

MOTION TO RECOMMIT
OFFERED BY MR. RAHALL OF WEST VIRGINIA

Mr. Rahall of West Virginia moves to recommit the bill, H.R. 2553, to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 7. BAGGAGE FEES FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARMED**
2 **FORCES.**

3 (a) FEES.—No air carrier may charge any fee for the
4 transport of 4 or fewer items of baggage checked by a
5 member of the Armed Forces who is—

6 (1) traveling in scheduled air transportation on
7 official military orders; and

8 (2) being deployed on or returning from an
9 overseas contingency operation.

10 (b) DEFINITION.—For purposes of this section, the
11 term “baggage” does not include an item whose weight
12 exceeds 80 pounds.
