 - 23 weeks of training in one year
 - United States, Europe, Asia

 - The PIM process
 - Technical
 - Training
 - 120, 90, 60, 30 days

 - Results (05/2007)
 - 276 Army Civilians trained
 - 58 Installations using DOEHRS

Lessons Learned

- Training
 - On-line Exposure Assessment Model pre-requisite to DOEHRS training
 - Follow-up to ensure immediate use of system after training
 - 3 & 6 month intervals
 - Technical
 - Tablets
 - Security with Table Security Administrators

- Sustainment Training
 - New hires
 - Refresher/Enhancement
- CHPPM surveys entered into Local Program Office
- Army Proponent Office for Preventive Medicine (POPM) Metrics Interface
- Continual process improvement
