Product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports:

The subject chemical is a synthetic organic intermediate that is used in the production of fluorinated polymers. These polymers, due to their unique physical properties such as heat stability, resistance to solvents, and mechanical strength, are then used in a broad spectrum of high-technology materials applications such as panel displays, aerospace materials, and fuel cells. The subject product is imported from Germany.
