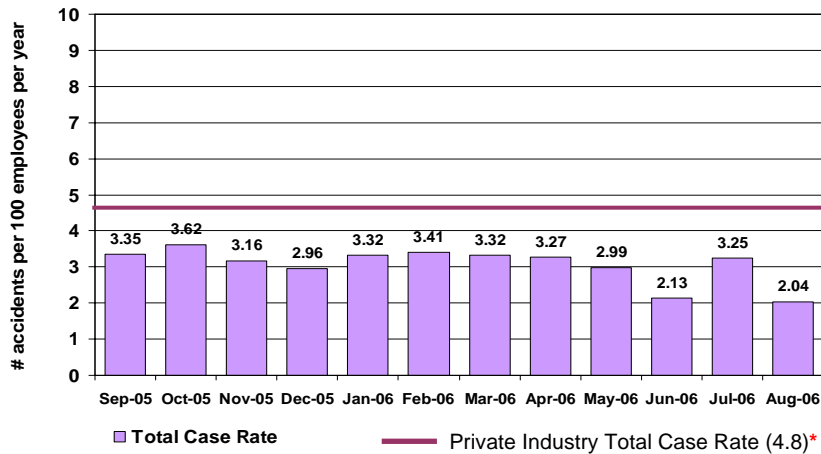

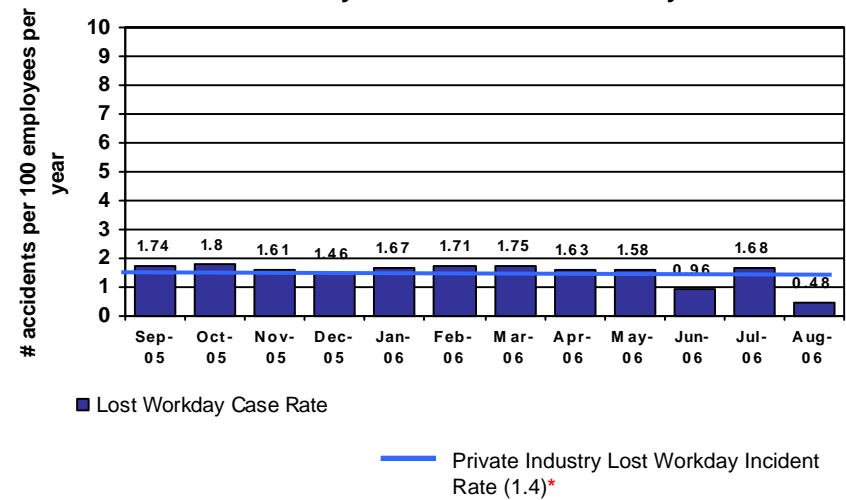
Army Civilian Employee Accident Performance Total Case Rate - Total Army

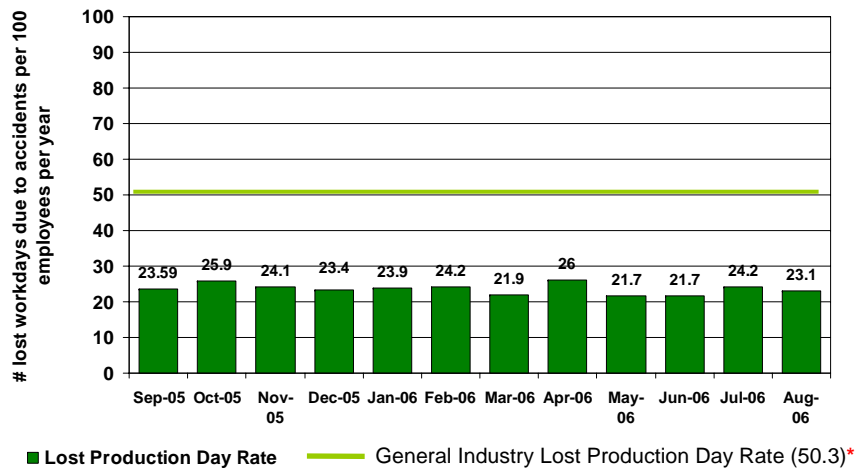
Army Civilian Employee Accident Performance Lost Workday Incident Rate - Total Army

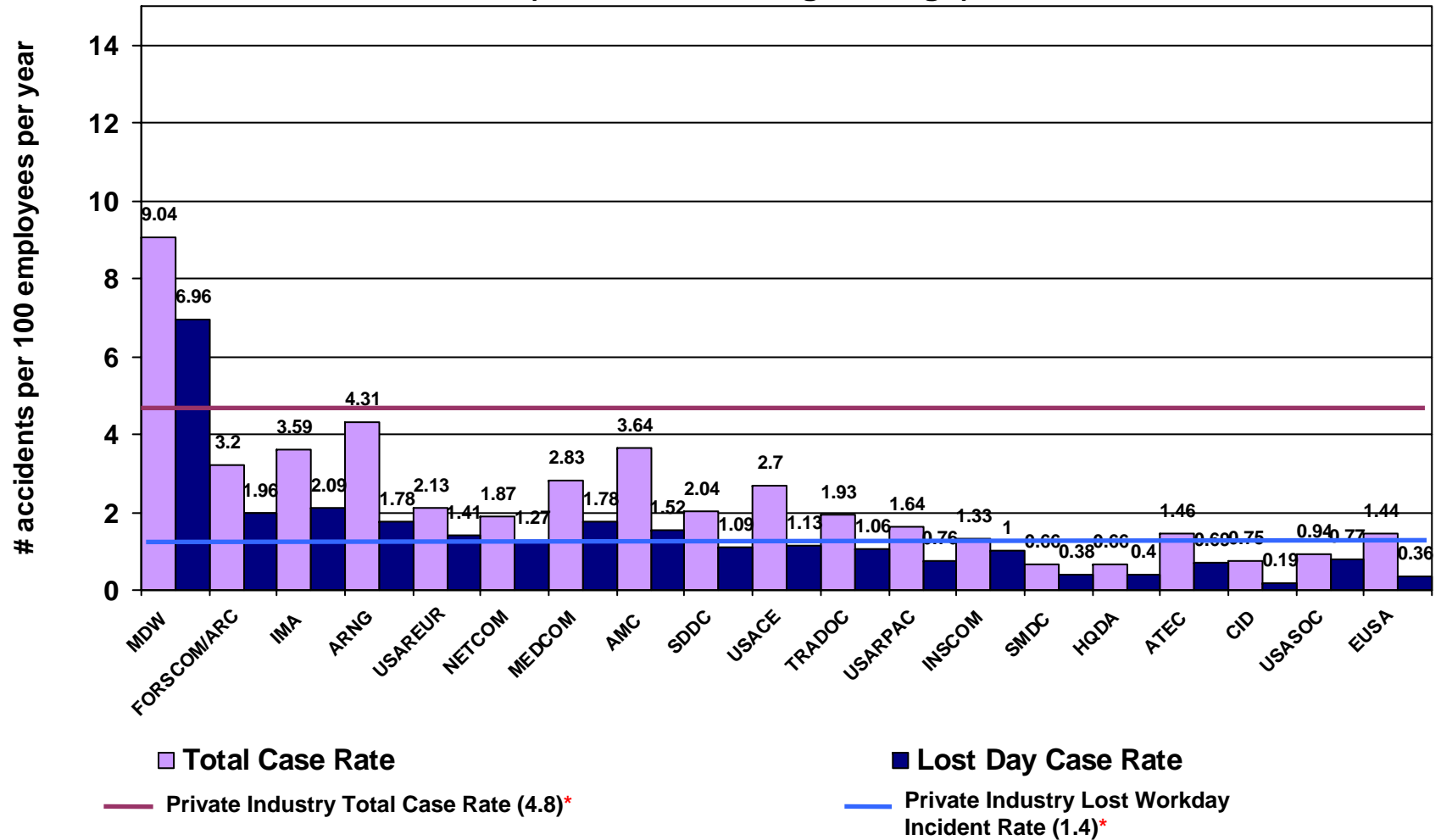
Assessment and Primary Interventions

- 1) Deploying on-line civilian safety and occupational health training.
- 2) Developing scorecard to track progress towards Leadership directed safety initiatives and safety performance.
- 3) Re-emphasizing requirement for installations to operate a Civilian Resource Conservation Committee to review occupational injury and illness trends and compensation case management and provide Leadership attention to accident reduction.
- 4) Developing web-based civilian accident immediate notification and reporting system to provide immediate notification upon the occurrence of an accident and detailed accident reporting for refined accident trend analysis.
- 5) Publishing policy/guidance on civilian accountability for safety and occupational health.
- 6) Developing on-line automated installation/activity safety program self-assessment tool.

(12 Months Rolling Average)

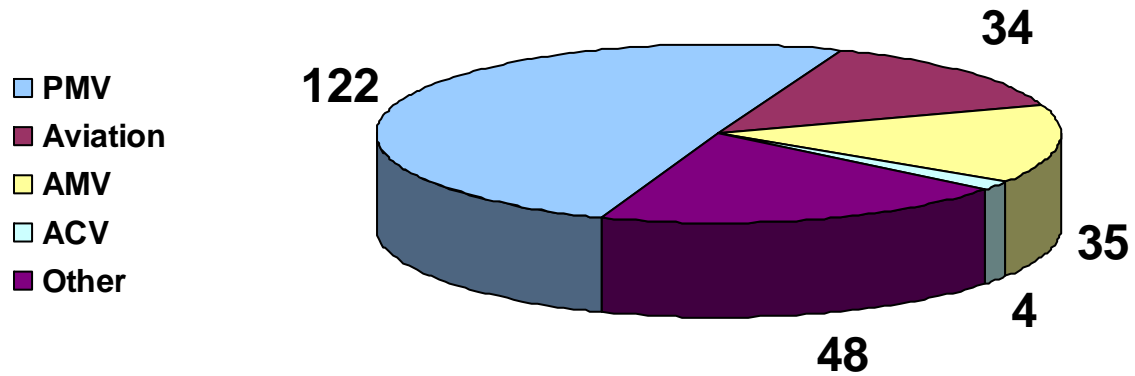


Total case rate: rate, per 100 employees per year, of fatal, lost time, and no lost time accidents
