Suggested article description(s) for enactment (including appropriate HTS subheading(s)):

Mixtures containing methyl 2-[(4-methyl-5-oxo-3-propoxy-4,5-dihydro-[1,2,4]triazole-1-carbonyl) sulfamoyl]benzoate, sodium salt (Propoxycarbazone-sodium) (CAS No. 181274-15-7) (provided for in subheading 3808.93.15).

#### Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

This formulated herbicide is used on winter wheat to control brome species and wild oat. Wild oat control is based on treatment between the 1-leaf stage and up to 2-tiller growth stage. This product is imported from Germany.

The Commission staff suggest that, in the article description of the proposed new heading, "3808.93.1500" be deleted and "3808.93.15" be inserted in lieu thereof.

The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.
