The Osan Passport Office has been designated as a Military Passport Acceptance Agency by the U.S. State Department for accepting Official, no-fee (dependent) and Tourist passport applications. As a Military Passport Acceptance Agency, we do not produce passports, but rather act as an authorized courier between you and the U.S. State Department for passport applications. The requirements vary depending on the type of passport application submitted and individual Status.

Every application is different and will require proper documentation. The Passport Agent reviews each application and the necessary paperwork to satisfy each situation. It is may be necessary to meet with the agent three times: Once to understand the requirements, once to process the application, and finally to pick up the passport. As the passport process can be lengthy, it is recommended to start the process as early as possible.

<u>Official Passports receive priority over Tourist Passports.</u> With this exception, our Passport Agent sees applicants on a first-come-first-served basis. Please be patient. Each application is thoroughly reviewed before submission to Washington as errors will delay passport processing ranging in times from weeks to months. While the agent is available and willing to help all applicants, the U.S. Embassy and Camp Humphreys have additional agents who take appointments and have multiple agents to process applications.
