America Invents Act

Goals of Patent Reform Legislation

- Encourage innovation and job creation
- Support USPTO's efforts to improve patent quality and reduce backlog
- Establish secure funding mechanism
- Provide greater certainty for patent rights
- Provide less costly, time-limited administrative alternatives to litigation

- must file application electronically (utility application)


Satellite Offices


- USPTO required to open 3 satellite offices in 3 years

 - 100 locations suggested







Micro-entity Status

- New size-based entity status
- Entitled to a 75% discount on fees for "filing, searching, examining, issuing, appealing, and maintaining" patent applications/patents, once the USPTO exercises its fee setting authority
- Discount not available until USPTO exercises fee setting authority
- 2 bases for micro entity status

Micro-entity: Gross Income Basis

- "Applicant" certifies that he/she/it:
 - 1. qualifies as a small entity;
 - has not been named as an inventor on more than 4 previously filed patent applications;
- did not have a gross income exceeding 3 times the median household income in the calendar before the applicable fees is paid; and
- 4. has not assigned, granted, conveyed a license or other ownership interest (and is not obligated to do so) in the subject application to an entity that exceeds the gross income limit

NITED STATE

Micro-entity: University Basis

- "Applicant":
 - certifies that his/her employer is an institution of higher education as defined in section 101(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965;

or

 has assigned, or is obligated to assign, ownership to that institute of higher education
