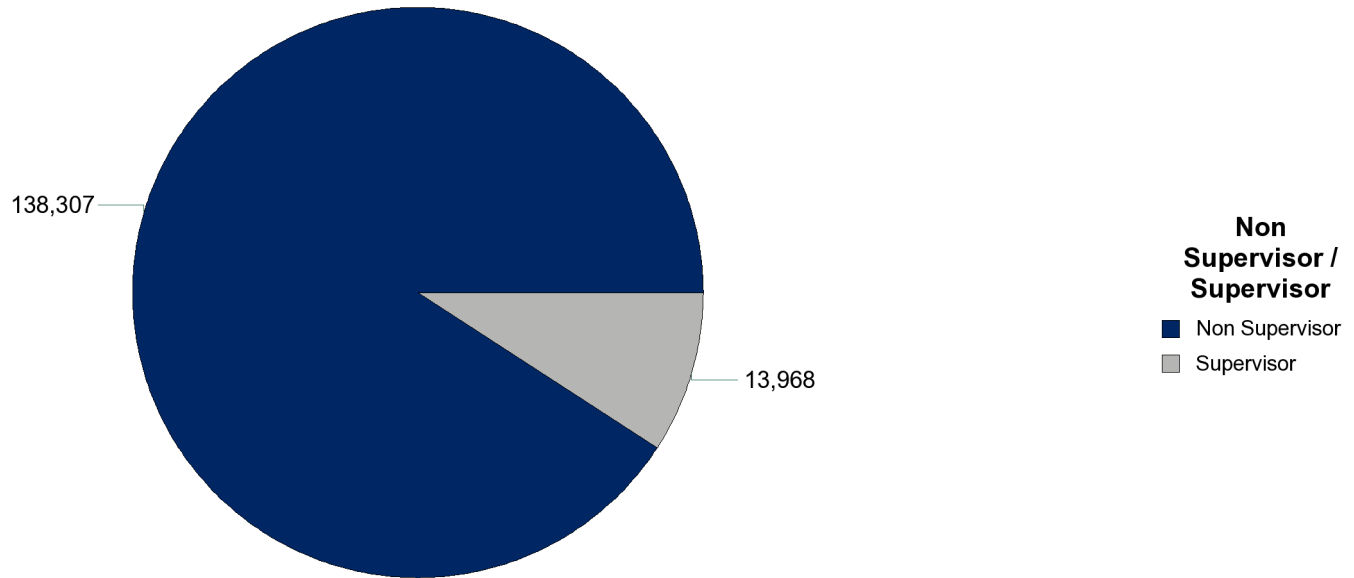

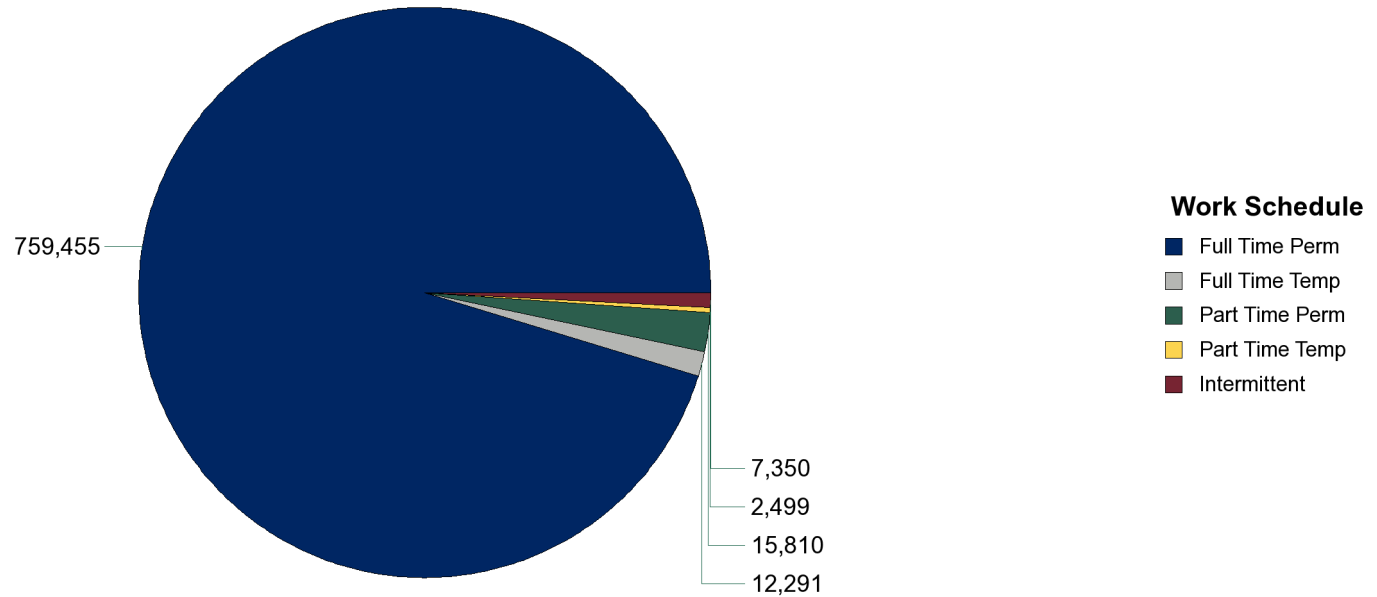
Blue Collar vs White Collar (Appropriated Fund)

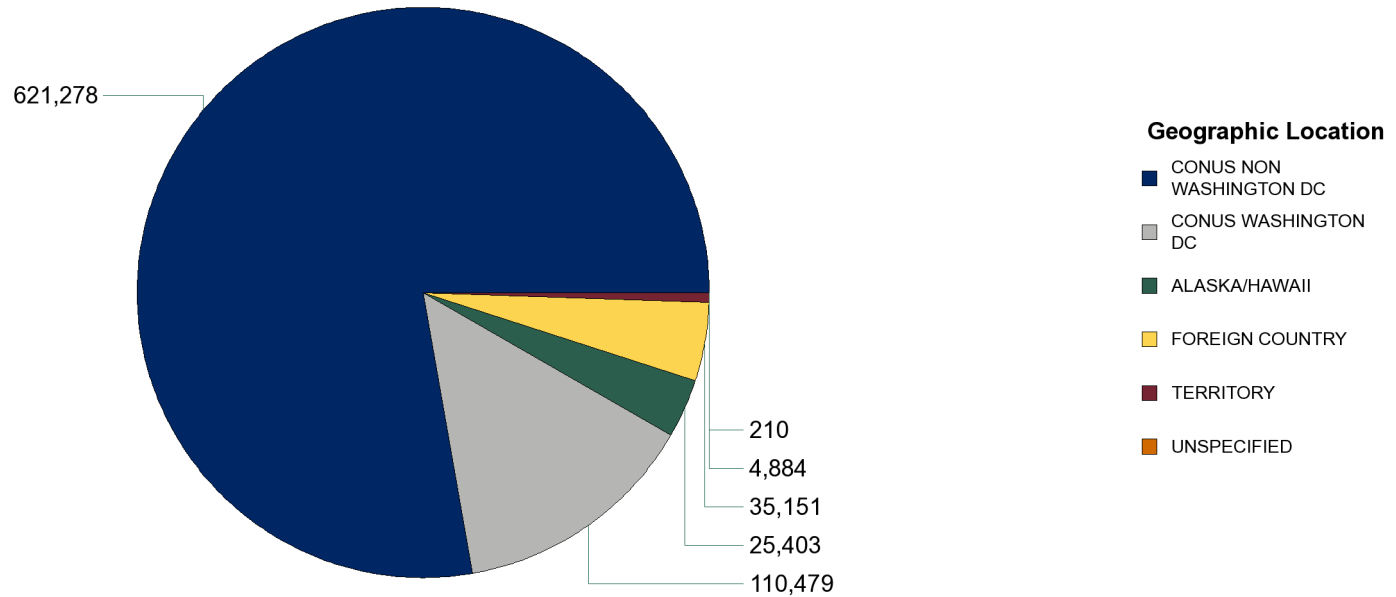

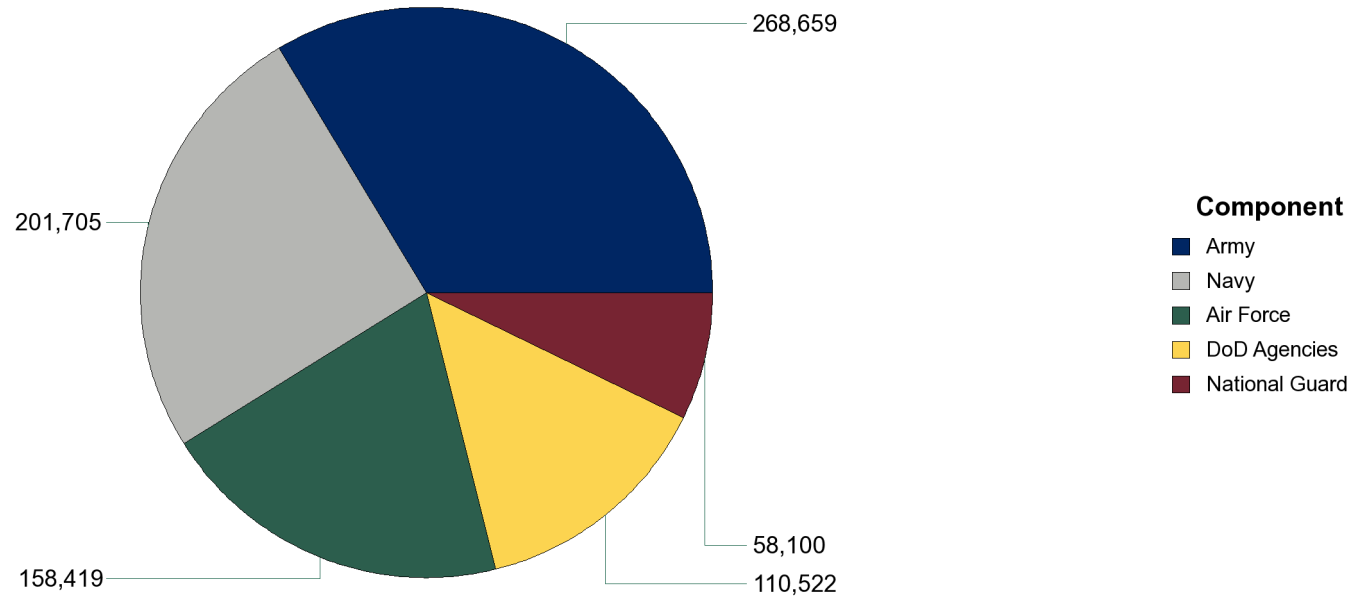

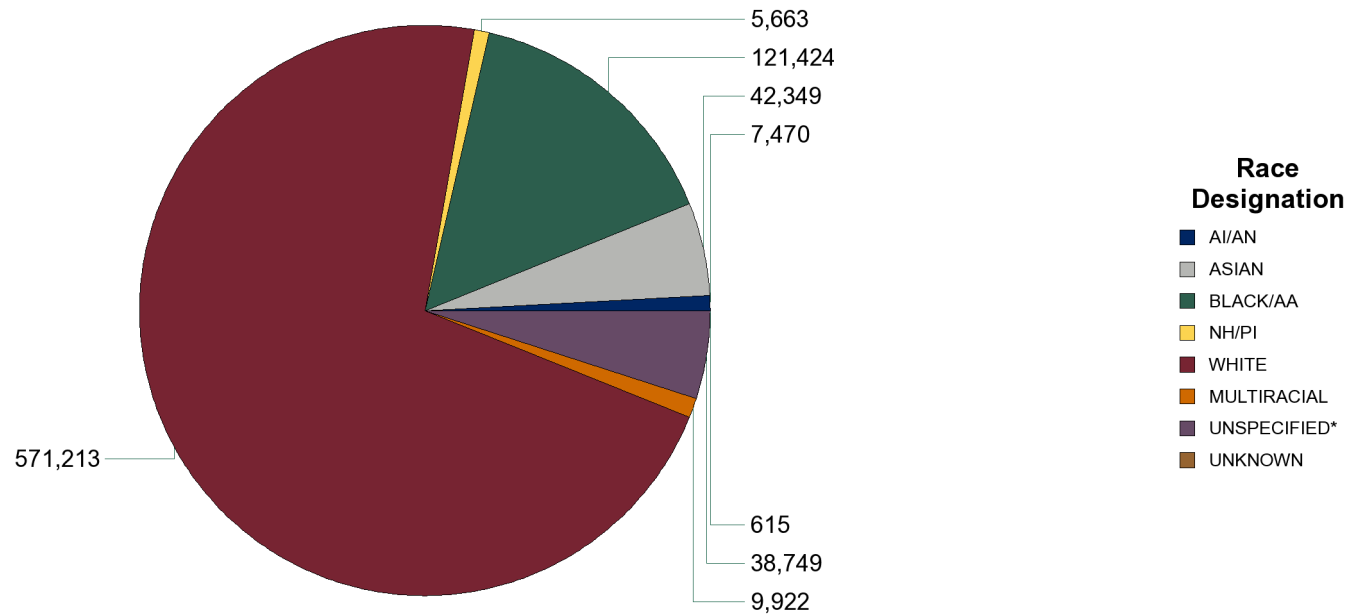

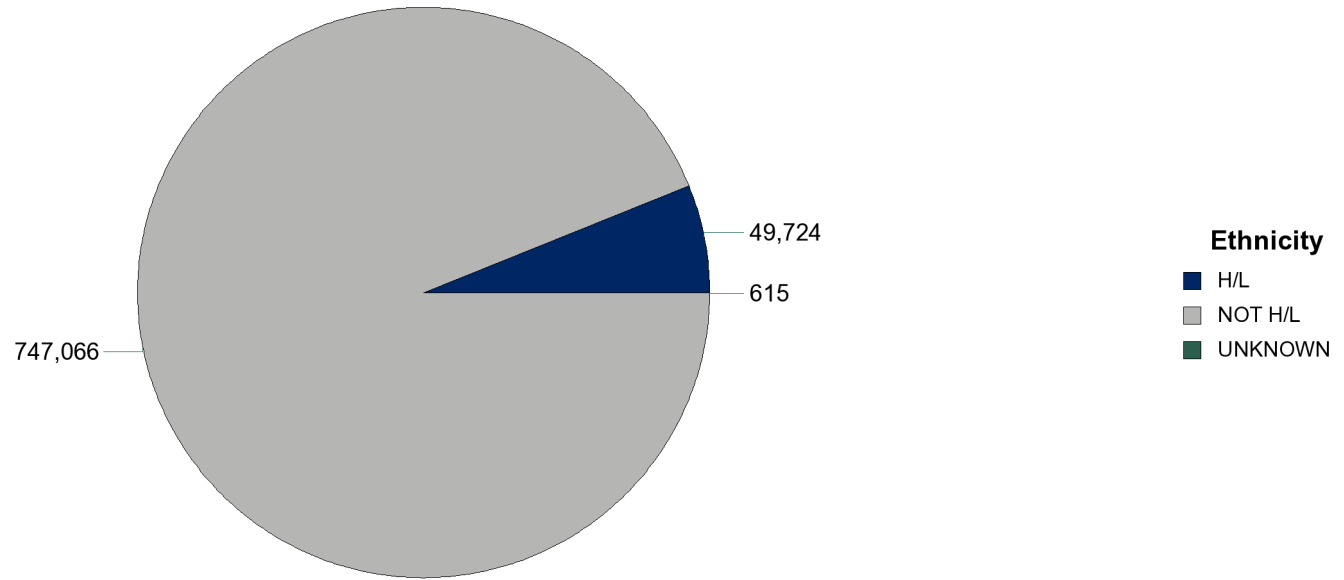

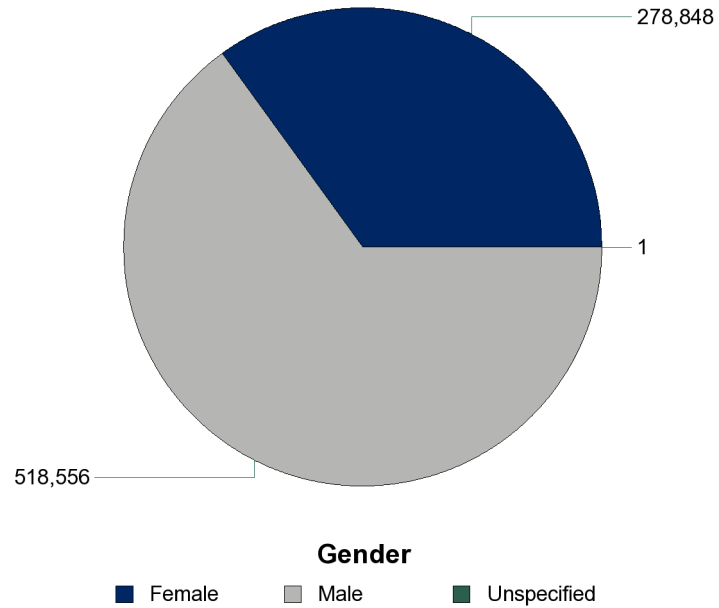

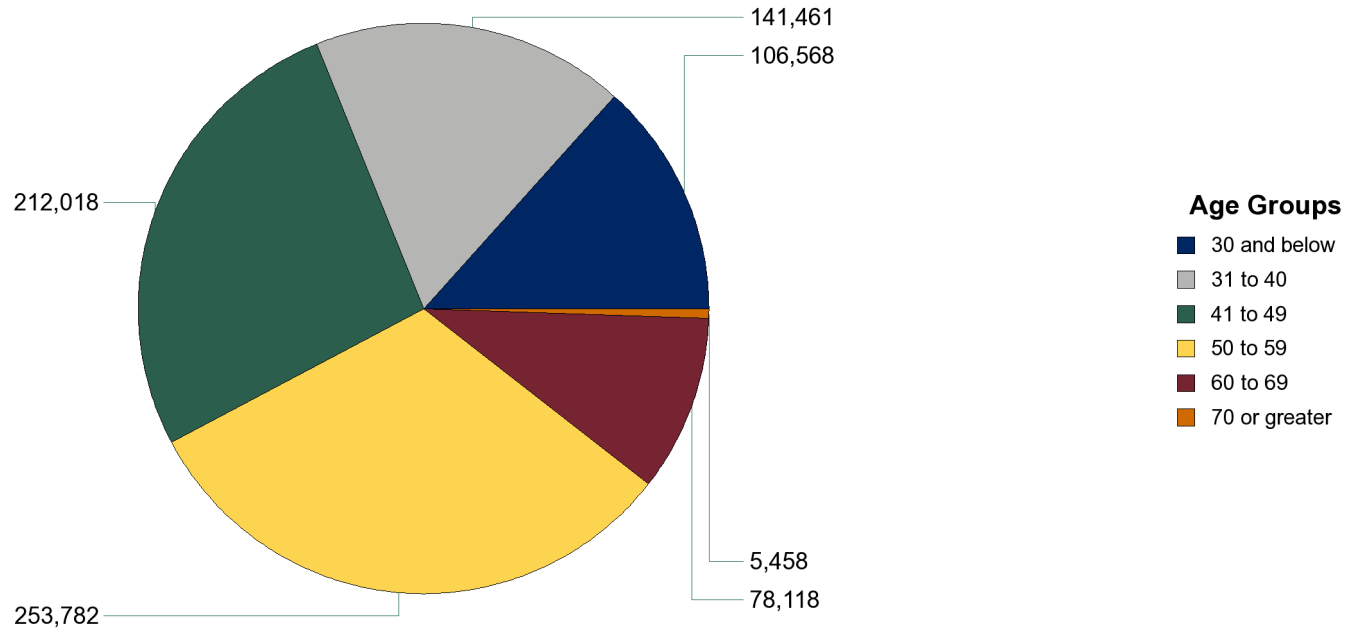
General Workforce Demographics - Gender (Appropriated Fund)

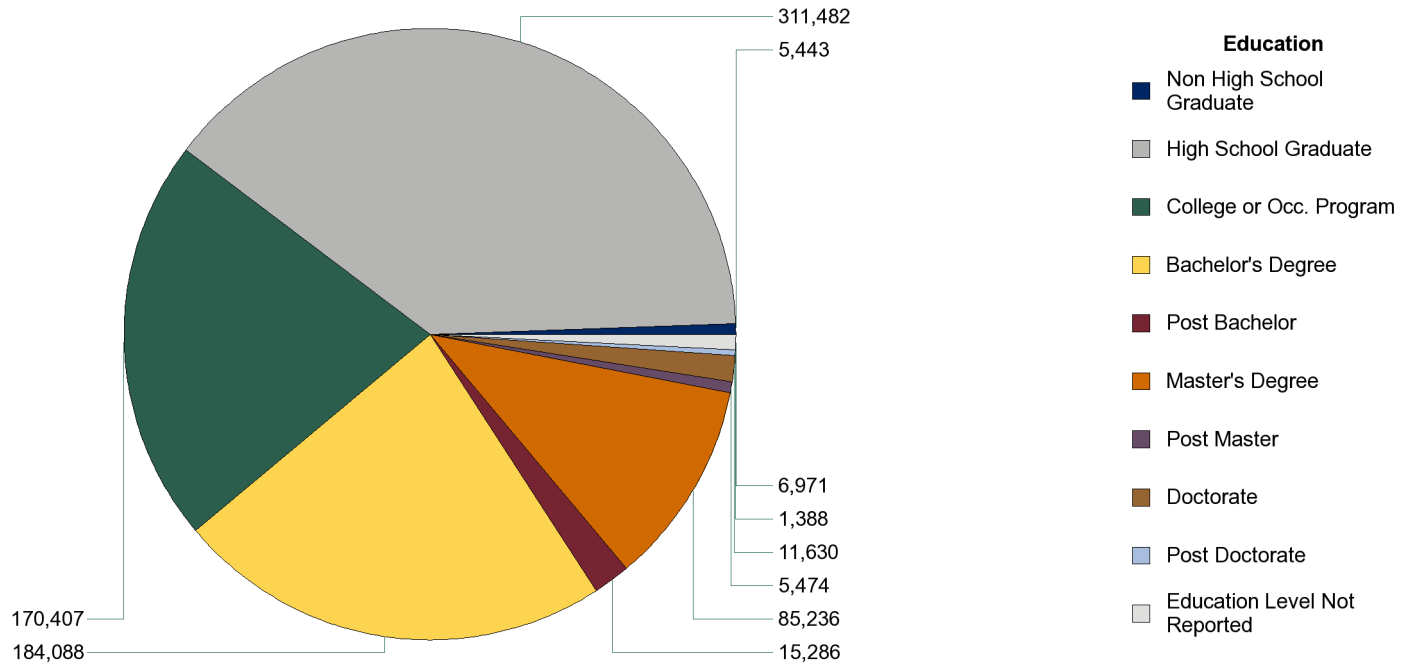

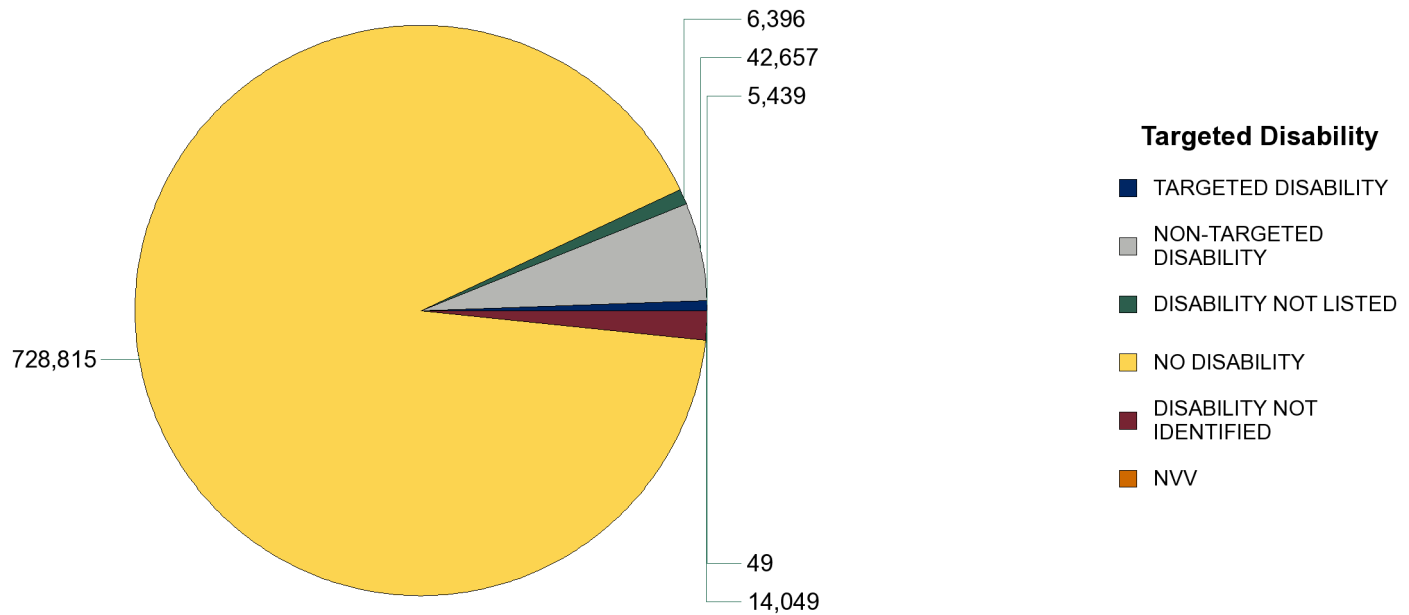

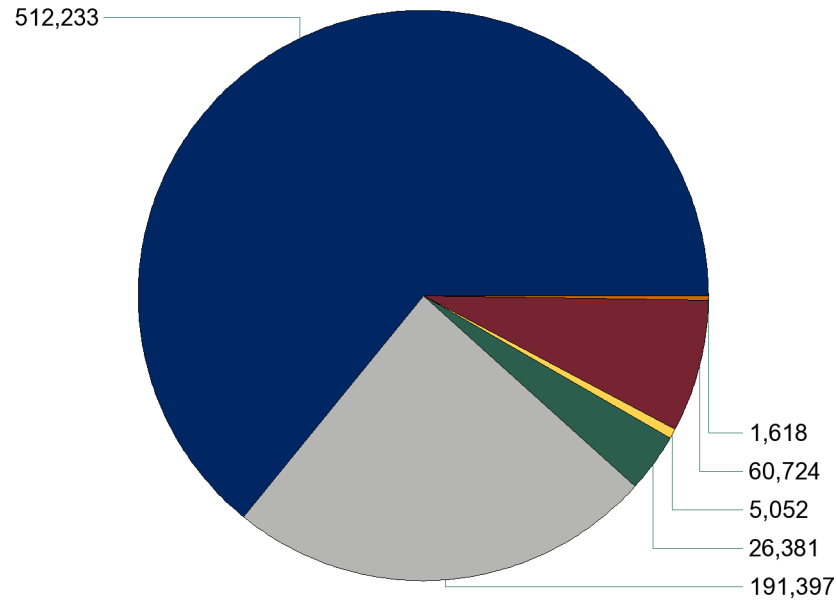

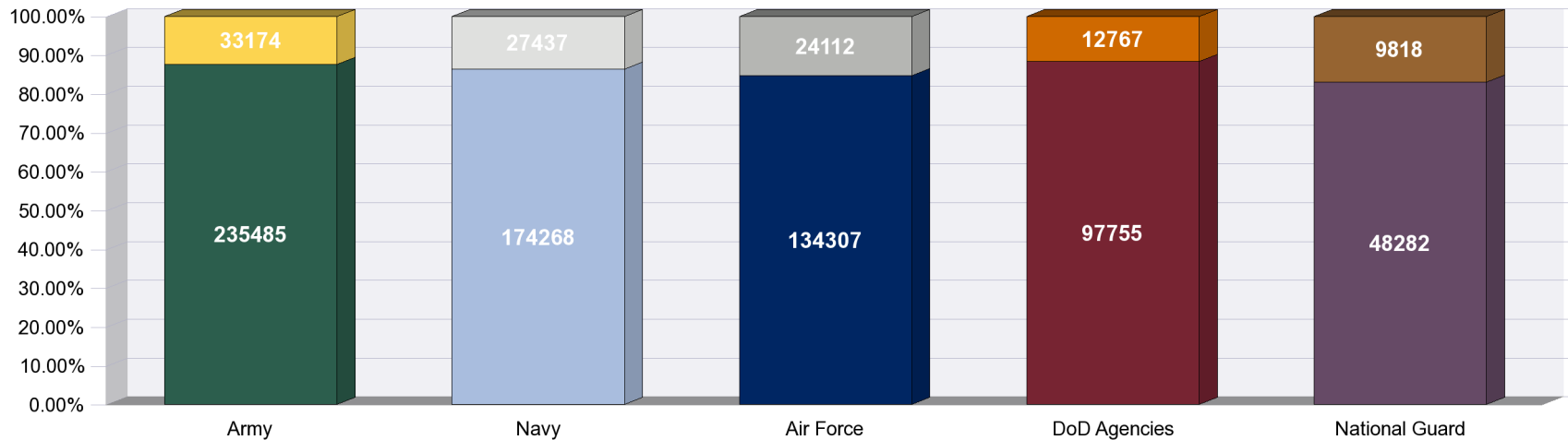

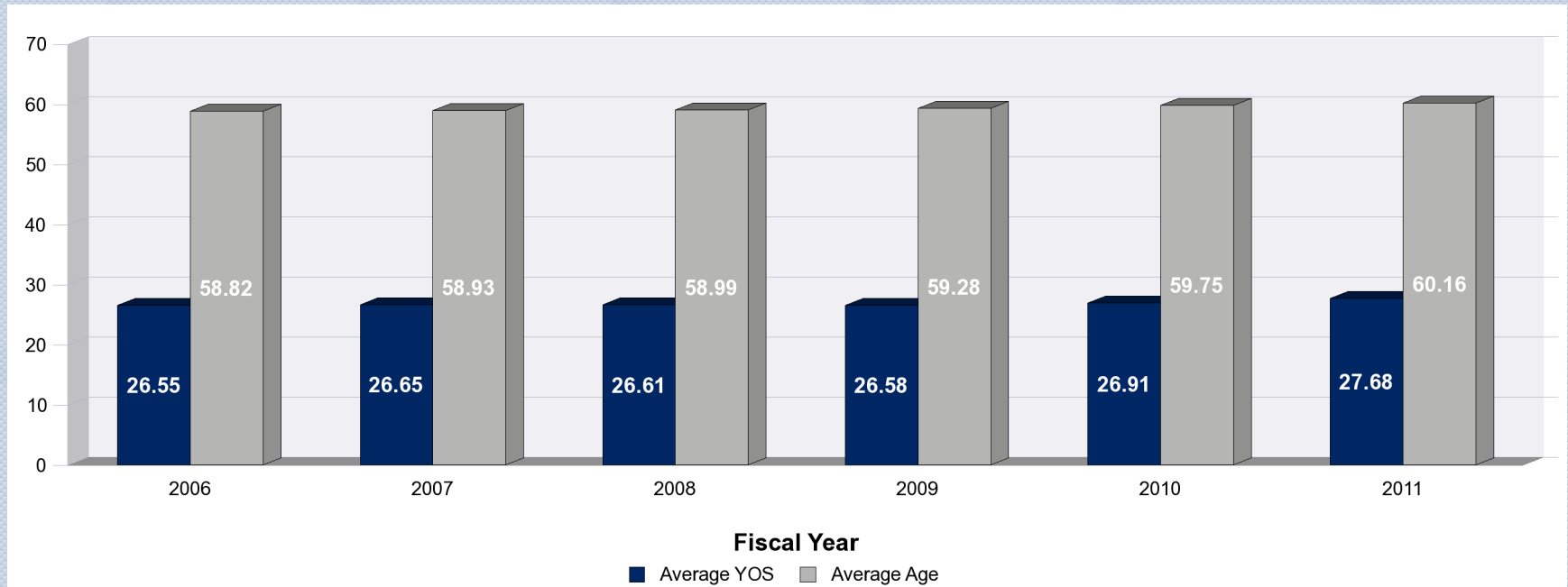
CSRS & FERS Optional Retirement Eligibility As of 05/31/2011 & 05/31/2016 (Appr Fund - Perm Employees)

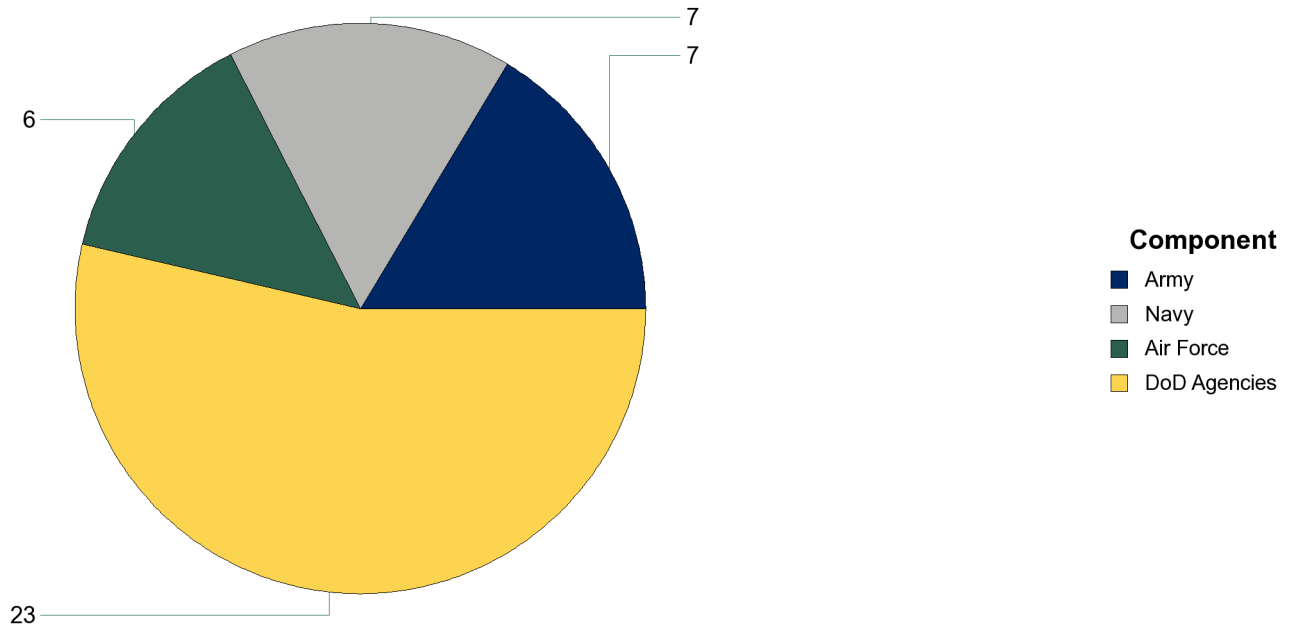

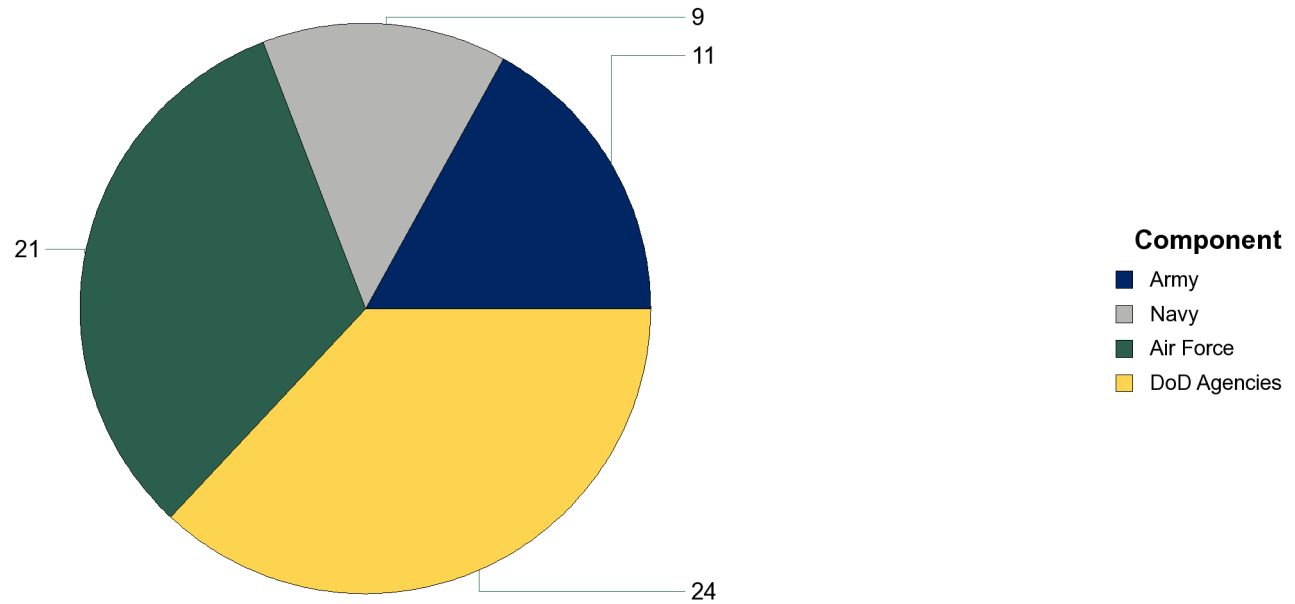
DoD Executive Pay by Component (Appropriated Fund)

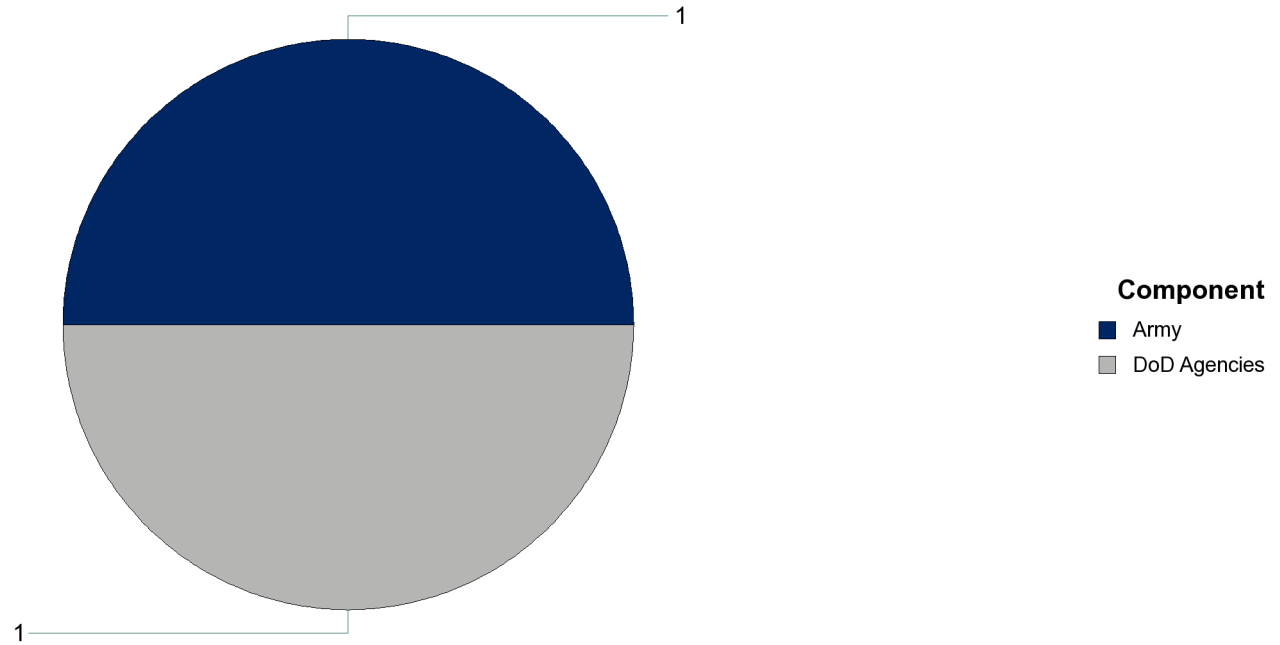

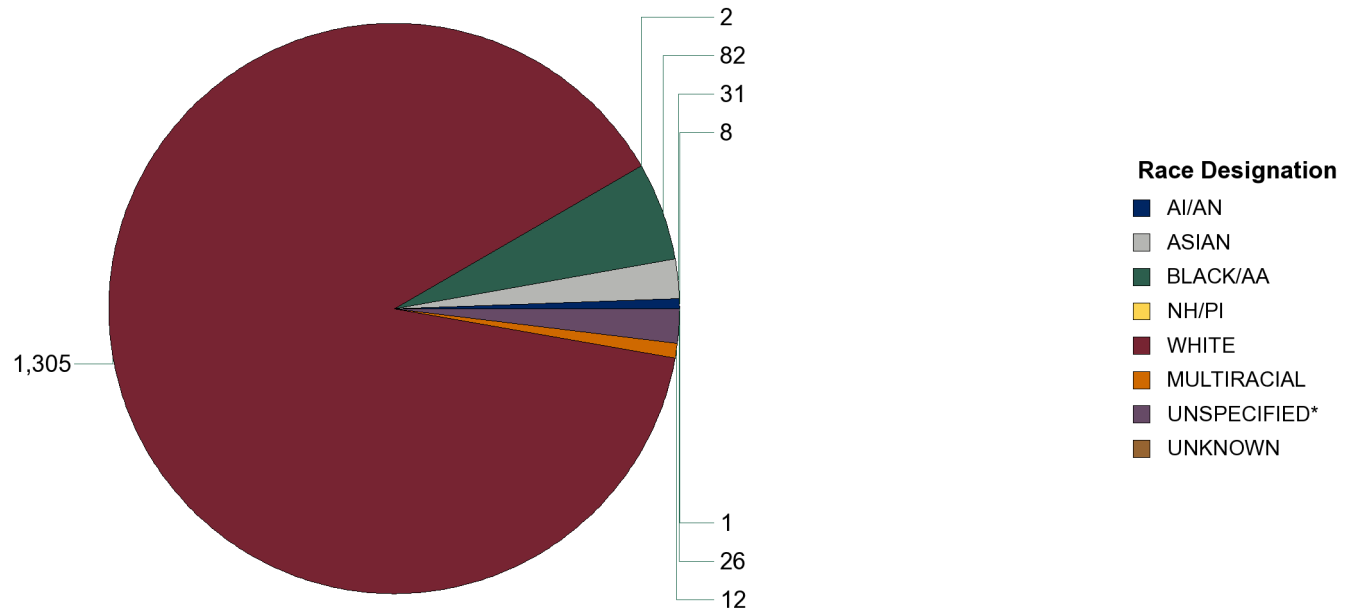
DoD Inspector General by Component (Appropriated Fund)

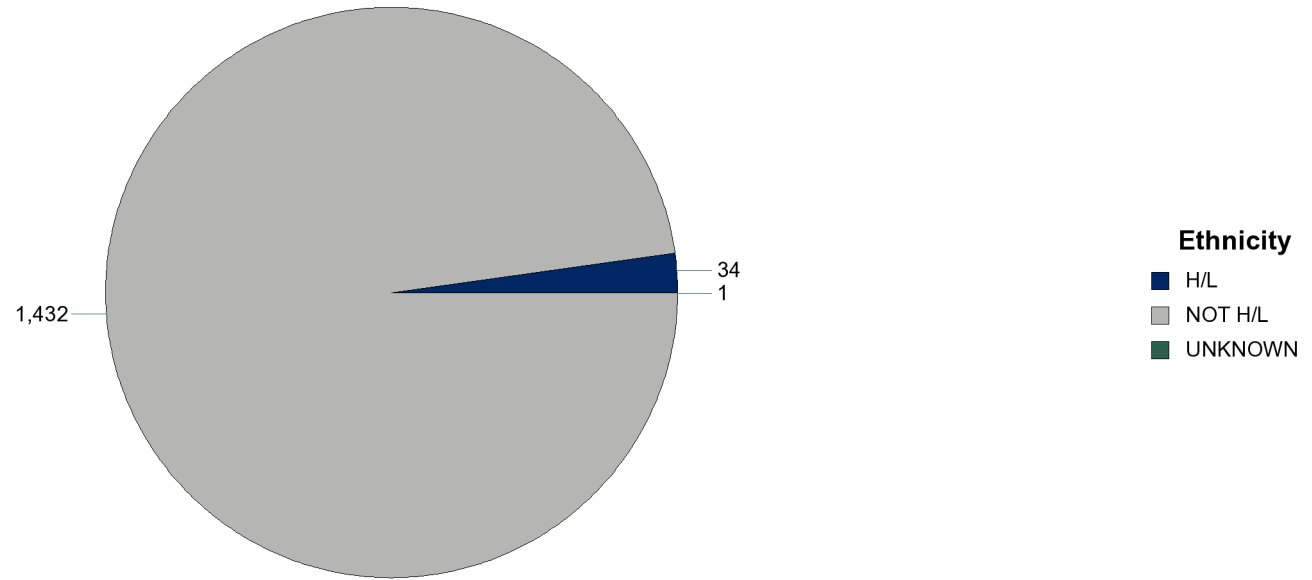

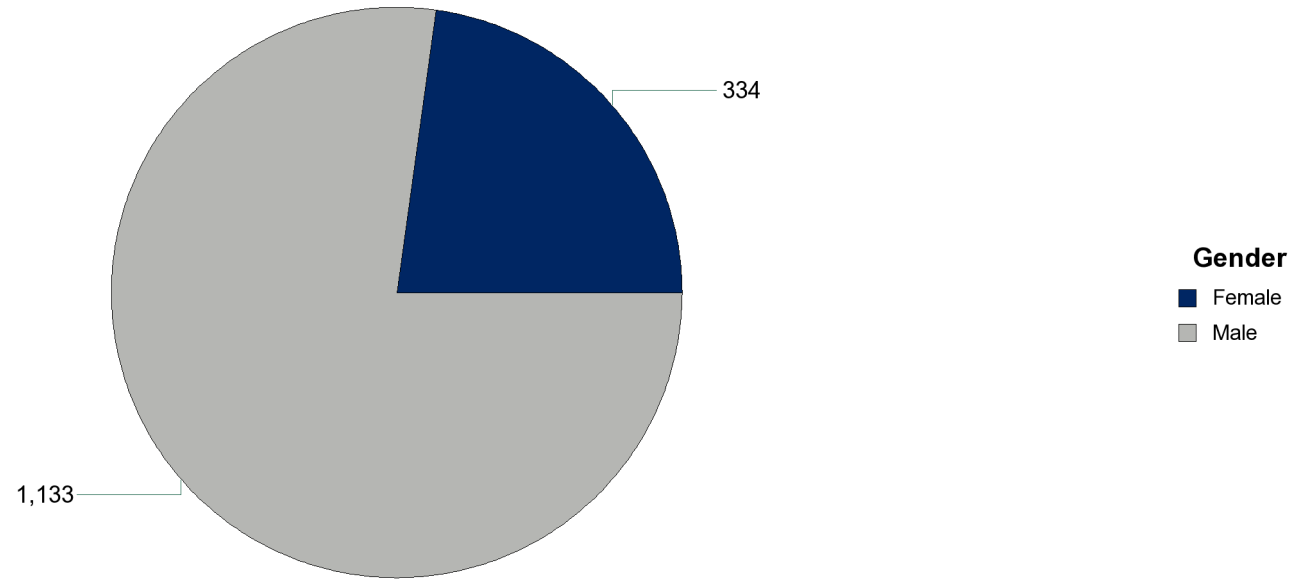

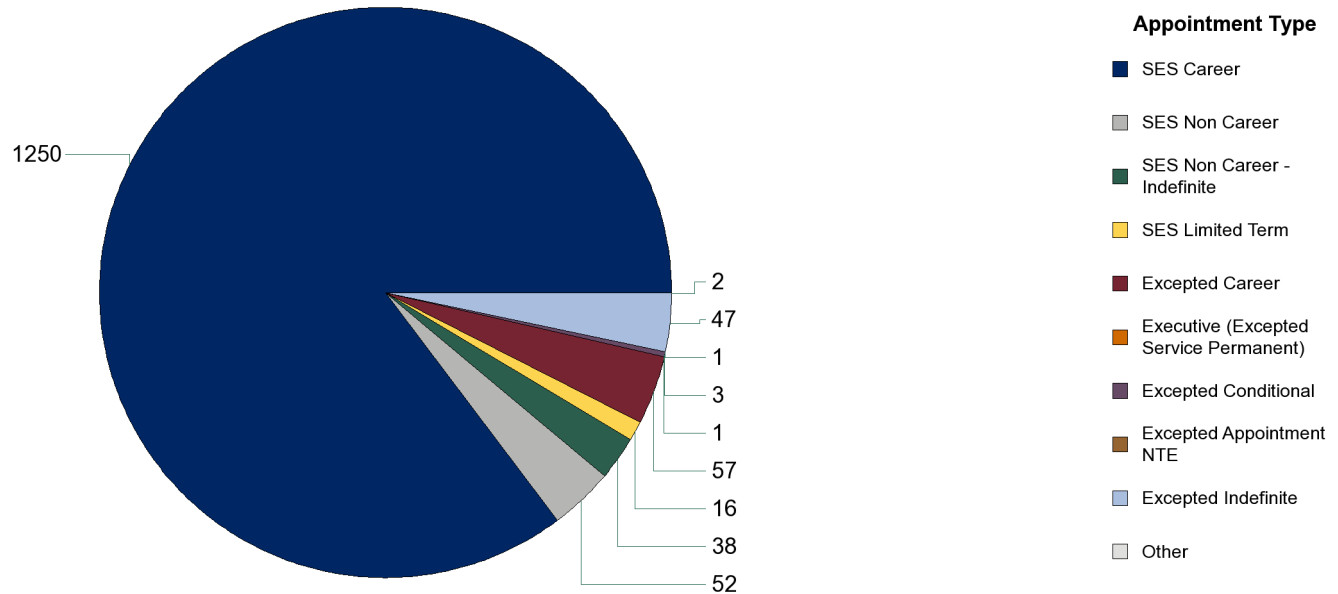
Executive Demographics - Gender (Appropriated Fund)

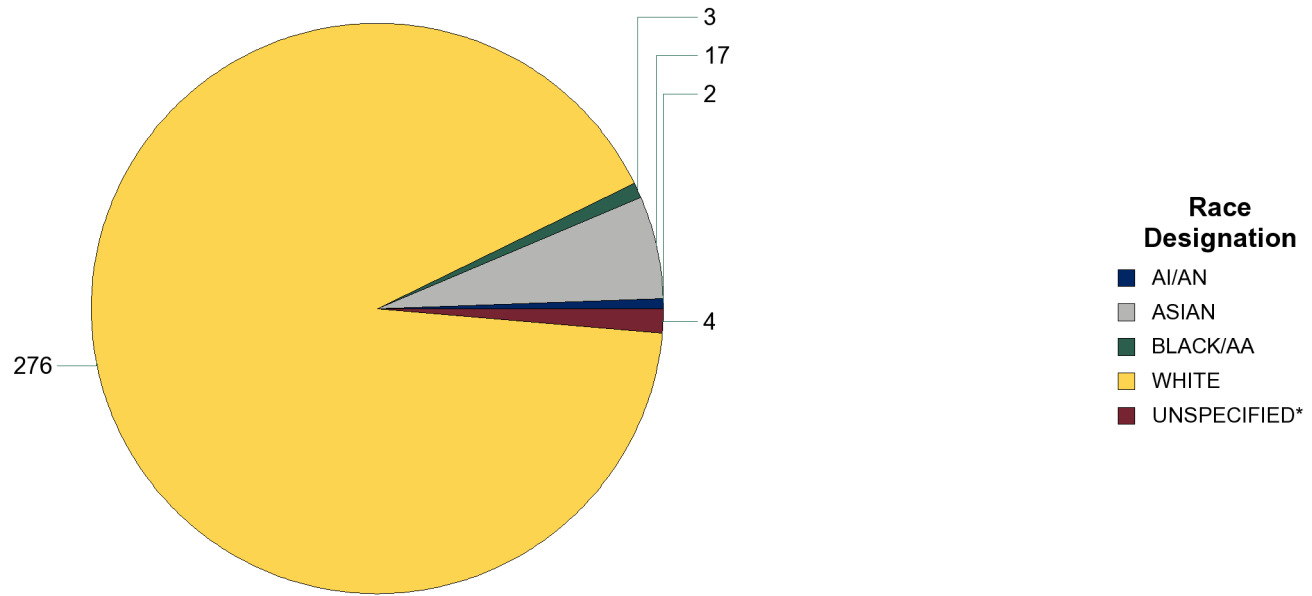
DoD Scientific and Professional by Component (Appropriated Fund)

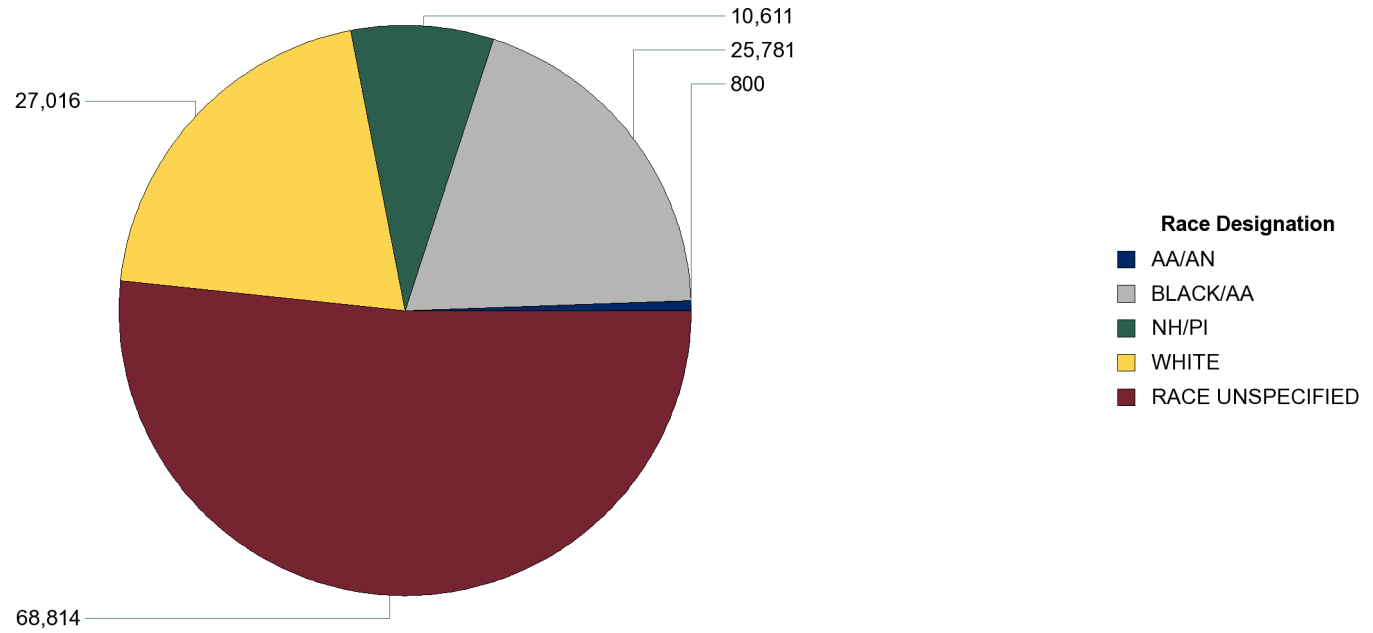

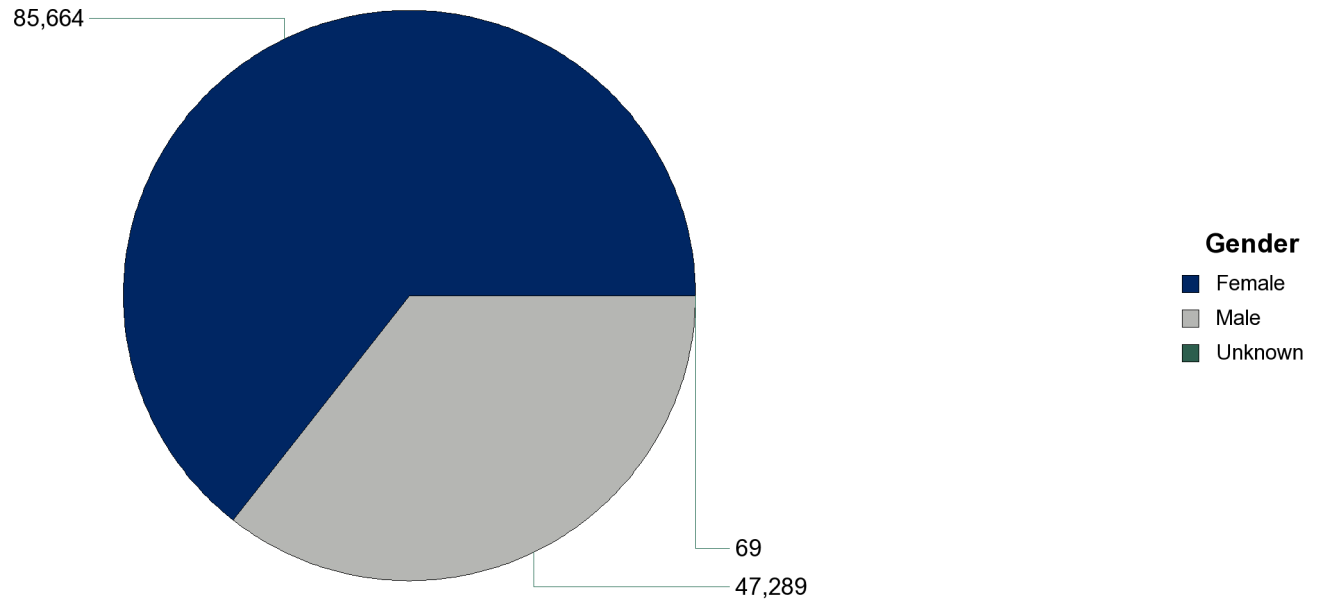
Non Appropriated Fund Ethnicity

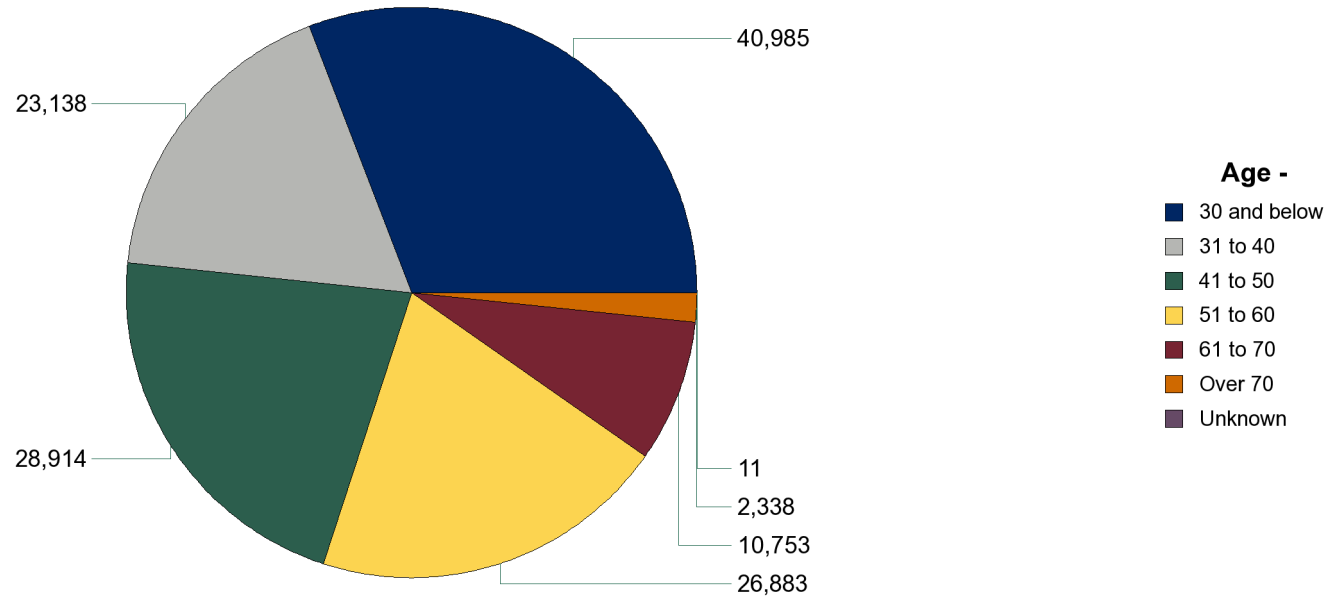
Non Appropriated Fund Gender

Non Appropriated Fund by Age

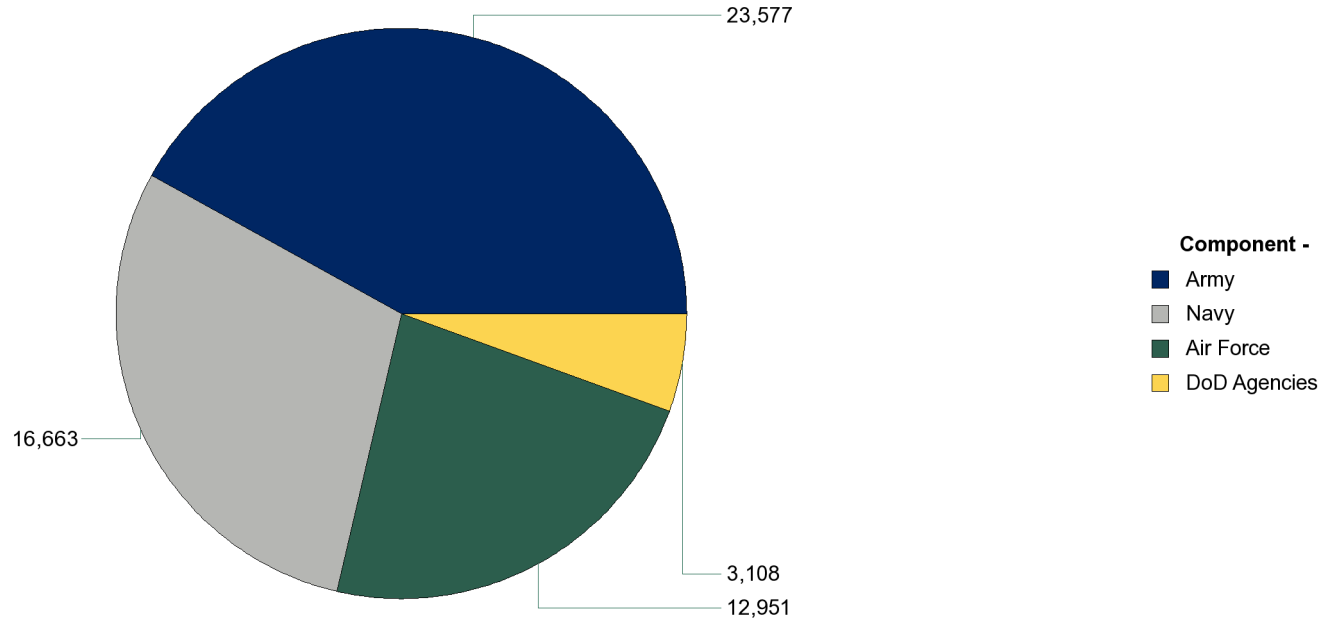

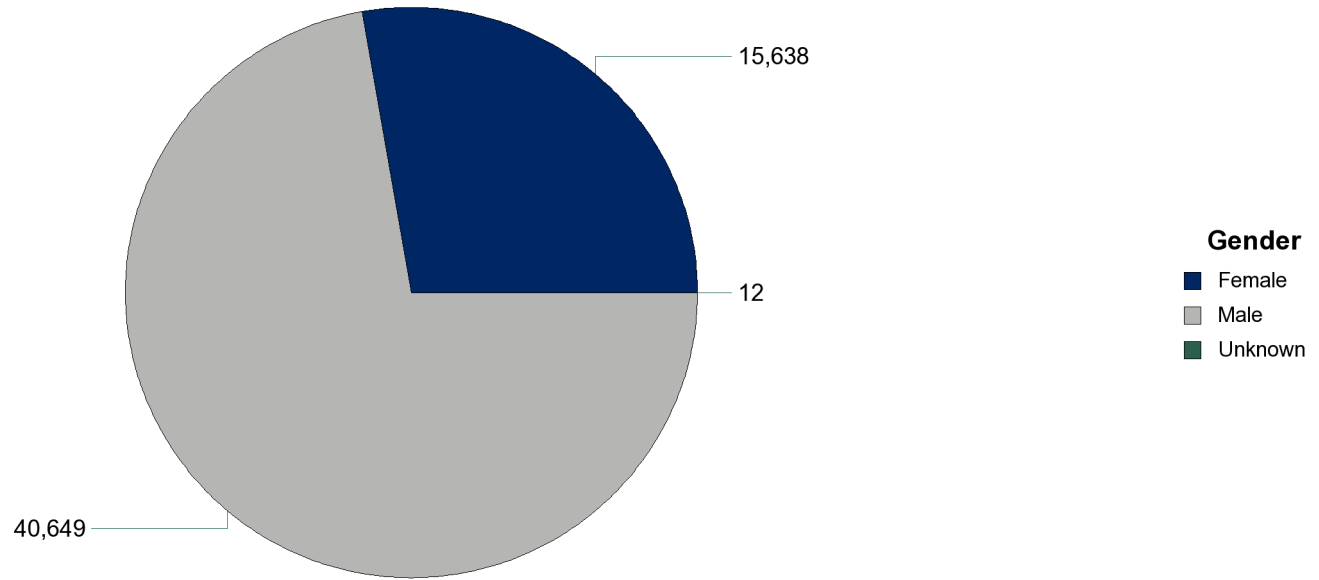

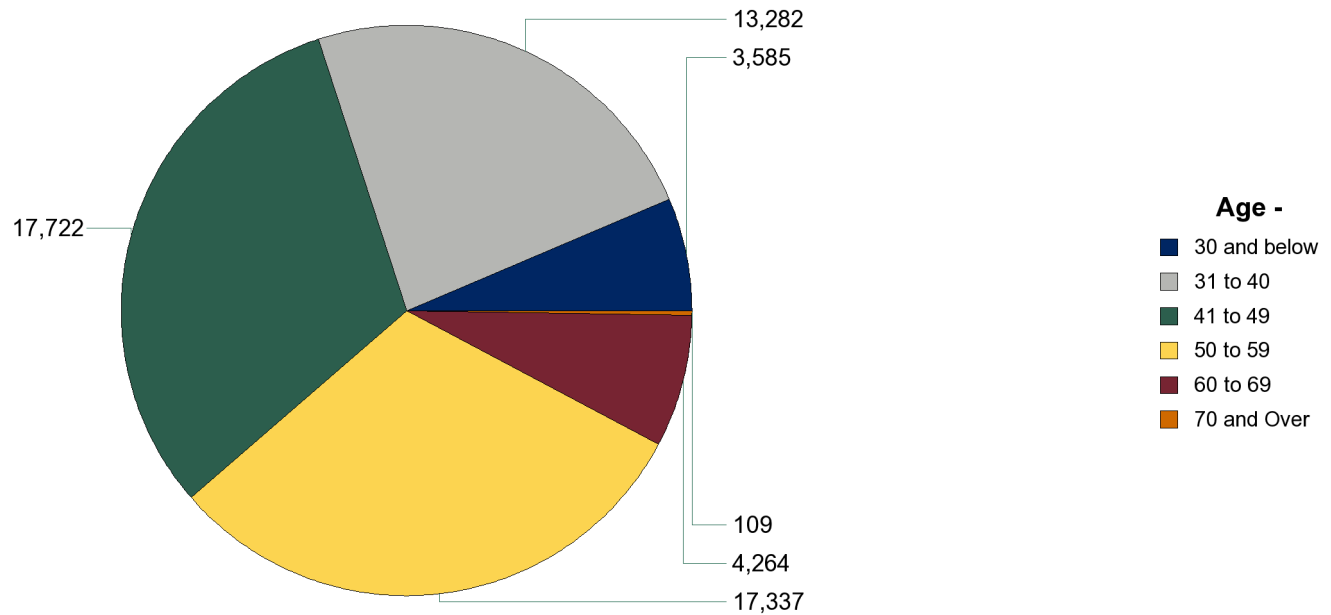
Local National Employees by Gender

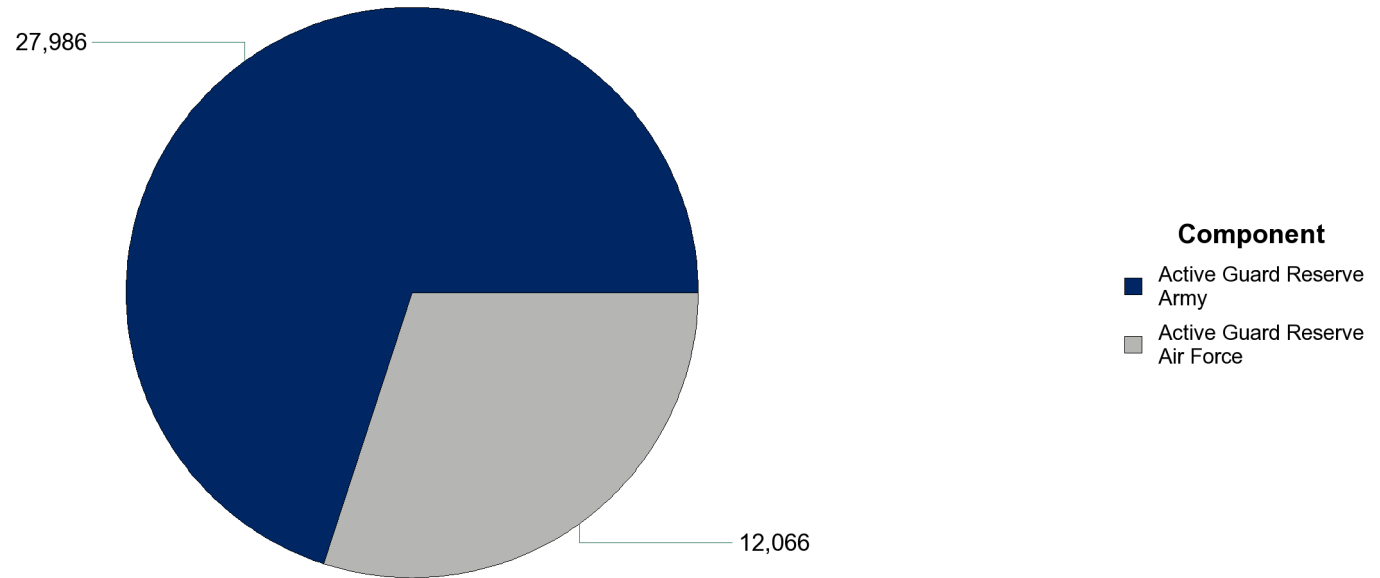

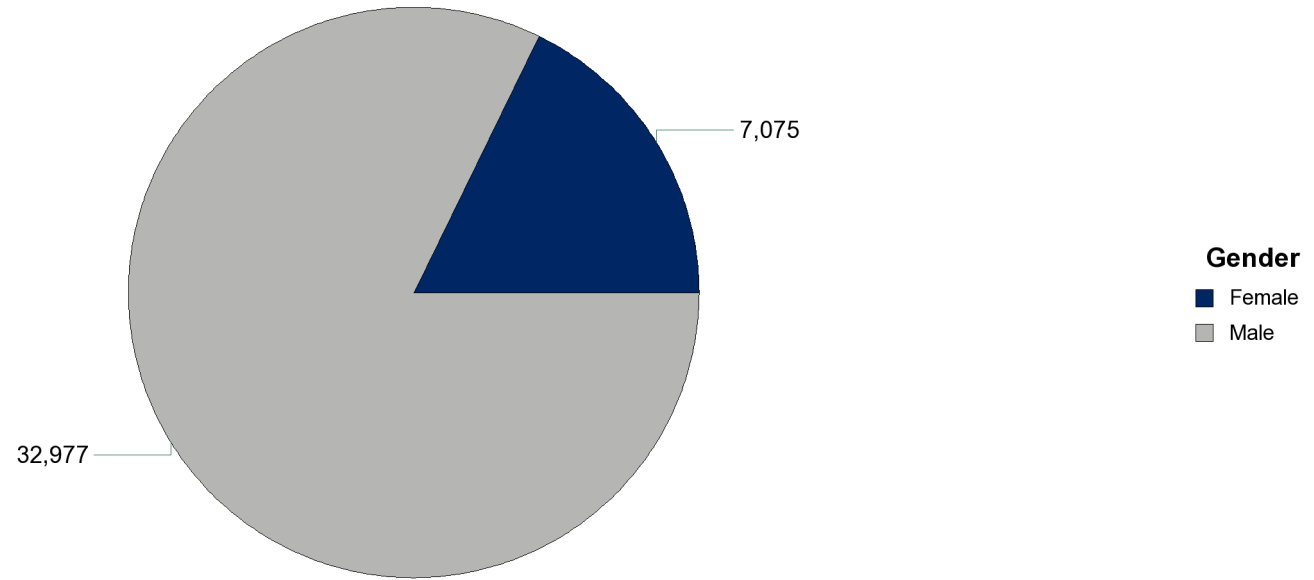
Active Guard Reserve by Component

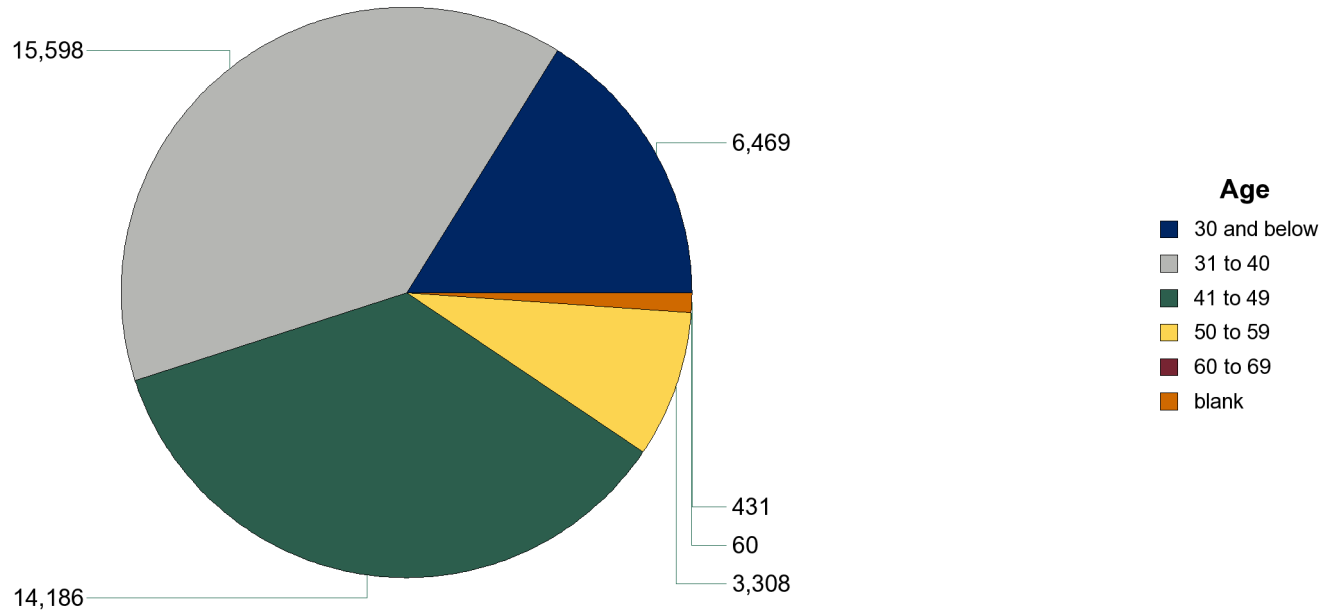
Active Guard Reserve by Gender
