COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

COMMISSION ACTION ON FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT APPEAL

LIBRARY

The Commission denied the request of Robert Anton and Lambert Hirsheimer for access to certain materials contained in or relating to an investigatory file relating to Financial Programs, Inc. which was compiled by the staff prior to the institution of a public administrative proceeding in which Messrs. Anton and Hirsheimer are named respondents. The staff has made some of the requested materials available to the requesters and the Commission is of the view that all records being withheld are exempt from disclosure by virtue of the seventh exemption, and that any further production of investigatory records which may be made to the requesters ought to occur only in response to a request made pursuant to the rules of procedure applicable to the pending administrative proceeding. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BEN FRANKLIN INCOME SECURITIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 18 to request a hearing on a proposal of the Commission to declare that Ben Franklin Income Securities, Inc., a closed-end investment company registered under the Act, has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-8863 - July 22)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MISSISSIPPI POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 15 to request a hearing on a proposal of Mississippi Power & Light Company, subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., to issue and sell at competitive bidding, up to \$25 million of first mortgage bonds. The net proceeds of the sale will be used to finance, in part, Mississippi's construction program and to repay short-term borrowings. (Rel. 35-19093 - July 22)

ADDITIONAL ACTION ON THREE TRADING SUSPENSIONS

The SEC has announced the suspension of (a) exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of BBI, Inc. for the further ten-day period July 23 - August 1, inclusive; and (b) exchange and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Equity Funding Corp. and over-the-counter trading in the securities of Industries International, Inc. for the further ten-day period July 26 - August 4, inclusive.

MISCELLANEOUS

LEE NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued denying the application of Lee National Life Insurance Company, a Louisiana corporation, under Section 12(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, for an exemption from the provisions of Section 15(d) of the Act. It appeared to the Commission that the granting of the requested exemption would not have been consistent with the public interest or the protection of investors. (Rel. 34-11545)
