

GSA Bulletin FTR 12-06

TO: Heads of Federal Agencies

SUBJECT: Adjusted Calendar Year (CY) 2012 Privately Owned Vehicle Mileage Reimbursement Rates

1. What is the purpose of this bulletin? To inform the Federal community that the U.S. General Services Administration's (GSA) recent review of the Federal privately owned vehicle (POV) mileage reimbursement rates, conducted pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 5707, has resulted in rate changes for the use of privately owned automobiles (POA), POAs when Government owned automobiles (GOA) are available, privately owned motorcycles, and privately owned airplanes for official purposes. This bulletin updates the rates for CY 2012. The original rates for CY 2012, as well as the rates for prior years, may be found at <http://www.gsa.gov/mileage>.
2. What are the adjusted CY 2012 POV mileage reimbursement rates? Pursuant to FTR § 301-10.303 and § 301-10.310, the adjusted POV rates will be \$0.555 for the use of POAs, \$0.23 for the use of POAs when GOAs are available, \$0.525 for the use of privately owned motorcycles, and \$1.31 for the use of privately owned airplanes.
3. What is the effective date of these rate changes? The effective date of these changes is the date the Notice to this bulletin is published in the Federal Register and applies to travel performed on or after this date, through December 31, 2012.
4. What is the background of this bulletin? This bulletin updates the POV mileage reimbursement rates, as described in FTR Amendment 2010-07 (75 FR 72965, Nov. 29, 2010). Once published on the GSA website, this bulletin updates the POV mileage reimbursement rates prescribed by GSA's Office of Government-wide Policy (OGP).
