Mr. Gratacós was sworn-in as the second Inspector General of the Export-Import Bank of the US on October 18, 2010. Mr. Gratacós had been serving as Acting Inspector General since October 2009.

Before his nomination, Mr. Gratacós served as the Deputy Inspector General and Counsel to the Inspector General. In that capacity, Mr. Gratacós was the OIG's principal administrative and legal officer, advising the Inspector General and OIG staff with respect to the legal aspects of audits, investigations, procurement, employment, and administrative and operational matters.

Mr. Gratacós joined Ex-Im Bank OIG from Motorola, Inc. where he worked as commercial counsel with worldwide responsibilities for federal transactions and regional responsibilities (Latin America) for commercial transactions. Before joining Motorola, he served as attorney advisor and as Legal Counsel to the Inspector General (Acting) at the U.S. Agency for International Development OIG.

Mr. Gratacós holds a BA from Universidad Interamericana de Puerto Rico, a JD from the University of Florida, and a professional MBA from the University of Massachusetts (Amherst). He is an alumnus of the Federal Executive Institute. Between 2004 - 2008, he served as adjunct professor at the University of Virginia School of Continuing & Professional Studies, teaching undergraduate and graduate level courses in international purchasing and business transactions at the University's Northern Virginia campus.
