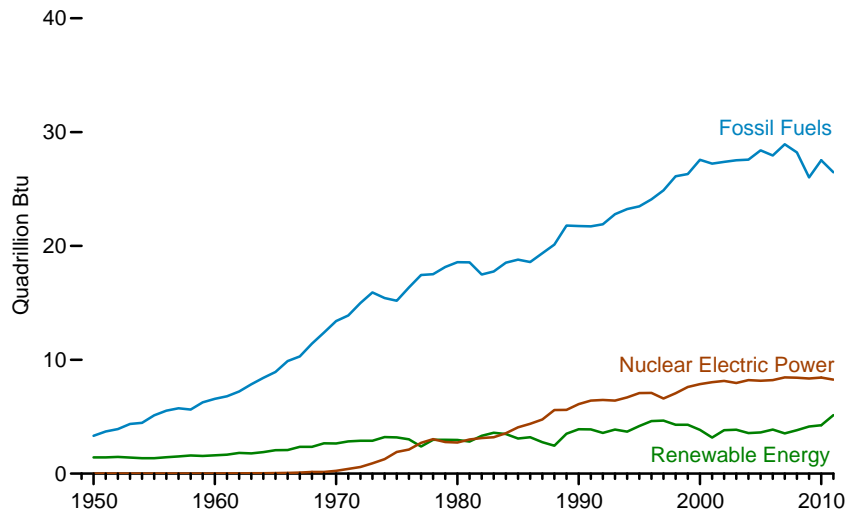
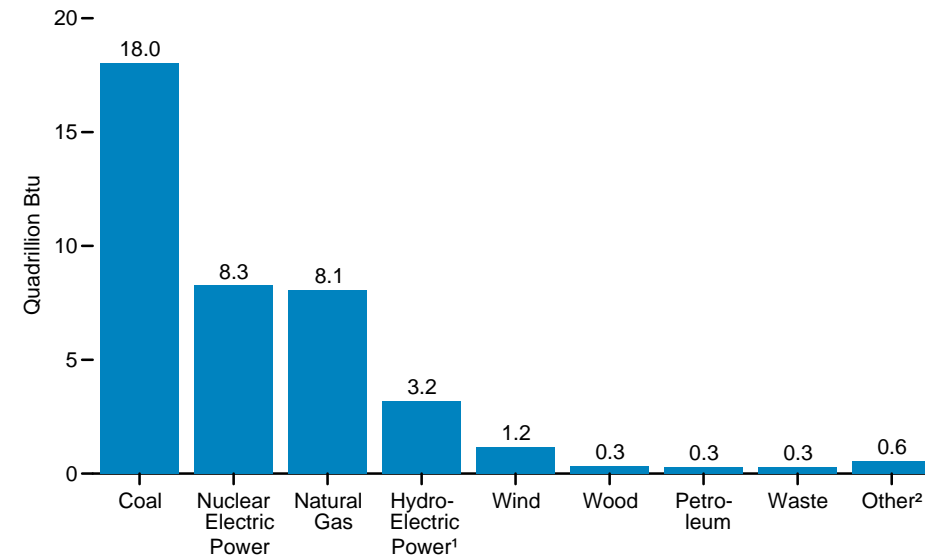


## Figure 8.4 Consumption for Electricity Generation

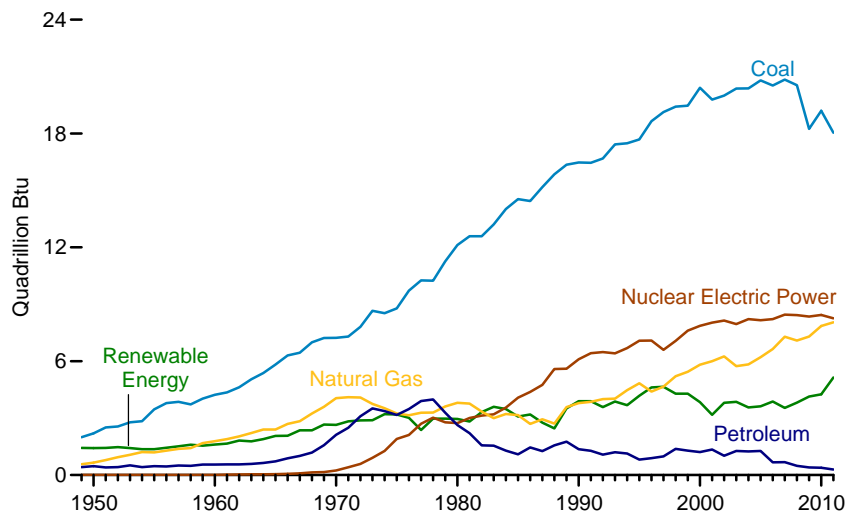
### By Major Category, 1949-2011



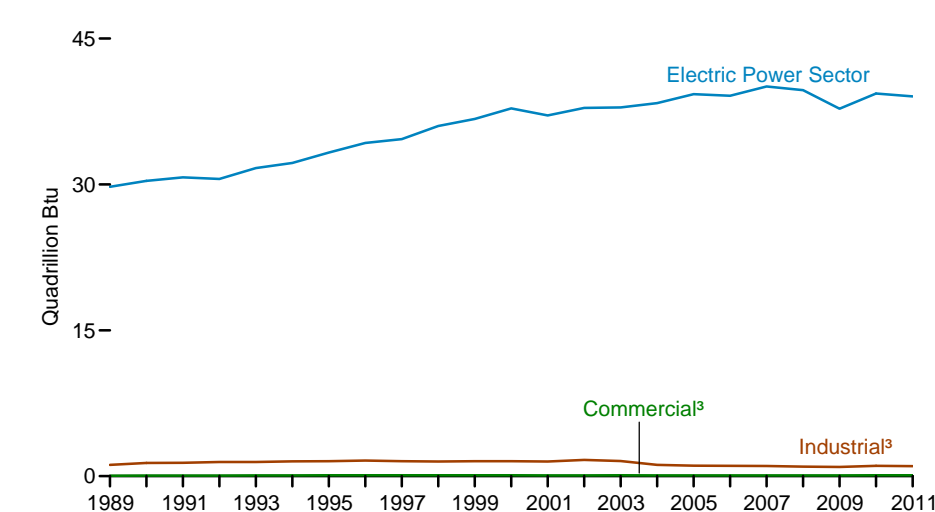
### By Major Fuel, 2011
