


A. The purpose of this modification is to: (1) increase the current Not-to-Exceed (NTE) budget authority for contractor participation in the development of site-wide safety programs by \$65,000, from \$35,000 to \$100,000; and (2) revise Contract Section J, Attachment J-15, "Site-Wide Safety Programs and Standardized Training," to update the listing of Site-Wide Safety Programs in which the contractor is authorized to participate.

Contract revisions are detailed in the SF30 Block 14 Continuation beginning on Page 2 of this modification.

SF30 BLOCK 14 CONTINUATION:

- B. DOE Letter No. 10-SED-0029, dated January 4, 2010 (see paragraph F.3 below) authorized the contractor to participate in the development of Hanford Site-wide safety programs with a Not-to-Exceed (NTE) budget authority of \$35,000 per program. As stated in paragraph A above, this modification increases the NTE budget authority by \$65,000, for a total budget authority of \$100,000 per site-wide safety program. The number of site-wide safety programs and/or associated manuals currently authorized is 18 (see Contract Attachment J-15 as revised, paragraph E below). WCH is authorized to perform the work identified in this modification up to this authorized NTE amount. Do not exceed the NTE budget amount provided herein without prior approval from the Contracting Officer via a modification to increase this amount. Notify the Contracting Officer in writing with your rationale if the NTE amount is insufficient to proceed with the identified work.
- C. Within 45 days after completion of the implementation plans, WCH is requested to provide a cost proposal, if deemed necessary, for the implementation of the Hanford Site Safety Programs identified in Contract Section J, Attachment J-15.
- D. This modification does not add additional funds to the contract. Accordingly, work under the contract, such as that described herein, must be performed within the amount of funds which have been incrementally allotted to the contract in accordance with Clause I.57 - FAR 52.232-22 - Limitation of Funds (Apr 1984).
