1-Naphthyl methylcarbamate (Carbaryl) (CAS No. 63-25-2) (provided for in subheading 2924.29.47).

Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

Carbaryl, a synthetic organic chemical, is the active ingredient in a broad-spectrum insecticide for use in food crops, grain crops, forests, tobacco markets, and residential applications. The product is imported from China.
