

# Camp Eggers History

**Camp Eggers** is a military base in Kabul, Afghanistan. It is located near the US Embassy and the President of Afghanistan's Palace. The camp is named after Capt. Daniel W. Eggers, a US soldier from the 1st Battalion, 3rd Special Forces Group (Airborne), Fort Bragg, North Carolina, who was killed by an improvised explosive device (IED) along with three other soldiers on 29 May 2004 near Kandahar.

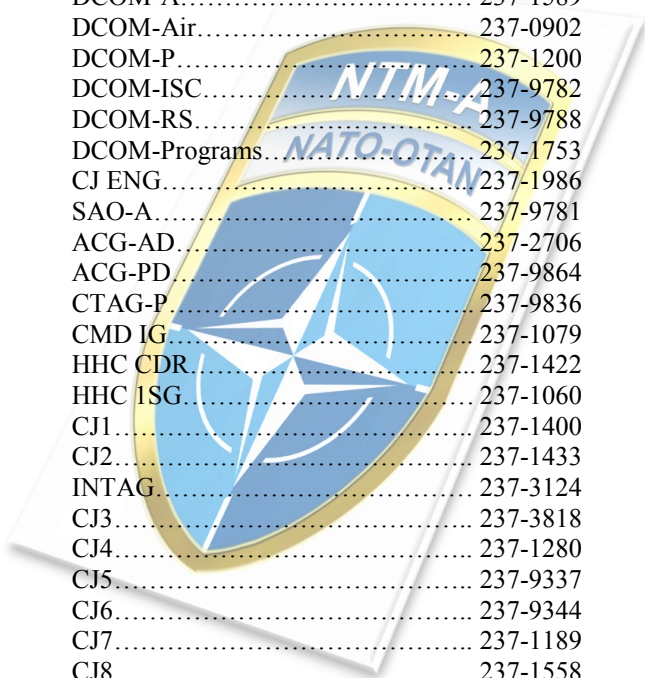
The NTM-A is a very young command, born on 12 October 2009. It achieved full operational command status on 12 November 2009. LTG General William Caldwell, IV (U.S. Army), currently leads the Command. NTM-A is a training command that was created to recruit, train and develop the Afghan National Security Force (ANSF). The ANSF is comprised of the various police and army forces of Afghanistan.

## Kuwait - Ali-Al-Saleem

1. When you arrive at Ali-Al-Saleem you will be meet by personnel stationed there and given several briefings.
2. Report to the Passenger Service clerk and sign up for a military or civilian contract aircraft flight to Afghanistan. You must present your CAC card and orders to sign up for military airlift. Activity duty military personnel and cargo have priority over civilian contractors. Be sure to note the "SHOW TIME" for the next flight to Afghanistan. You must show up for the manifest calls for every flight to Afghanistan at tent #1. You will not be notified over the PA system of roll calls times. There is a message board with tentative flight times. There will be a roster posted in tent #1 that list destinations, your name, and your roster number. If the person ahead of you is not there they move to the next name on the list; you will not be notified your name was called if you are not there.
3. The billeting office is located near the air terminal. Report to the billeting office to obtain transient billeting. You can expect to remain at Ali Al Saleem Air Base for a few days. **THEY DO NOT PROVIDE LINEN.**  
**Note:** Use the baggage storage area in Tent Papa-1 while at Ali Al Saleem Air Base.
4. The base has an Exchange Service, Morale Welfare and Recreation (MWR) activities with internet access, AT&T phone booths to inform your family of your safe arrival. You can also call your family from a DSN line by dialing: (312) 560-1110 and asking the military operator to assist you in placing a morale and welfare call to your friends or family members.
5. While at Ali Al Saleem Airbase, you are encourage to contact the directorate you will be assigned to inform them of your travel status, projected arrival time and projected arrival location in Afghanistan. The CTSC-A/NTM-A LNO DSN is 442-0238 and is located in Tent #2.

## Afghanistan - Bagram

1. When you arrive at Bagram you will be meet by personnel stationed there and given several briefings.
2. Report to the Passenger Service clerk and sign up for a military or civilian contract aircraft flight to Kabul. Do not sign up for a flight to anywhere other than Kabul. You must present your CAC card to sign up for military airlift. Activity duty military personnel and cargo have priority over civilian contractors. Be sure to note the "SHOW TIME" for the next flight to Kabul. You must show up for the manifest calls for every flight to Afghanistan at the PAX terminal. You will not be notified over the PA system of roll calls times. There is a message board with tentative flight times. There will be a roster posted that list destinations, your name, and your roster number. Make sure you report to the PAX terminal for all manifest calls for Kabul. There are also STOL flights that fly more frequently than the standard military flight and are authorized for your use.
3. The billeting office is located in the PAX terminal. Report to the billeting office to obtain transient billeting. **THEY DO NOT PROVIDE LINEN.**  
**Note:** Use the baggage storage area outside of the PAX terminal. This area is unsecure and PPE should not be stored there.
4. The USO is located across the street from the PAX terminal and can be utilized while awaiting you flight. There are phones located in the rear of the USO. They also offer beverages and snacks. Movies are played throughout the day and is never closed. The PX is approximately a ten minute walk from the PAX terminal.
5. While at the Bagram airfield, you are encourage to contact the directorate you will be assigned to inform them of your travel status, projected arrival time and projected arrival location in Kabul. The CTSC-A/NTM-A LNO's contact number is Cell: 070-518-8614.

## Afghanistan - Kabul

1. When you arrive at Kabul you will be escorted to the PAX terminal.
2. To arrange transportation to Camp Eggers there is a signup roster for the shuttle that make approximately two runs a day. The time for the next scheduled pickup will be on the roster.
3. The billeting office is located in the PAX terminal. You must go out the arrival doors and go in the departure doors. Once you leave the arrival side of the PAX terminal to cannot get back in. Ensure you have your baggage with you. **BILLETING DOES NOT PROVIDE LINEN.**  
**Note:** Use the baggage storage area outside of the PAX terminal. This area is unsecure and PPE should not be stored there.
4. The baggage storage area is located to your right as you go out the arrival doors.
5. While at the KIA airfield, you are encourage to contact the directorate you will be assigned to inform them of your travel status.
