Formaldehyde, polymer with toluene (CAS No. 25155-81-1) (provided for in subheading 3911.90.25).

Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

The product is a low molecular weight, aromatic hydrocarbon additive and extender for epoxy resin systems. Its composition is greater than 99 percent formaldehyde polymer with toluene, with less than 1 percent toluene as a solvent. This product has also been used successfully with certain polyester and urethane resins. It is soluble in, and compatible with, liquid epoxy resins as well as most curing agents. Systems utilizing the product exhibit improved adhesion to many substrates, as well as improved pigment/filler wetting and trowelability (reduced stickiness) of epoxy mortars and reduced viscosity. At higher concentrations it acts as a plasticizer. The product is imported from the United Kingdom.
