

## AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1433 OFFERED BY My. Nodley

On the first page, line 8, strike "(a) IN GENERAL.—

Page 2, line 5, strike ", if that State" and all that follows through the end of line 3 on page 3 and insert "in any project receiving Federal economic development funds.".

Page 3, strike line 10 and all that follows through the end of line 9 on page 4 and insert the following:

- (a) CAUSE OF ACTION.—Any—
- 2 (1) owner of private property who has received
- 3 notice of a final determination that an action to take
- 4 such owner's property by eminent domain in viola-
- 5 tion of section 2 will proceed; or
- 6 (2) any tenant of such property;
- 7 may in a civil action obtain appropriate declaratory, in-
- 8 junctive, or monetary relief to enforce any provision of this
- 9 Act.
- 10 (b) Waiver of State Sovereign Immunity.—A
- 11 State shall not be immune under the 11th Amendment

- 1 to the Constitution of the United States from a civil action
- 2 under this section.
- 3 (c) BURDEN OF PROOF.—In a civil action under this
- 4 section, the defendant has the burden to show by clear
- 5 and convincing evidence that the taking is not in violation
- 6 of this Act.
- 7 (d) Limitation on Bringing Action.—An action
- 8 under this section may not be commenced later than 7
- 9 years after date of the notification described in subsection 10 (a).

Page 4, line 18, strike all after the one-em dash though line 2 on page 5 and insert "Any owner of private property or tenant of such private property described in section 4(a) may report a violation by the Federal Government, any authority of the Federal Government, State, or political subdivision of a State or instrumentality thereof to the Attorney General.".

Page 5, line 17, strike all after "(2)" though line 21 and insert the following: "that a court has entered a final order in an action brought by a property owner or tenant under this Act.".

Page 6, line 16, strike "seek" and all that follows through line 18 and insert "obtain appropriate declaratory, injunctive, or monetary relief.".
