Hyland to Host Indirect Lending Webinar

Alexandria, Va., October 22, 2010 – National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) Board Member Gigi Hyland will host a webinar on Tuesday, November 9, 2010 entitled “Indirect Lending: Balancing the Risks and Rewards.” The webinar will begin at 2:00 p.m. EST and end at 3:30 p.m. EST.
