Purpose of Modification:

1. The following change is being made pursuant to FAR 52.243-2, Changes-Cost Reimbursement (AUG 1987):

The Contractor is hereby authorized to incur costs, not to exceed \$1,000,000.00, to begin work on the active double shell tanks (DST) primary ventilation systems. WRPS is directed to complete work on the DST Primary Ventilation Systems as follows:

As a safety improvement in the Hanford Tank Farms, the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of River Protection (ORP) is providing the following direction to the Washington River Protection Solutions, LLC (WRPS), the Tank Operations Contractor (TOC). This direction addresses concerns identified by the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board on the importance of maintaining active primary ventilation of the double-shell tanks (DST). This direction is divided into two phases. The first phase covers near-term changes to the current control strategy by revising the safety classification of the DST primary ventilation systems, while the second phase long-term control strategy identifies the necessary planned upgrades to the DST primary ventilation systems required to support future operation of DST mixer pumps.

Phase One: WRPS is directed to submit a Safety Basis amendment by the end of June 2011 to designate the existing DST primary ventilation systems as safety significant. Adequate primary tank ventilation for flammable gas hazards shall be assured by the measurement of the ventilation flow rate for each of the 28 DSTs. Furthermore, WRPS is directed to provide a gap analysis to support the amendment. The gap analysis shall identify those components/systems that define the safety significant boundary within the existing system design. The gap analysis shall also identify differences between the functional/performance requirements for the systems to perform their safety function and the existing system designs. The gap analysis shall include planned design improvements to support retrofit system upgrades to the DST primary ventilation system. One expected difference is the requirement for a backup power system on the existing DST primary ventilation systems. Therefore, WRPS is directed to procure and install backup power systems as a planned improvement to increase system reliability by the end of February 2012.

Phase Two: WRPS is directed to upgrade the DST primary ventilation systems as necessary to support future DST mixer pump operations. Necessary changes to the DST primary ventilation systems will be identified during control development for use of the DST mixer pumps. Required DST primary ventilation system upgrades will be implemented prior to mixer pump operation.

- 2. WRPS shall submit cost and technical proposals, identified as Phase One and Phase Two, for these directed changes. The proposals shall include costs for implementing the new DST ventilation systems strategy including new scope, additional equipment, accelerating the schedule for upgrading existing DST ventilation systems and installing new systems, increased maintenance requirements, and updating procedures. The Phase One proposal is due by March 31, 2011.
 - ORP recognizes that the functional requirements needed for Phase Two may not yet be available to support a proposal. Thus WRPS is requested to submit a proposal implementing the direction given for Phase Two as the information becomes available..
- 3. The scheduled date to definitize Phase One of this change order is no later than August 25, 2011.
- 4. All other Terms and Conditions remain unchanged.
