


SMART VOYAGE PLANNING DECISION AID



What is it?

Smart Voyage Planning Decision Aid (SVPDA) is a computer software application that will be used by the Navy's Fleet Weather Centers in Norfolk and San Diego to push optimized ship routes to all Navy ships for both maximum fuel efficiency and safety.

How does it work?

SVPDA reduces energy consumption by exploiting ship-specific hydrodynamic and propulsion data and real-time knowledge of the physical environment including:

- Wind
- Waves
- Currents
- Ship-specific hydrodynamic and propulsion data

What will it accomplish?

SVPDA capitalizes on real-time weather data and computing power to plot routes for fuel savings after the system is fully developed and fielded.
