Airport Certification Information Bulletin (ACIB) 2012-08

Subject: Temporary Closure of ARFF Live-Fire Training Facility at Chicago O'Hare International Airport.



The Chicago O'Hare International Airport (ORD) fire training facility will be closed for upgrades and improvements beginning on September 1, 2012 and will remain closed through the winter season. Any airport that may have normally scheduled their live-fire training during this period will need to seek out an alternate training location.
