ONLINE REGISTRATION OPEN FOR FUEL CYCLE INFORMATION EXCHANGE, JUNE 12-13 IN ROCKVILLE, MD.

Online registration is open for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's 7th Annual Fuel Cycle Information Exchange (FCIX), to be held June 12-13 at the agency's headquarters in Rockville, Md.

NRC Chairman Gregory B. Jaczko will deliver a keynote address on June 12. The theme of this year's FCIX is "The Nuclear Fuel Cycle: Ensuring Safety and Security in a Dynamic Environment." Topics to be covered include enhancements to the fuel cycle oversight process; improving safety culture; industry perspectives; and rulemakings that will affect fuel cycle facilities.

The FCIX will run from 9:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day, in the NRC Auditorium. Visitors will need to enter at the agency's One White Flint North building, 11555 Rockville Pike, in Rockville. More information about the conference, including online registration, is available on the NRC website.
