# **AmeriCorps Requirements**



### Request for Proposal (RFP)

Formal document that invites
prospective service site partners to
submit a proposal describing how
AmeriCorps members would serve
at the site



#### **Competitive Review Process**

- Review submitted proposals
- Objectively rate them according to pre-determined criteria
- Select the organizations with the highest ratings



### Roles and Responsibilities

- In small groups, review the case studies and identify roles and responsibilities of both organizations
- Report out to the larger group
