Mixtures of methyl 2-[[[[[4-(dimethylamino)-6-(2,2,2-trifluoroethoxy)-1,3,5-triazin-2-yl]-amino]carbonyl]amino]-sulfonyl]-3-methylbenzoate (CAS No. 126535–15–7) and application adjuvants (provided for in subheading 3808.30.15).

This formulated product is composed of a synthetic organic herbicide and application adjuvants. More specifically, it is a postemergence herbicide that is used for selective broadleaf and grass weed control in sugar beets. The product is part of the family of sulfonylurea herbicides which, among other characteristics, are characterized by low application rates. The subject product is imported from France.
