Beginning of Heating Season

1. For family and unaccompanied personnel housing, heating systems may be placed into winter operation when the daily low outdoor temperature falls below 55°F for 3 of 5 consecutive days in the first quarter of the FY.
2. For all other facilities, heating systems may be placed into winter operation when the average outdoor temperature (using hourly readings from 0600-2200) falls below 60°F for 3 of 5 consecutive days in the first quarter of the FY.

- The AFSC provides a comprehensive introduction to life in Korea through our publication the Seoul Survivor.

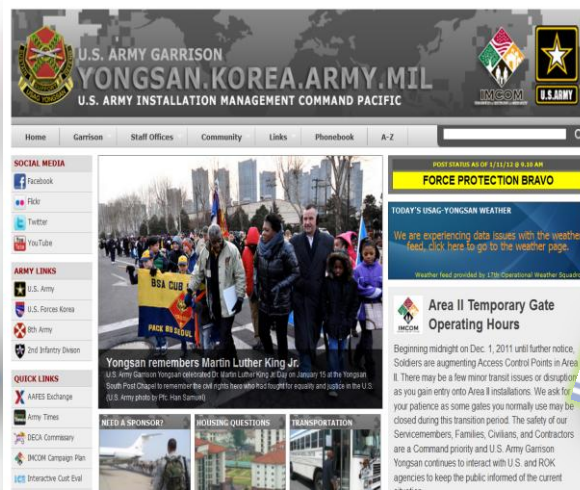
