The Commission suggests that the article description on page 1 of this report be used because it uses the correct capitalization, deletes "(9CI)" and presents the CAS number in front of the HTS subheading number.

The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.
