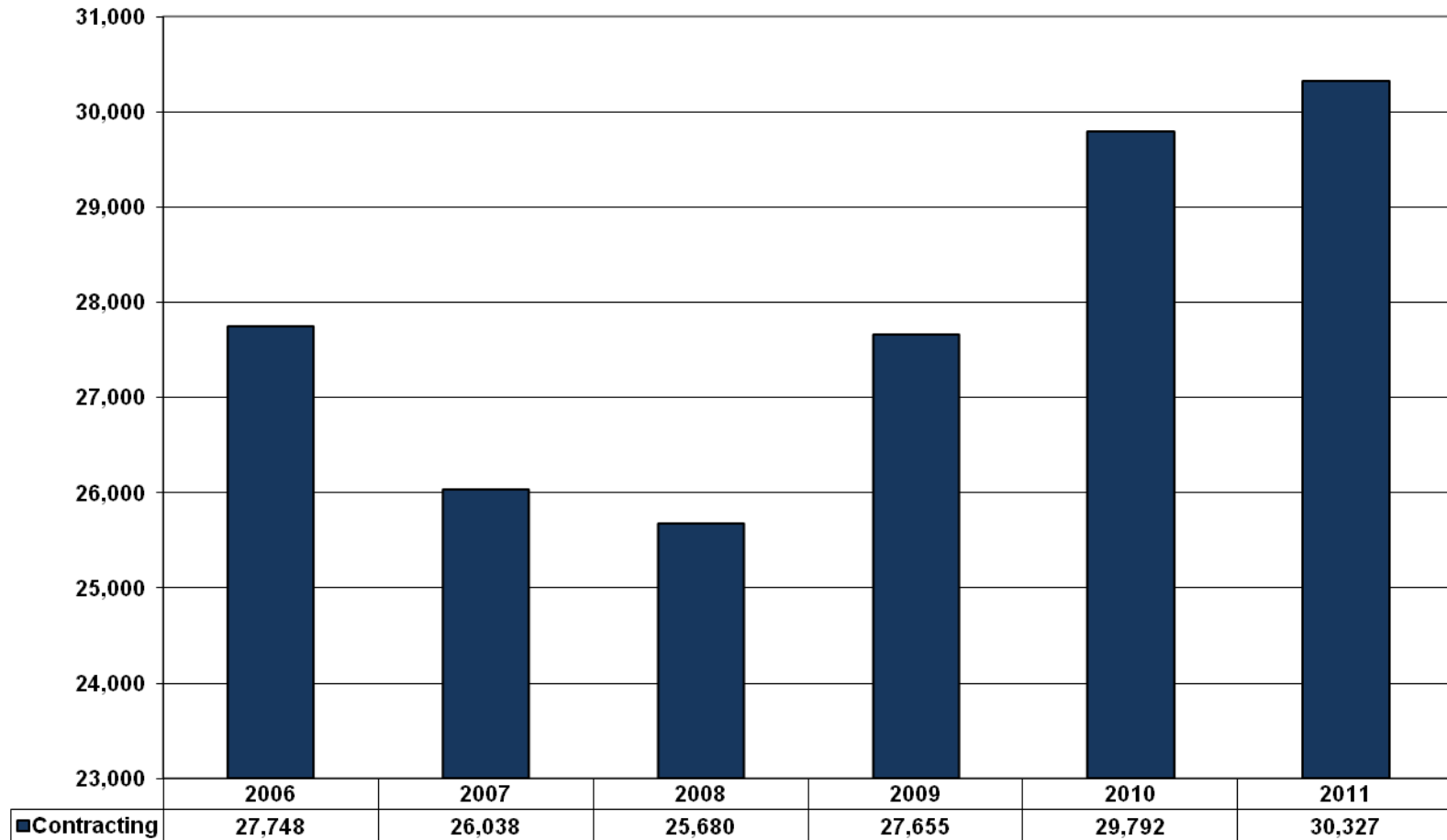

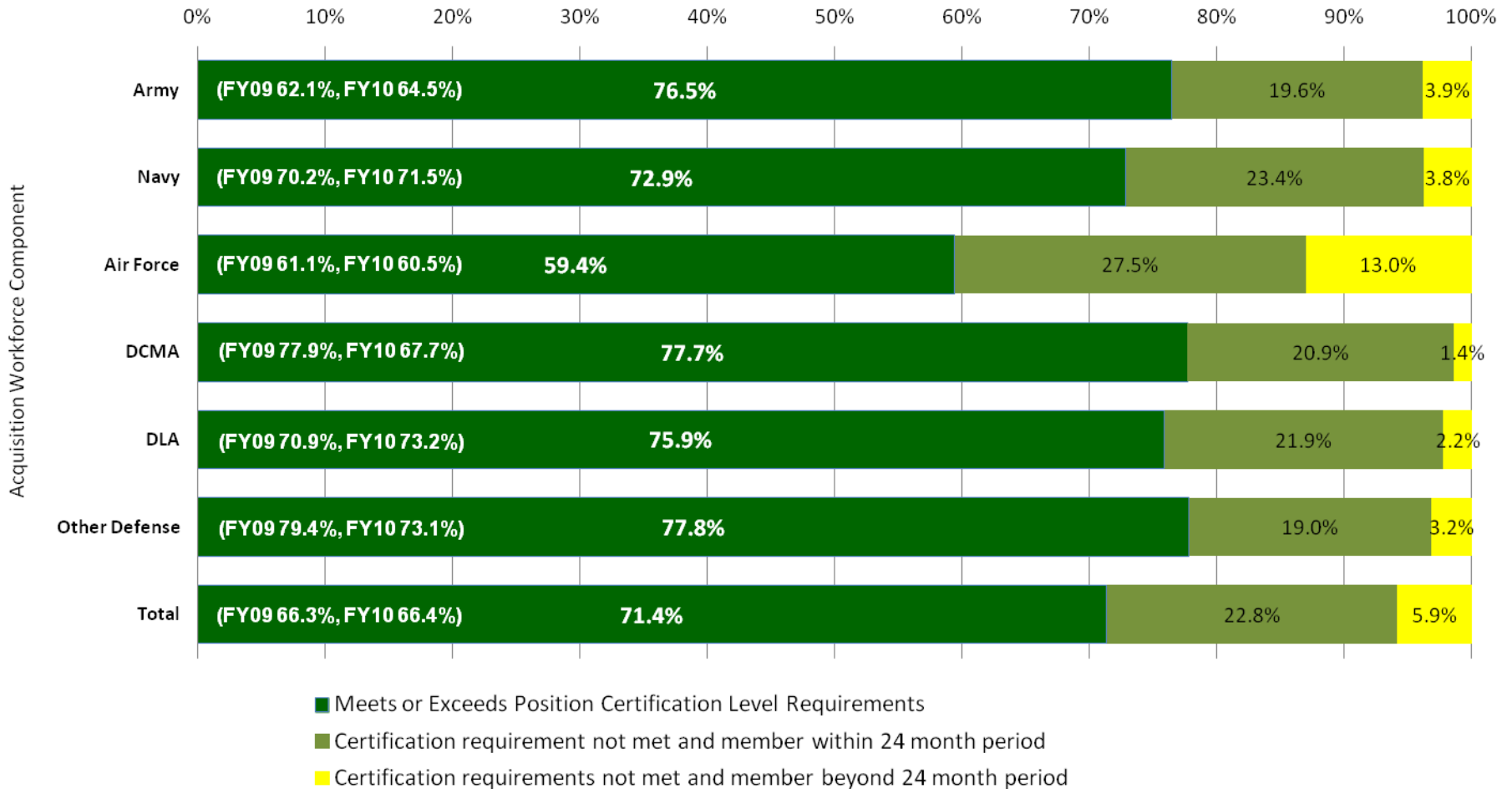

Contracting Certification Rates by Major Component

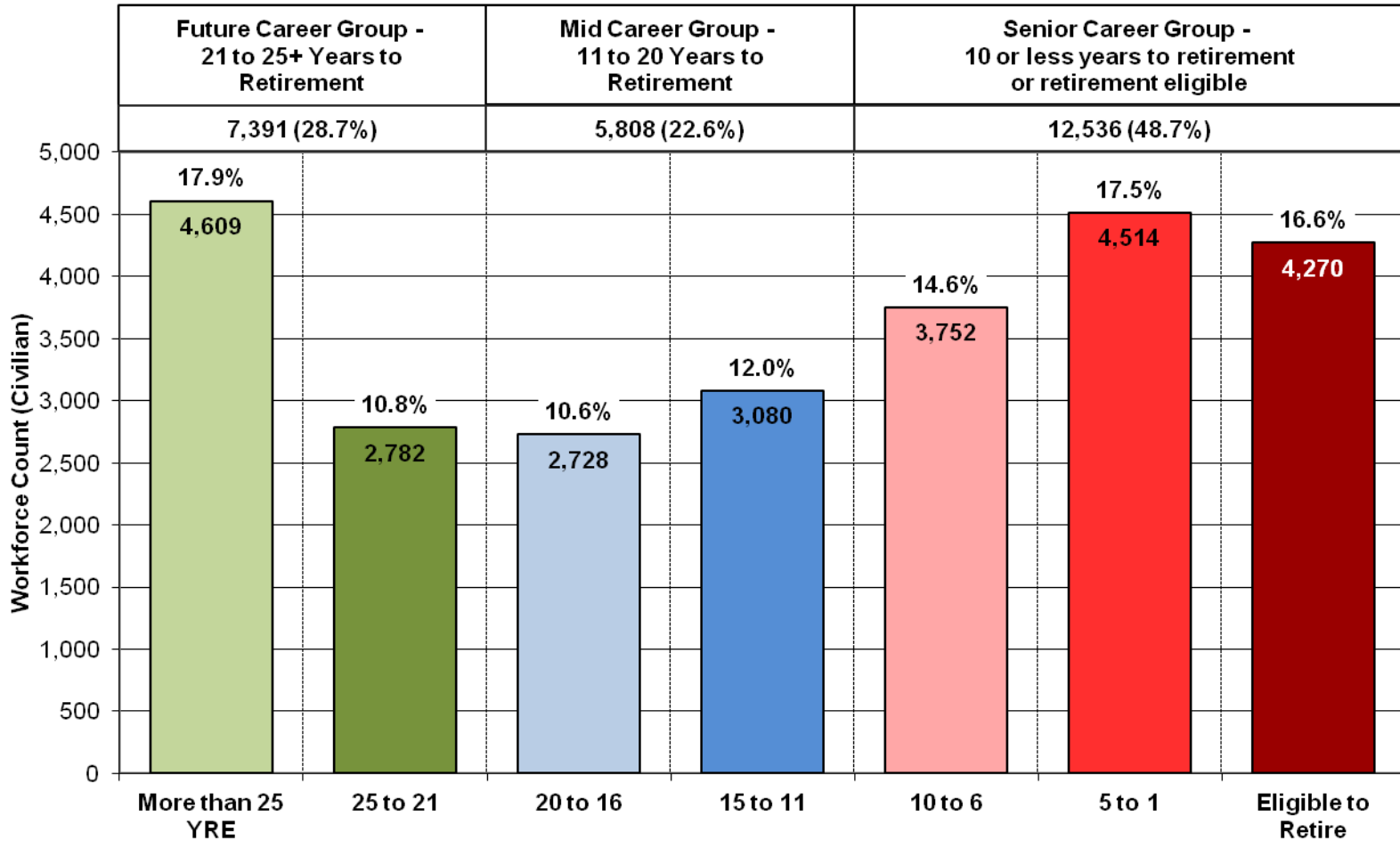
Certification Level "Meet/Exceed" Rates by Major Component Contracting (FY11)

by Years to Retirement Eligibility (YRE) - Civilian (FY11) - Contracting

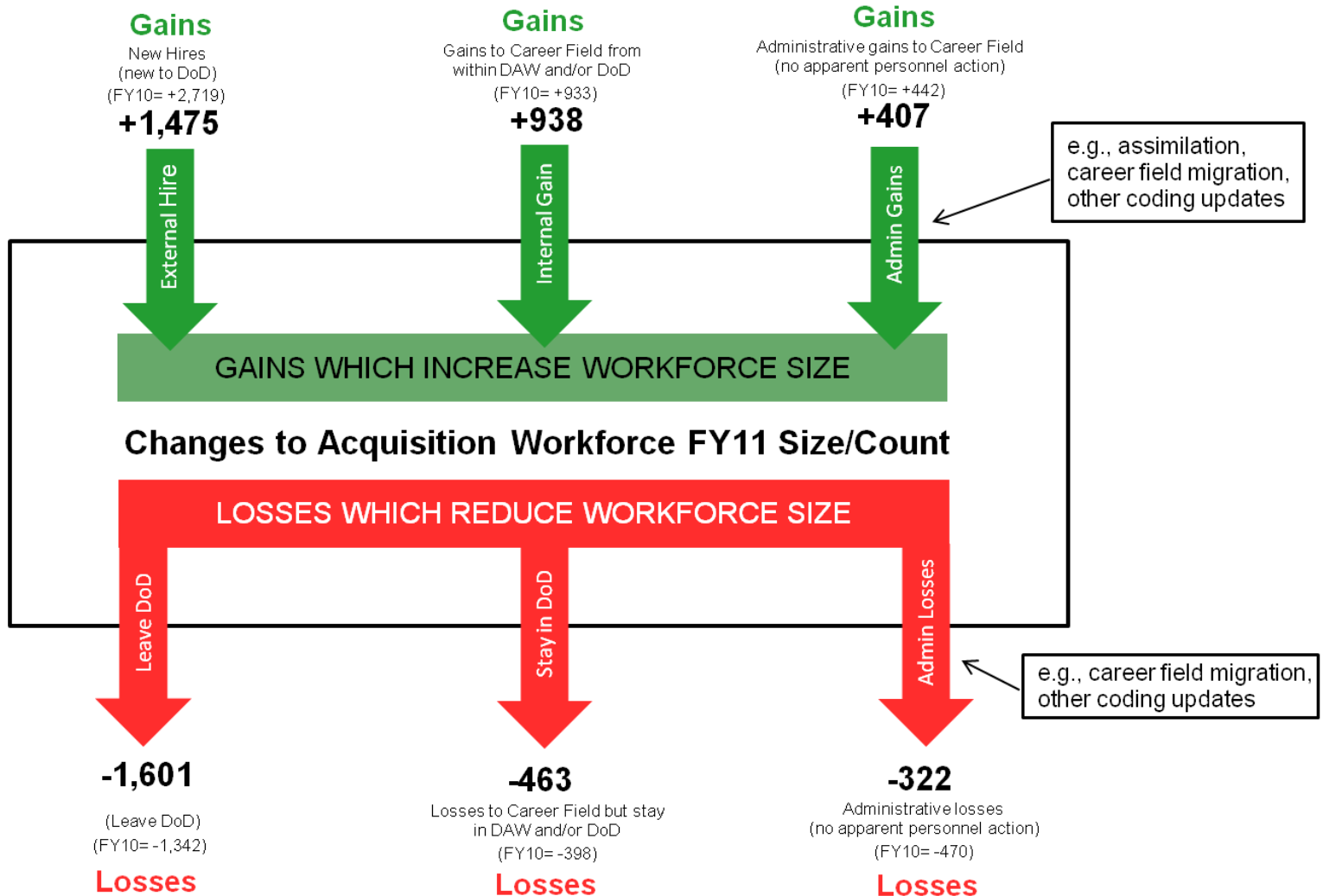




Contracting Change to Workforce Size (FY11)

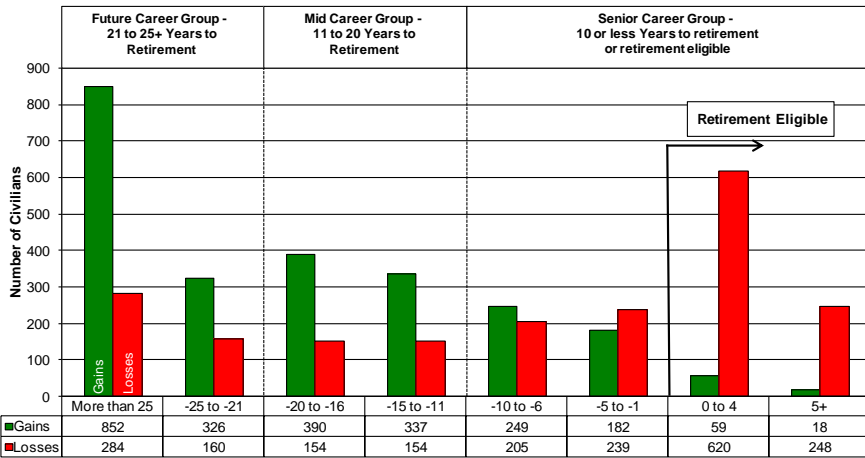
Gains and Losses by External to DoD, Internal to DoD, and Administrative Categories





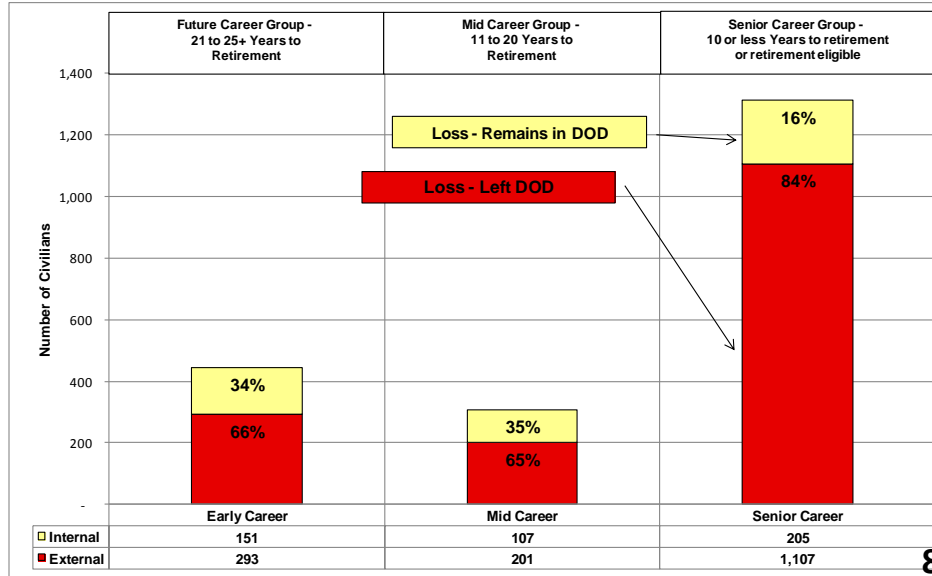
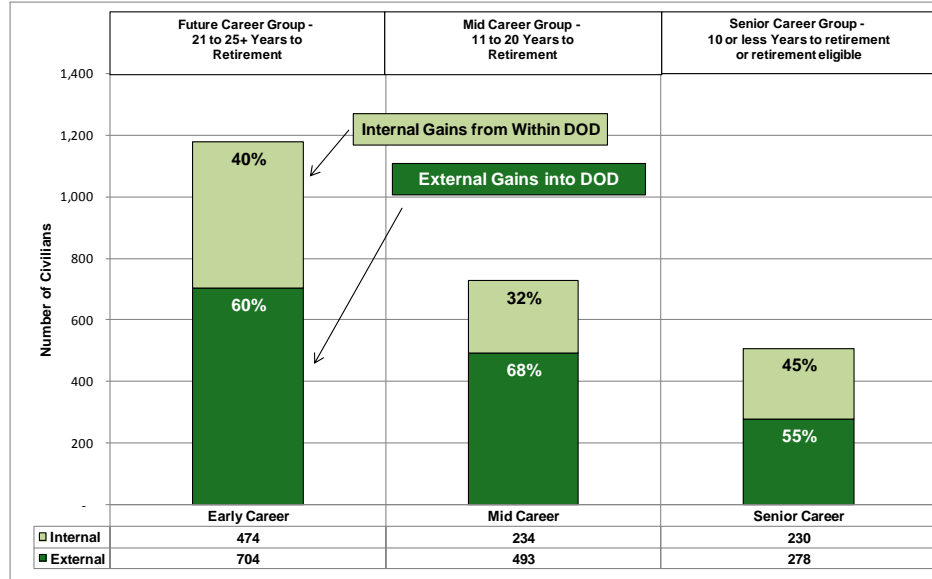
Contracting Workforce Lifecycle Gains & Losses (FY11)

Career Lifecycle by Years to Retirement Eligibility

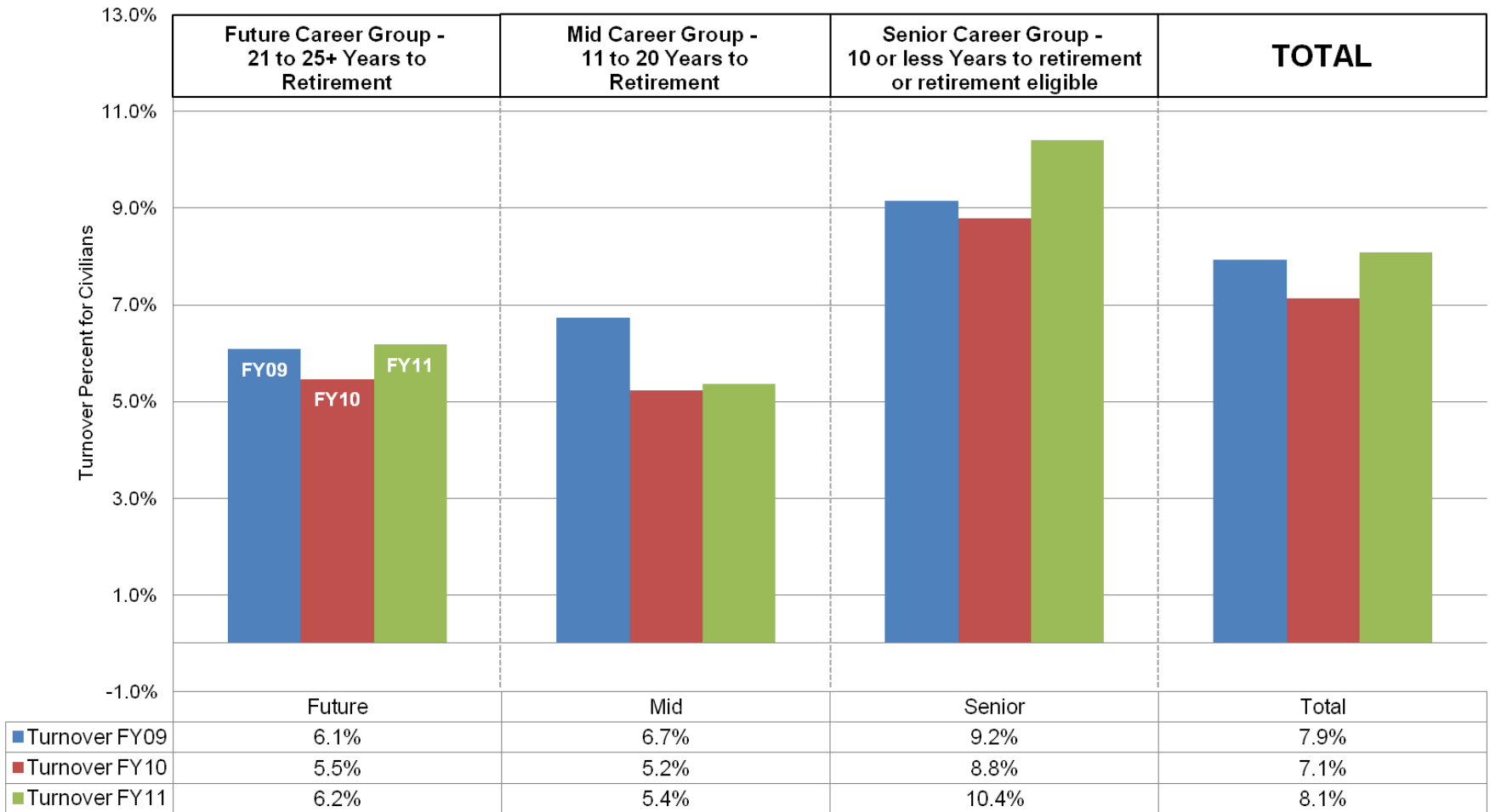

Defense Acquisition Workforce Turnover - Contracting (FY09, FY10, FY11)(by Career Lifecycle Group) (Civilian)

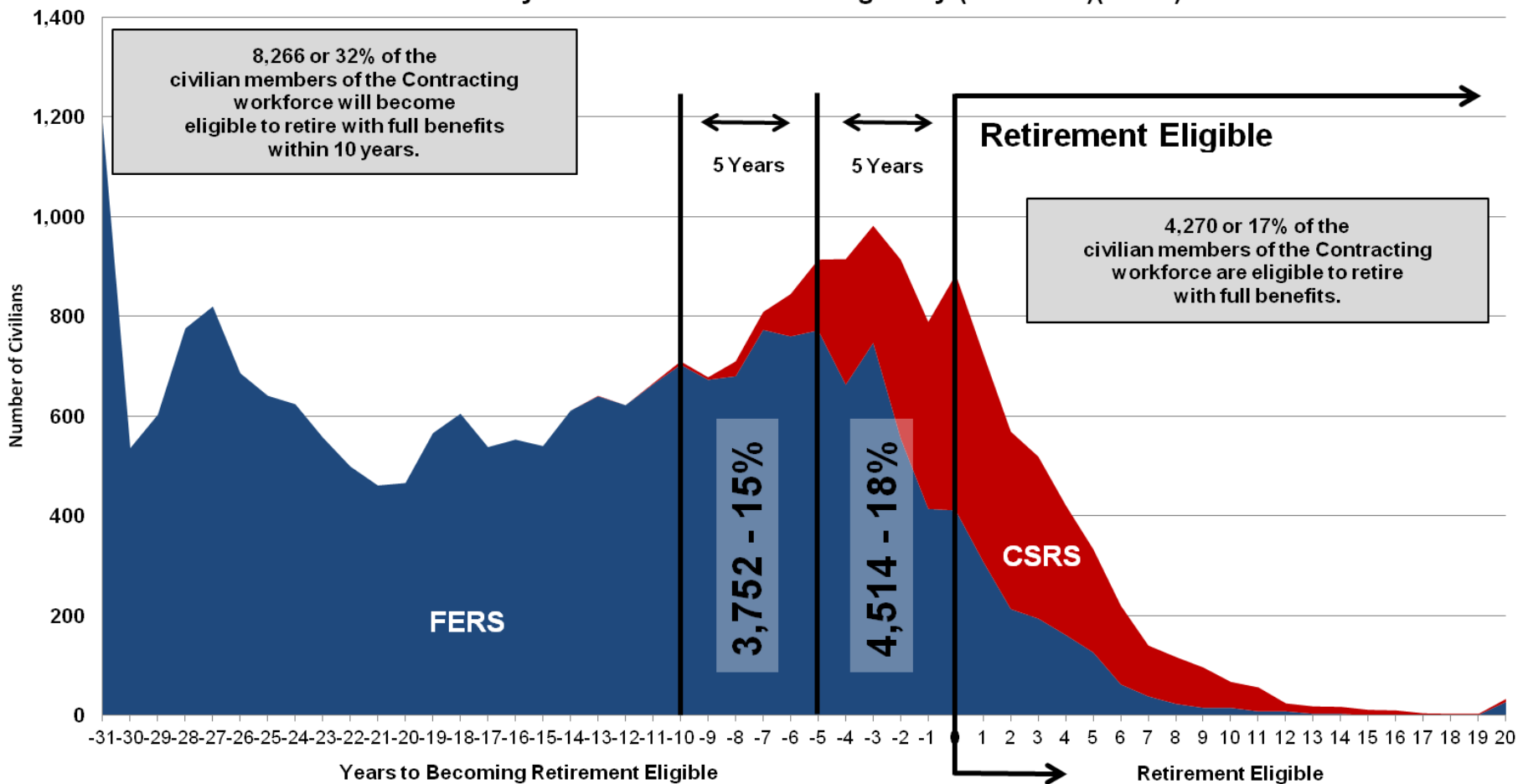




Contracting Workforce Year to Retirement Eligibility (FY11)
