Technical comments:³

The Commission also notes that there is an existing (but expired) heading 9902.32.15 which covers allyl pentaerythritol. The Commission suggests that the new duty suspension be enacted using this heading number. This could be accomplished by deleting heading 9902.32.15, and by using that heading number for the new duty suspension in this bill. ⁴ The Commission recommends that the article description on Page 1 of this report be used in the proposed new heading in order to correct capitalization and to remove a replaced CAS number.

Also, the word "Free" in the special subcolumn should be deleted.

The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.

⁴ Specifically, line 6 of the bill should be amended to read "amended by striking heading 9902.32.15 and inserting in lieu thereof the following...". In addition, the heading number used in the bill, 9902.07.01, should be deleted and replaced with 9902.32.15.
