## Project overview

  - NVRA report
  - UOCAVA report
  - Survey report



#### Data overview

- collected data from 55 States and territories
  - total of 4,517 jurisdictions (counties and townships)
  - increase of 45% from number of jurisdictions in 2006
- approximately 800 variables
  - 52 questions and sub-questions
  - options for not available and not applicable
  - comment fields
- total of approximately 3.6 million data points
  - 962,000 numeric data points



### Data collection instruments

- Main tool: a MS Excel-based template
  - MS Word-based template for individual counties or for statewide totals
- Completed by the States and submitted through a Web portal
- Extracted into a SAS database
- Aggregated to create tables for reports
- UOCAVA and Survey report tables vetted with the States



#### Technical assistance

- varied widely from State to State
- based on one-on-one contact between 3 RTI staff and State officials
- consultation through email and telephone calls
- supported by material on project Web site:
  - supplementary instructions
  - FAQs
  - updates
- how can RTI make completion of the survey easier for you?



## Accomplishments

- significantly higher response rates due to:
  - improved processes
  - earlier start
  - State familiarity
  - general recognition of importance
- better and more reliable tools
- improved questionnaire
- more stable survey



## Improvements for 2010

- continue to improve timetable
  - questionnaire out earlier
  - more pre-election technical assistance
- better data tracking and validation
- Institute a GIS mapping component
