Mixture of poly[[6-[(1,1,3,3-tetramethylbutyl)amino]-1,3,5-triazine-2,4-diyl] [2,2,6,6-tetramethyl-4-piperidinyl)imino]-1,6-hexanediyl[(2,2,6,6-tetramethyl-4-piperidinyl)imino]] and bis(2,2,6,6-tetramethyl-4-piperidyl) sebacate (CAS Nos. 71878-19-8 and 5289-07-9) (provided for in subheading 3812.30.90)

Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

The subject mixture is a synthetic organic chemical used as a "hindered amine" light stabilizer (hals) for plastic articles. Hals do not absorb UV radiation, but act to inhibit degradation of the polymer, thus extending its durability. Each of the two components can also be used individually as light stabilizers for different specific plastics materials.³

This chemical mixture is imported from Germany. The individual chemicals are also available from a supplier in China.⁴ There is no known domestic production of the individual products or the mixture.
