

Joshua Bamberger, MD, MPH will work on Veterans homelessness as a Senior Advisor to the Executive Director.

Josh is the Medical Director of Housing and Urban Health for the San Francisco Department of Public Health. He coordinates all medical and behavioral health services at the health department's supportive housing programs, presently serving over 5,000 people in housing. He is also the medical director of the Housing and Urban Health Clinic, a Federally Qualified Health Center that is designed to provide integrated primary care and behavioral health services for formerly homeless people living in supportive housing. He has published in the areas of overdose prevention, cost effectiveness of supportive housing, and HIV post-exposure prophylaxis as well as in the area of drug user health related issues. Josh is an Associate Clinical Professor in the Department of Family Medicine, University of California, San Francisco and a Lecturer at the School of Public Health at the University of California Berkeley. He has been practicing family medicine with people living in poverty since 1989.
