AGENCY: Bureau of International Labor Affairs, Department of Labor.

ACTION: Correction. Amendment to SGA 11-02.

SUMMARY: The Department of Labor is publishing an amendment to SGA 11-02 *Global Action Program on Child Labor Issues* on Grants.gov and the USDOL website. The solicitation was originally published on Grants.gov and the USDOL website on July 14, 2011.

Amendments:

- On page 18, Section III.G., remove the sentence from **G. Application Package:**
“The application package for this solicitation can be downloaded and viewed from Grants.gov by referencing Funding Opportunity Number 11-XX.”

Replace with the sentence:

“The application package for this solicitation can be downloaded and viewed from Grants.gov by referencing Funding Opportunity Number 11-02.”

- On page 24, Section III.H., remove the sentence from **H. Submission Date, Time, Address, and Delivery Method:**

“Hard copy application must be delivered to U.S. Department of Labor, Procurement Services Center, 200 Constitution Avenue NW, Room S-4307, Washington, DC 20210, Attention: Brenda White, Grant Officer, Reference: Solicitation 11-XX.”

Replace with the sentence:

“Hard copy application must be delivered to U.S. Department of Labor, Procurement Services Center, 200 Constitution Avenue NW, Room S-4307,

Washington, DC 20210, Attention: Brenda White and James Kinslow, Grant Officers, Reference: Solicitation 11-02.”

- On page 25, Section III.H., remove the sentence from **H. Submission Date, Time, Address, and Delivery Method**

“Confirmation of receipt can be obtained from Brenda White (see section VI. for contact information).”

Replace with the sentence:

“Confirmation of receipt can be obtained from Brenda White and James Kinslow (see section VI. for contact information).”

- On page 26, Section III.I., remove the sentence from **I. Funding Restrictions, Unallowable Activities, and Specific Prohibitions**

“If any Applicant has questions about these or other restrictions, please e-mail Brenda White at white.brenda.j@dol.gov”

Replace with the sentence:

“If any Applicant has questions about these or other restrictions, please e-mail Brenda White and James Kinslow at white.brenda.j@dol.gov and kinslow.james@dol.gov.”
