

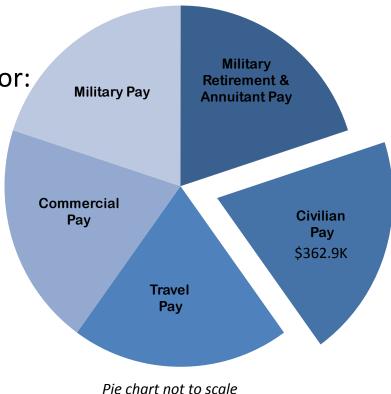
Department of Defense High Dollar Improper Payments Quarter 3, Fiscal Year 2011

What is a high dollar improper payment?

- For payments to individuals, a high dollar improper payment is when the amount paid is \$5,000 or greater and more than 50% higher than the correct amount
- For payments to entities, a high dollar improper payment is when the amount paid is \$25,000 or greater and more than 50% than the correct amount

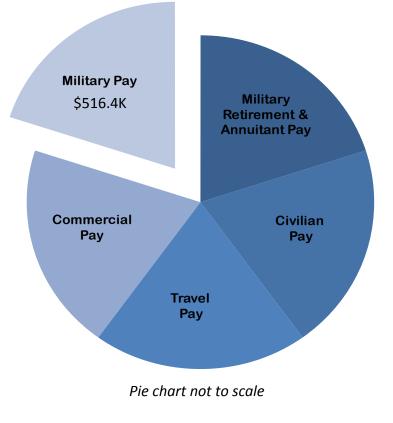
DoD Civilian Pay Quarter 3, FY 2011 Reasons for High Dollar Overpayments

- Late receipt of entitlement changes (\$362.9K)
- Payees continued to receive entitlements for:
 - Base Pay: 26% (\$94.3K)
 - Leave: 26% (\$94.3K)
 - Incentive: 22.2% (\$80.6K)
 - Other: 18.4% (\$66.8)
 - Living Qtrs. Allowance: 7.4% (\$26.9K)



DoD Military Pay Quarter 3, FY 2011 Reasons for High Dollar Overpayments

- Change in Active/Reserve status (\$516.4K)
 - Basic Allowance for Housing 87% (\$449.3K)
 - Basic Pay
 6% (\$31K)
 - Basic Allowance for Subsistence 5% (25.8K)
 - Miscellaneous errors
 2% (\$10.3K)

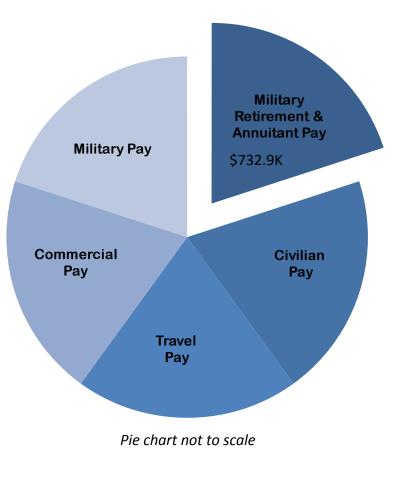


DoD Military Retiree & Annuitant Pay Quarter 3, FY 2011 Reasons for High Dollar Overpayments

- Retiree/Annuitant death occurs after monthly entitlement is processed (\$720.3K)
 - Death certificate received late 65% (\$468.2K)
 - Death certificate not received 35% (\$252.1K)

(Death notification most often obtained through Social Security Administration file match)

 Rapid recoupment due to ability to electronically pull back payment in some cases



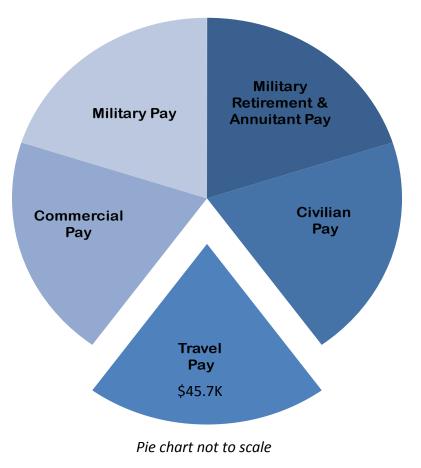
DoD Travel Pay Quarter 3, FY 2011 Top Reason for High Dollar Overpayments

- Traveler mistakenly reimbursed through more than one travel system (\$45.7K)
 - Duplicate Payments: 86% (\$39.3K) When traveler is reimbursed from more than one payment system
 - Missing documentation: 7% (\$3.2K)

Traveler did not attach receipts – remains an overpayment until documentation received

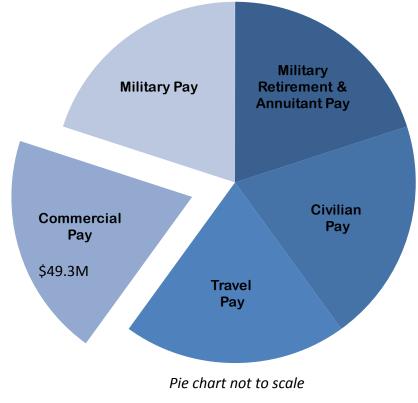
• Per diem: 7% (\$3.2K)

Actual lodging is less than standard per diem rate and results in an overpayment



DoD Commercial Pay Quarter 3, FY 2011 Top Reasons for High Dollar Overpayments

- Contract and Vendor Pay disbursements for both DFAS and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (\$49.3M)
 - DoD Data Entry Error: 52.3% (\$25.8M)
 - Progress payment calculation error (under-recoupment): 19.9% (\$9.8M)
 - Contractor Billing Error: 15% (\$7.4M)
 - Miscellaneous errors: 12.8% (\$6.3M)



Additional Information on Recoupment Efforts

- A debt for an overpayment is established as soon as it is identified
- Collection of overpayments continues until the debt is satisfied
- Commercial overpayments can be recaptured quickly if a pending invoice from the same firm is available for offset

Causes / Corrective Actions

Cause:

- Data Entry errors
- Billing errors

Correction:

- Training and monitoring
- Improve contractor interface for proper invoice submission

 Progress payment calculation errors

• Simplify contract terms to eliminate manual calculations
