

The subject product is a synthetic organic chemical that is used as a curing agent for organic coatings. The agent is activated using ultraviolet light. The product is imported from Japan.

The Commission suggests that the article description on page 1 of this report be used because it uses the correct capitalization, deletes “(9CI)” and presents the CAS number in front of the HTS subheading number.

³ The Commission may express an opinion on the HTS classification of a product to facilitate consideration of the bill. However, by law, only the U.S. Customs Service is authorized to issue a binding ruling on this matter. The Commission believes that the U.S. Customs Service should be consulted prior to enactment of the bill.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:
