



Hazardous Fuels Reduction Contract Pre-Bid Workshop



The Bureau of Land Management, National Park Service, Fish & Wildlife Service, and U.S. Forest Service plan to issue multiple contracts for a wide range of fuels management reduction work to reduce the risk of wildland fires. To help potential contractors understand this solicitation, pre-bid conferences have been scheduled. The contract includes slashing, girdling, lop and scatter, thinning, selective slashing, pruning, fuel modification zone construction, hand piling and cover, fire line construction and maintenance, fuels pullback, snag felling, roadblock removal/restoration, mastication, chipping, crushing, chaining, herbicide application, and seeding.
