The subject product is an ink-jet colorant that delivers unique performance characteristics to ink-jet printing inks. The subject product is imported from the United Kingdom.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CYAN 1 SPECIAL LIQUID FEED.
- 4 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.04.21 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 6 Cyan 1 special liquid feed) is amended by striking "12/
- 7 31/2006" and inserting "12/31/2009".
- 8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 9 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of enactment of this Act.
