Combating Exploitative Child Labor by Promoting Sustainable Livelihoods and Educational Opportunities for Children in Egypt

AGENCY: Bureau of International Labor Affairs, Department of Labor.

ACTION: Correction. Amendment to SGA 10-09.

SUMMARY: The Department of Labor is publishing an amendment to SGA 10-09 *Combating Exploitative Child Labor by Promoting Sustainable Livelihoods and Educational Opportunities for Children in Egypt* on Grants.gov and the USDOL website. The solicitation was originally published on Grants.gov and the USDOL website on September 28, 2010.

Amendments:

- On page 27, Section III.G., remove the sentence from the Submission Date, Time, Address, and Delivery Method section:
“Attention: Georgiette Nkpa, Reference: Solicitation 10-09. Applicants are advised to submit their applications in advance of the deadline.”
Replace with the sentence:
“Attention: James Kinslow, Reference: Solicitation 10-09. Applicants are advised to submit their applications in advance of the deadline.”
- On page 27, Section III.G., remove the sentence from the Submission Date, Time, Address, and Delivery Method section:
“Confirmation of receipt can be obtained from Georgiette Nkpa (See section VI. for contact information).”
Replace with the sentence:
“Confirmation of receipt can be obtained from James Kinslow (See section VI. for contact information).”

- On page 28, Section III.H., remove the sentence from the Funding Restrictions, Unallowable Activities, and Specific Prohibitions section:

“If any Applicant has questions regarding these or other restrictions, please e-mail Georgiette Nkpa at nkpa.georgiette@dol.gov.”

Replace with the following point of contact:

“If any Applicant has questions regarding these or other restrictions, please e-mail James Kinslow at kinslow.james@dol.gov.”

- On page 31, Section III.H.10., delete the sentence from the inherently religious activities section:

“For additional guidance, please consult USDOL’s Center for Faith-Based and Community Initiatives’ Web site at <http://www.dol.gov/cfbc>.”

Replace with the sentence:

“For additional guidance, please consult USDOL’s Center for Faith-Based and Neighborhood Partnerships Web site at <http://www.dol.gov/cfbnp/>.”

- On page 31, Section IV.A., delete the following sentence in the application evaluation criteria section:

“The criteria outlined below will be used to evaluate applications submitted in response to this solicitation on the basis of 100 points, with up to a possible 5 extra points.”

Replace with the sentence:

“The criteria outlined below will be used to evaluate applications submitted in response to this solicitation on the basis of 100 points.”

- On page 32, Section IV.A.1., delete the sentence from the project design and budget section:

“Low administrative costs and amount of resources to direct services (*e.g.*, direct educational and livelihoods services) are preferred.”

Replace with the sentence:

“Low administrative costs and higher amounts of resources to direct services (*e.g.*, direct educational and livelihoods services) are preferred.”

- On page 37, Section VI., remove the sentence from the agency contacts section:

“All technical questions regarding this solicitation (SGA 10-09) must be sent in writing to Georgiette Nkpa, U.S. Department of Labor’s Office of Procurement Services, via e-mail (e-mail address: nkpa.georgiette@dol.gov).”

Replace with the sentence:

- On page 38, Section VII.A., remove the sentence from the Office of Management and Budget Information Collection section:

Replace with the sentence:
