Defense Acquisition University


SUBJECT: Letter of Intent for Charter in Qualifying Defense Acquisition University Certified Students toward Acceptance in Bethune-Cookman College degree and certification programs for credit.

1. WHEREAS, the Defense Acquisition University is engaged in providing systems acquisition education and training for the Department of Defense (DoD) wide Acquisition, Technology and Logistics (AT&L) workforce;
2. WHEREAS, Bethune-Cookman College is engaged in delivering degree and certification programs that are compatible with DAU programs; and
3. WHEREAS, DAU is interested in augmenting its current curriculum by working with Tuskegee University to identify specific Bethune-Cookman College courses that will provide continuous learning opportunities to the DoD wide AT&L workforce.
4. NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed that DAU and Bethune-Cookman College wish to enter into good faith negotiations to create a Strategic Partnership. The purpose of this Strategic Partnership is to leverage capabilities of the parties to create continuous learning opportunities for the DoD wide AT&L workforce members to increase their skills, knowledge and abilities. Specifically, DAU students will be able to leverage completed DAU training and take Bethune-Cookman College courses toward degrees and/or certification.
5. FURTHERMORE, it is the understanding of DAU and Bethune-Cookman College that both parties will appoint representatives to determine within 120 days the specific courses to comprise the curricula for each of the specified programs.
