Triadimefon (1-(4-Chlorophenoxy)-3,3-dimethyl-1-(1*H*-1,2,4-triazol-1-yl)-2-butanone)  
(CAS No. 43121-43-3) (provided for in subheading 2933.99.22).

**Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:**

Triadimefon is a synthetic organic chemical used as a systemic fungicide to control powdery mildew on cereals, vegetables, and fruits. It is also used to control a wide spectrum of diseases relating to turf and ornamentals. Currently, there is no U.S. production of this product. This product is imported from Germany as a technical material and then formulated and packaged for sale in the domestic market.

There are at least two systemic fungicides that compete with Triadimefon in the turf, ornamentals, and specific crop markets. Some of these competing products are also imported and then formulated in the United States.

**Technical comments:<sup>3</sup>**

There is already an existing duty suspension on this product. The Commission suggests that the bill be re-written to extend the current duty suspension on Triadimefon. The current heading 9902.02.56 can be modified by striking the date in the Effective Period column and inserting "12/31/2008" in lieu thereof.

In any event, the Commission suggests that the article description given on page 1 of this report be used in the proposed new heading to reflect the correct nomenclature for this product as well as to reflect the common name Triadimefon. The article description is the same as currently listed under heading 9902.02.56.

<sup>3</sup> The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.

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## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Triadimefon.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRIADIMEFON.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.05.72	1-(4-Chlorophenoxy)-3,3-dimethyl-1-(1H-1,2,4-triazol-1-yl)-2-butanone (CAS No. 43121-43-3) (provided for in subheading 2933.99.22) ..	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2008	”.
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8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of enactment of this Act.

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
