- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 6 p-Acetanisole) is amended by striking "12/31/2006" and
- 7 inserting "12/31/2009".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 10 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 11 the date of the enactment of this Act.
